Note: [a] Not available.

Comments: [i] BOBRIK : Unidentified cover-name. Either beaver-cloth or a Russian style of men's hair-out where the hair is out short apart from a small quiff in front.

[ii] MAYOR : Unidentified cover-name.

[iii] ...NG : Unidentified cover-name. The only one now held which ends in NG is "SLANG" which this could be although it cannot be proved at this time.

[iv] COMPETITORS: Members of a Non-Soviet intelligence organisation.
