

## PHILL HANSEL

### HISTORY & RECORDS



From 1975-1996, he was the most influential man for the University of Houston swimming and diving team. He guided the Cougars to more than 70 dual meet victories and ten Top 20 finishes at the AIAW and NCAA Championships.

Last year, all of that hard work paid off, as Phillip Hansel was inducted into the Hall of Honor on Nov. 14, 2008.

A 1949 graduate and swim team captain at Purdue University, Hansel began coaching at Multnomah Athletic Club in Portland, Ore. immediately after graduation.

In 1957, Hansel was named the first head swimming coach for the University of Houston and given the task of assembling a team. With a school of nearly 30,000 students, Hansel knew there must be some undergraduates who knew how to swim. He put an advertisement in the Daily Cougar, and had a few who were eager to learn but had little experience.

In 1958, Hansel recruited some talented athletes, but he found out in December that the program would be dropped because of a lack of an indoor swimming

facility.

He continued to stay in the Houston area, coaching Cougar swimmers at the YMCA. In 1959, he took some of the swimmers, competing as the University of Houston swim club, to the AAU National Championships, where they finished second in the nation. This was the highest any school had ever finished in the US National Championships.

Leading the Cougars that year was 18-time national champion, Carin Cone. Under Hansel's direction, Cone was the first UH athlete to appear on Sports Illustrated on April 18, 1960.

In 1971, Houston reinstated the swimming program. Hansel once again became the men's coach. He added the women's team to his duties in 1975. Before the revival of the program, Hansel coached the Shamrock Hilton club from 1958-68 and the Houston Swim club.

Hansel would go on to guide the Houston women's team to ten-consecutive Top 20 finishes (1976-86).

Under his guidance, Diane Johannigman (1978-81), Beverly Rose (1983-85), Anne Jardin (1977-81), Nicola Fibbens (1983-86), Ingrid Lawerence (1981-84), Cory Schia (1977-80), Katy Archer (1982-84) and Oliva Clark

(1991-95) received a combined 120 All-America honors.

Johannigman, who set an American record in the 100-yard butterfly, was the first NCAA swimming national champion in UH history.

Hansel was also a three-time recipient of the SWC Swimming and Diving Coach of the Year award (1976, 1983, 1986).

In 1986, Hansel became a columnist for Swimming World Magazine. Despite no formal training, Hansel became a celebrity, receiving an abundance of fan mail.

Outside of the university, Hansel also served on the staff of the first annual US Pan-Pacific team that set four world records in one day in Tokyo, Japan.

He also managed the US Swimming Team in 1992 that won 27 medals, 11 of which were gold in the Barcelona Olympic Games. The team broke three World records, two Olympic records and three American records.

In addition to his coaching duties, Hansel served on the US Olympic Swimming Committee in 1992. There he, along with 10 other coaches from around the country, watched 40 of America's best swimmers, including world-record holders and past Olympians.

Hansel coached Singapore's Olympic Team in 1984 in Los Angeles, and was the assistant coach for Singapore's Olympic Team in 1988 in Seoul, South Korea.

In 1996, Hansel finished out the season with over 39 years of coaching experience and was recognized as one of the most successful collegiate swim coaches in the nation.

In his honor, the University of Houston will play host to the Phillip Hansel Duals Weekend on Oct. 9-10.

Last season, during the Phillip Hansel Duals Weekend, Hansel was inducted into the University of Houston's Hall of Honor.

- 21 swimmers, divers and coaches have made 34 appearances in the Olympic Games, with seven Cougars representing five nations at the 1984 Games in Los Angeles.
- Current Cougar Anastasia Pozdniakova made her first appearance and captured silver in the women's synchronized 3-meter springboard in the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games with teammate and former Cougar Yulia Pakhalina.
- 46 swimmers and divers have earned 233 NCAA and AIAW All-American awards.
- 12 Cougars claimed individual championships in the Southwest Conference from 1983 to 1994, led by five-time champion Beverley Rose.
- Diving head coach Jane Figueiredo has guided divers to the NCAA Championships in 14 consecutive seasons. She also competed for Portugal in the 1984 Olympic Games and coached Great Britain (1996) and Russia (2000, 2004, 2008) in four Olympics.
- The 2000 Cougar Squad earned the best national finish in the program history with a third-place finish at the National Independent Championships.
- Swimmer Carin Cone was the first of many UH student-athletes to grace the cover of Sports Illustrated magazine in 1960.
- Phill Hansel, the first swimming and diving coach, was inducted into the Hall of Honor on Nov. 14, 2008.

**YULIA PAKHALINA**

The 2001 and 2003 NCAA Diver of the Year, Pakhalina captured five NCAA national championships in the 1-meter and 3-meter springboards. In addition, she won three consecutive NCAA national crowns on the 3-meter board from 2001-03.

**ANASTASIA POZDNIKOVA**


In 2009, Anastasia Pozdniakova won the 1-meter event at the NCAA Championships, while finishing second in the 3-meter event and ninth in the platform competition.

**JANE FIGUEIREDO**

Eight-time defending Head Coach of the Year, Jane Figueiredo has established herself as one of the country's finest diving instructors and was named NCAA Diving Coach of the Year in 2009, 2003 and 2001.

**2008 OLYMPICS**

Former Cougar Yulia Pakhalina and current Cougar Anastasia Pozdniakova, who competed for Russia, took the silver medal in the women's 3-meter synchronized springboard. Pakhalina also took silver in the women's 3-meter springboard.

**OLIVIA CLARK**

Olivia Clark added to the Cougars' rich diving tradition in the early 1990's. In four years, Clark earned nine All-American honors to establish herself as one of the most decorated divers in school history.

**ALEXANDRA HEYN**


Alexandra Heyns (1992-95) was the school record-holder in the 200-yard freestyle and owns a Top Five mark in two other events.

**DIANNE JOHANNIGMAN**

Dianne Johannigman (1978-81) was the first Cougar to win an AIAW individual national championship in swimming and diving by sweeping the 100-and 200-yard butterfly events in 1978. She would go on to add two more national crowns during her career.

**SASHA SCHWENDENWEIN**

Sasha Schwendenwein was named the 2009 Conference USA Swimmer of the Year and became Houston's first swimmer to qualify for the NCAA Championships since 1989, earning All-America honors in the 200-yard butterfly.

**PHILL HANSEL**

Hansel was the first coach of UH Swimming & Diving and guided the Cougars to more than 70 dual meet victories and 10 Top-20 finishes at the AIAW and NCAA Championships. He was inducted into the Hall of Honor Nov. 14, 2008.

**CARIN CONE**

After being named as a finalist for the Sullivan Award, Carin Cone was presented with an award from head coach Phill Hansel, the "Father of Cougar Swimming and Diving."

• Competed in her third Olympic Games in Beijing, China in the summer of 2008 and won two silver medals. Her first medal was in the 3-meter synchronized diving, where she was paired with current Cougar, Anastasia Pozdniakova. Her second silver was in the 3-meter springboard.

• Competed in her second Olympic Games in Athens in the summer of 2004 and won the silver medal in synchronized diving... Earned the bronze medal in the 3-meter individual springboard event.

• Teamed with Vera Ilyina to win the gold medal in 3-meter synchronized diving at the 2000 Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia.

• Established herself as possibly the greatest female student-athlete in the storied history of Cougar athletics.

• Set a school record in 2003 by winning her fourth and fifth NCAA individual national championships.

• Won 64 of the 66 collegiate diving events in which she entered as a Cougar with the only losses coming during the finals of the NCAA Championship.

• Received the C-USA Women's Swimming and Diving Scholar-Athlete Award in 2004.

• Never lost on the 3-meter springboard, winning all 32 events during her distinguished career.

• Collected back-to-back Conference USA championships on both the 1-meter and 3-meter springboards in 2002 and 2003.

• Won the C-USA platform diving championship in 2002, the only platform event in which she competed at UH.

• Honored as the Conference USA Diver of the Week 11 times in two seasons, including seven times during the 2002-03 season alone.

• Won a silver medal during the 3-meter synchronized diving competition at the European Championships in Berlin in August 2002 and captured a gold medal in the 3-meter event.

• Won a silver medal in synchronized diving at the 2001 FINA World Championships in Japan.

• Competed at the 2001 Goodwill Games in Brisbane, Australia.







- Received 24 All-America honors during her outstanding collegiate career, the most by any Cougar swimmer or diver.
- Set a new American AAU record in 1977 in the 100-yard time with a clocking of 54.11, nearly a full second faster than the previous record.
- Besides three national crowns, was the National Runner-Up in the 100-yard butterfly in 1979 and 1980... Earned five third-place finishes at the AIAW national meet in a three-year span as well.
- Was ranked among the world's Top 20 leaders in three events (100-meter butterfly, 200-meter butterfly and 100-meter backstroke).
- Finished as the eighth-highest scorer among the Top 10 leaders at the 1980 AIAW national meet.
- Continues to hold the Cougars' Top Three fastest times in both the 100-yard and 200-yard butterfly events.
- Posted 15 times in eight events that continue to rank among the Cougars Top 10 fastest times, more than 20 years after competing in her final collegiate meet.
- Inducted into the University of Houston Athletics Hall of Honor in 2006.



### JOHANNIGMAN'S SCHOOL RECORDS

Former Cougar great **Diane Johannigman** continues to hold the school record in the 100-yard butterfly, more than 20 years after competing in her final collegiate meet.

In fact, Johannigman owns the top three fastest times in UH history in the 100-yard butterfly and two of the Top 5 times in the 200-yard butterfly.



- Was the first nationally-acclaimed student-athlete in UH history.
- Held seven world records, 10 American short course records and 14 American long-course records during her outstanding career.
- Represented the United States at the 1956 Olympic Games in Melbourne, Australia, and tied for first in the 100-meter backstroke but was awarded the silver medal by the judges.
- Won 16 titles competing in the U.S. Senior Nationals and helped lead the UH swimming team to a national runner-up finish at the 1959 AAU National Championships.
- Honored as a finalist for the 1959 Sullivan Award, given to the nation's top collegiate athlete.
- Became the first of many UH student-athletes to grace the cover of *Sports Illustrated* magazine on April 18, 1960.
- Inducted into the International Swimming Hall of Fame in 1984.
- Inducted into the University of Houston Athletics Hall of Honor in 2004.
