**SCOUTING REPORT:** Two-time letterwinner who challenges Thomas Merriweather for starting duty ... needs 277 net yards rushing to reach 1,000 yards for his career ... though he does not have great size, he is a player who can run both inside and outside ... catches the ball extremely well out of the backfield.

**2008:** Played in 11 of Miami's 12 games, winding up with 366 net rushing yards and one touchdown ... averaged 4.6 yards per carry ... caught a career-high 33 passes out of the backfield for 246 yards ... his top effort came at home in the season finale against Ohio, rushing for a career-best 100 yards and catching three passes ... started games at Northern Illinois, vs. Kent State, at Buffalo and vs. Ohio ... recipient of the team's outstanding junior award.




**SCOUTING REPORT:** Emerged from spring practice as back-up punter to senior Chris DiCesare ... begins his second season at Miami.



**2008:** Played in eight games, but did not register any pass receptions.


