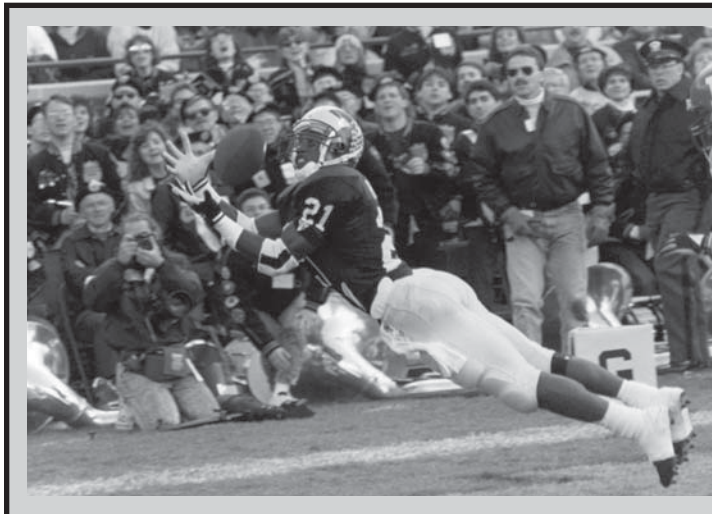
BUTCH WOOLFOLK

As a top U-M sprinter from 1979-82, Woolfolk captured NCAA All-America honors with a sixth-place performance in the 200-meter dash in 1980. A two-time Big Ten champion, Woolfolk's personal bests of 10.36 (100m) and 20.59 (200m) remain among the Wolverines' top marks. On the gridiron, he set Wolverine records for most attempts (718) and most yards gained rushing (3,861), leading the team in rushing for three straight seasons. His touchdown runs of 92 and 89 yards are the longest and third longest in U-M history. Named Michigan's Most Valuable Player in 1981, he also was named MVP in the 1981 Rose Bowl and Bluebonnet Bowl games. He was selected in the first round of the NFL draft by the New York Giants. Woolfolk had a seven-year pro career with three teams: New York Giants, Houston Oilers and Detroit Lions.



HARLAN HUCKLEBY

A four-year letterman on the gridiron, Huckleby completed his Wolverine career with 25 touchdowns and 2,624 total rushing yards. The Wolverines compiled an impressive 38-8-2 record during Huckleby's tenure (1975-78) and made three consecutive Rose Bowl appearances. After his graduation in 1979, he went on to play six seasons with the Green Bay Packers, scoring 13 career touchdowns. In one season with the U-M track team, Huckleby earned All-America honors after contributing to a third-place finish by the mile relay at the 1976 NCAA indoor meet at the Silverdome, helping Michigan to a 10th-place team finish. Huckleby also claimed a Big Ten title in the same event as the Wolverines swept the conference indoor and outdoor team trophies.



DESMOND HOWARD

Winner of the 1991 Heisman Trophy, Howard's acrobatic catches made him one of the most electrifying players ever to play the game. Howard became the first receiver in Big Ten history to lead the conference in scoring (90) as he set or tied five NCAA records and 12 single-season records. He finished his U-M tenure with 37 career touchdowns and 2,146 yards receiving as well as two 90+ kickoff returns for touchdowns and a 90+ punt return for a touchdown. He won the Heisman by the second largest margin of victory in the trophy's history; his 640 first-place votes (85 percent) were the most ever for a Heisman winner. Howard was also recognized as Player of the Year by receiving the Walter Camp Trophy and Maxwell Award. Howard was a first-round draft pick of the NFL's Washington Redskins. Later, with Green Bay, he was voted MVP of Super Bowl XXXI. Howard also played in one Pro Bowl and received All-NFL honors in 1996. A track letterwinner from 1990-92, Howard was a Big Ten scorer in the 60-meter dash.

ROB LYTLE

A consensus All-American in 1976, Lytle gained 1,469 yards as a senior to set a U-M record and broke the Wolverine career rushing mark with 3,317 yards. His honors include the John F. Maulbetsch Award (top freshman) and the Louis B. Hyde Award (team's MVP). He finished third in Heisman Trophy balloting. Lytle played five seasons with the Denver Broncos, making one Super Bowl appearance in 1977. A two-year track and field letterwinner, Lytle was a Big Ten scorer in the short-sprint events, helping U-M sweep the indoor and outdoor conference team titles in 1976.

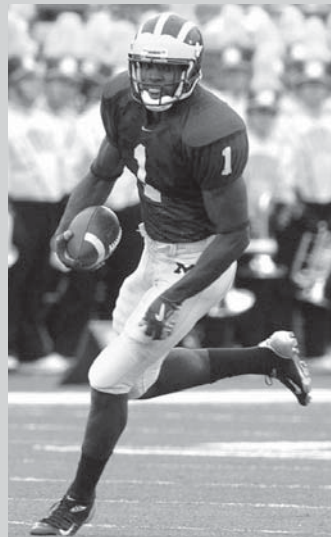


THOMAS WILCHER

A three-time NCAA All-American in the high hurdles, Wilcher capped a successful track and field career by capturing the 1986 NCAA title in the 55m hurdles. He also claimed individual titles in the hurdles at the Big Ten Championships and the Penn Relays. With personal-bests times of 7.76 and 13.52, Wilcher continues to hold the Michigan school records in the 60m and 110m high hurdles, respectively, as well as the U-M Indoor Track Building record in the 60m hurdles (7.78). Wilcher was a two-year letterwinner on the Wolverine football team (1985-86), accumulating eight career rushing touchdowns as a tailback.

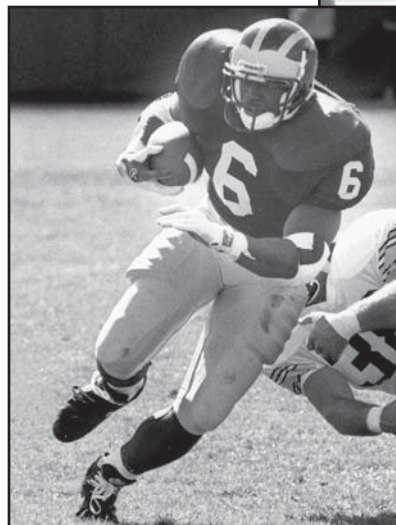
BRAYLON EDWARDS

The 2004 Biletnikoff Award recipient as the nation's top receiver and an All-American, Edwards registered 36 career touchdowns while setting U-M records in career yards gained receiving (3,432), season receptions (87) and season receiving yards (1,221). He also helped lead Michigan to back-to-back Big Ten titles and Rose Bowl appearances in 2003 and 2004. At the 2005 NFL Draft, Edwards was chosen No. 3 by the Cleveland Browns. A two-year letterwinner with the U-M track and field program, Edwards competed in the sprints and high jump, scoring points for Michigan at the 2003 Big Ten outdoor meet.



TYRONE WHEATLEY

A three-time All-Big Ten selection (1992-93-94), Wheatley ranks seconds among Michigan's all-time great running backs with 47 career touchdowns and lists fourth with 4,178 total rushing yards. He boasts 20 games with more than 100 yards rushing, including 235 yards against Washington in the 1993 Rose Bowl and a 99-yard kick return against Houston in 1992. Wheatley was taken in the first round, 17th overall, by the New York Giants in the 1995 NFL Draft and recently retired from the Oakland Raiders organization after a successful 10-year professional career that included an appearance in Super Bowl XXVII. In track and field, Wheatley was an NCAA All-American and Big Ten champion in the 110m hurdles. With personal-bests of 10.46 and 13.77 in the 60m and 110m events, respectively, he continues to list among the greatest high hurdlers in U-M program history.

Considered the favorite to win the pole vault, Charles Dvorak missed the final after being incorrectly told it had been rescheduled. In response to heavy American protest, a special competition was held, allowing Dvorak to claim the silver medal. Future U-M coach Alvin Kraenzlein, largely considered the father of the modern hurdling technique, was the star of the 1900 Games, winning four individual gold medals over three days, the only track athlete to accomplish the feat.

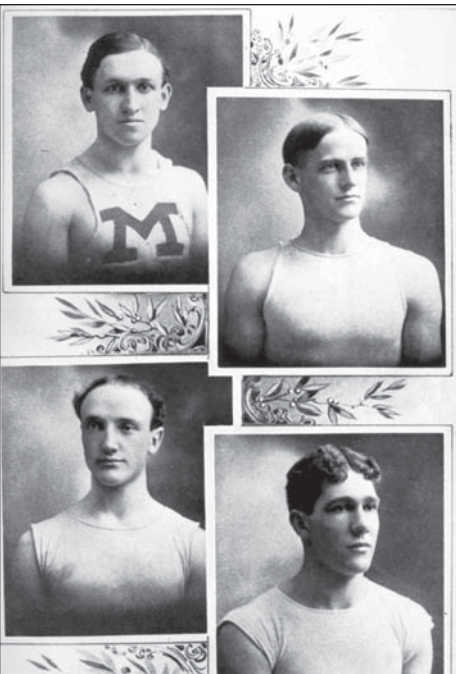

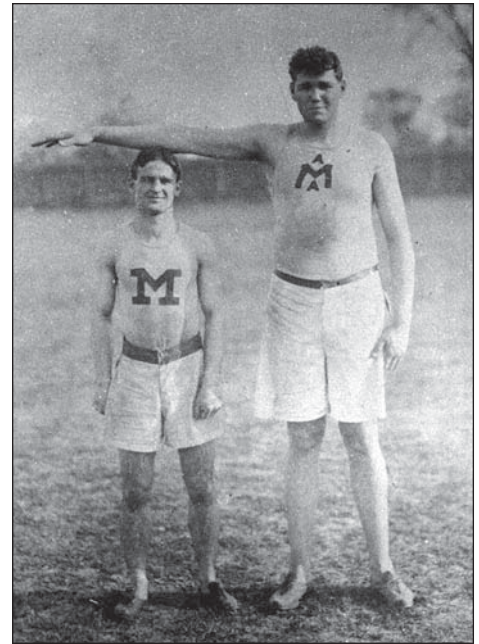
