## Draw ceremony 2009/10 UEFA Women's Champions League Round of 32 Nyon, 14 August 2009



Time: 12.00 hours

Duration: approximately 30 minutes

Number of teams involved: 32

Number of seeded teams: 16

Number of matches: 2 x 16

Set match dates: 30 September and 7 October 2009

Venues and kick-off times to be announced by: 28 August 2009 (first and second legs)

#### Conditions of the draw

The round of 32 pairings are determined by a draw for which an equal number of clubs are seeded and unseeded. The draw respects the following principles, in accordance with paragraphs 5.09 and 7.03 of the Regulations of the UEFA Women's Champions League 2009/10:

- Clubs from the same association may not be drawn against each other.
- The 16 best-ranked teams (seeded teams) are drawn against the teams ranked 17 to 32 (unseeded teams). The ranking to establish the 16 best-ranked teams is drawn up in accordance with paragraph 7.02 of the Regulations of the UEFA Women's Champions League 2009/10.
- The 16 best-ranked teams play the return leg at home.

### **Draw procedure**

The balls containing the names of the unseeded teams will be placed in one bowl and the balls containing the names of the seeded teams will be placed in another bowl.

A first ball will be drawn from the bowl containing the unseeded teams. The team drawn is placed as the home team of match 1.

A ball will be drawn from the bowl containing the names of the seeded teams to complete the match 1 tie. The team drawn will be placed as the visiting team of match 1.

This procedure will be repeated for the remaining matches (2 to 16).

Should the team drawn be from the same association as the home team in that tie, the team will automatically be transferred to be the visiting team of the next tie and another team will be drawn into the free position of the current tie.

Should a seeded team and an unseeded team from the same association be remaining in the two draw bowls when it comes to draw tie 15, the following procedure will ensue: a team will be drawn from the bowl containing the unseeded teams and will be placed as home team of match 15; the remaining three teams in the two bowls will be allocated to the three remaining positions in ties 15 and 16 in accordance with the conditions of the draw as specified above.

Duration: approximately 20 minutes

Number of teams involved: 16

Number of matches: 2 x 8

Set match dates: 4 and 11 November 2009

Venues and kick-off times to be announced by: 14 October 2009 (first and second legs)

### **Draw procedure**

At this stage of the competition, no teams are seeded.

The 16 balls containing slips of paper for "winner of match 1" to "winner of match 16" will be placed in the large central bowl and shuffled.

The first team drawn will play its first match at home against the second team drawn.

The same procedure will then be repeated for the other round of 16 matches.
