

## *ARREST OF A BASE-BALL MANAGER.*

PHILADELPHIA, June 6.—Horace B. Phillips, manager of the Columbus Base-ball Club, was arrested this afternoon when about to leave this City for the ball ground. The prosecutor was J. K. Franck, proprietor of the Great Western Hotel, who alleged that Phillips had defrauded him out of \$91, the amount of a board bill contracted in 1882. At that time Phillips was organizing the Philadelphia Base-ball Club, and it is alleged that he made false representations to the effect that A. J. Reach would see to the settlement of the amount. When Phillips was taken before the magistrate he effected a compromise by paying the bill, and was released.
