## 2013 Nations Cup Selection Criteria

The United States will send 12 teams to the 2013 Nations Cup.

The number of teams selected per level to be as follows:

Senior: 4 teamsJunior: 4 teamsNovice: 2 teamsAdult: 2 teams

Champions of the 2011 and 2012 National Theatre On Ice National competitions at the novice, junior, senior and adult levels will automatically qualify for the 2013 Nations Cup.

The remaining teams and alternates will be selected by the appointed the TOI International Management Subcommittee (IMSC).

The Criteria used for selection by the IMSC is as follows:

- Performances from the 2011 and 2012 TOI National Competitions and placement at the 2011 Nations Cup.
- Teams that qualify as novice or junior in 2011 may compete at Nations Cup one level higher (if a novice team decides to move up to junior for Nations Cup, then there will be five junior teams and only one novice team. No extra teams will be invited to fill the novice slot, with no junior team that is selected being impacted). We will then send five junior teams. No team may go to Nations Cup as a lower division (A junior team may not go to Nations Cup as a novice team).
- Two alternates will be selected for each level. The 2012 alternate teams must compete in the category in which they qualified if selected.

## Please Note:

Any team that is selected to represent the United States at Nations Cup 2013 is responsible for all travel, lodging and living expenses. All teams selected for Nations Cup 2013 will equally share expenses for the appointed team leaders and team doctor.
