









# KasPattern Book

## Zanny's T Sweater

Zanny Lovemore Blew

This sweater is from the original KAS pattern by Zanny (Ronda's sister, Sandy's Mother). This was the first garment pattern issued by KAS.

KAS would appreciate sweaters that will fit 3-10 year old children.

The garment will be longer than it is wide.

The added length is to cover the child's distended stomach.

Finished chest size: 24 in/61 cm

### **Materials and Equipment**

- Light worsted yarn (US)/Double Knit (UK)/8 Ply (Aus)
- 4.5 mm / 7 US / 7 Old UK needles

#### **Abbreviations**

Stocking stitch	one row knit, one row purl
Garter stitch	every row knit

#### **Instructions**

This garment is knitted in one piece.

Cast on 60 stitches Commence ribbed pattern as follows:

Row 1: \*Knit2, Purl2\*. repeat from \* to end of row. Row 2: \*Knit2, Purl2. repeat from \* to end of row.

Next row: continue these two rows until work measures approx 3½ ins/9cms.



Next row: Knit to end of row Next row: Purl to end of row

Next row: continue in stocking stitch until work measures approx 10ins/26cms from end

of ribbing, ending with a purl row.

Next row: cast on 20 stitches at beginning of row. Next row: cast on 20 stitches at beginning of row.

Next row: \*Knit2, Purl2\* to end of row. Next row: \*Knit2, Purl2\* to end of row.

Next row: continue in ribbed stitch until work measures 6ins /15cms from sleeve cast-

ons.

#### **Neck Opening**

Next row: Rib 27 stitches, cast/bind off next 46 stitches, rib 27 stitches

Next row: Rib 27 stitches, cast on 46 stitches, rib 27 stitches

Next row: Continue in ribbed stitch until work measures 6ins/15cms from neck opening

Next row: Cast/bind off 20 stitches at beginning of row. Next row: Cast/bind off 20 stitches at beginning of row.

Next row: Knit to end of row. Next row: Purl to end of row.

Next row: Continue in stocking stitch until work measures approx 10/26cms from

sleeve casting offs, ending with a purl row.

Next row: \*Knit2, Purl2. repeat from \* to end of row. Next row: \*Knit2, Purl2. Repeat from \* to end of row.

Next row: continue these two rows until work measures approx 3½ ins/9cms.

Next row: Cast/bind off.

Sew up side seam and under-arm for both sides.

Note: Once the neck opening stitches have been cast on again your work will be reversing what you have already knitted.

#### **Variations**

This garment can be made larger by casting on more stitches in multiples of four, for example, 64, 68, 72 etc. and/or a bigger needle.

The neck opening should be at least 8ins /20cms, which will be approx 46 stitches.

This garment can also be knitted in garter stitch (every row knit), see below.



For this sweater, 68 stitches were cast on and gives chest measurement 28ins/71cms



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
