- Call to arder, rall call: Roll call, chairman's welcome.
- Update from the Secretary of Technology: The Honorable Aneesh P. Chapra, Secretary of Technology for the Commonwealth, will provide a brief update on executive initiatives that allign with JCDTS' agenda, such as research \& development, broadband deployment, electronic health records, and education resources.
- Update on Cell Phone Spam Legislation: The General Assembly referred House Bill 1354 (Bell) to JCDTS, concerning cell phone spam. This is an issue that JLDTS worked on during the 20C․ Interim, but did not recommend legislation. Patrick Cushing will pravide an update on cell phone spam legislation, including the interplay of this legislation with federal regulations.
- Dverview of RFID Issues: The General Assembly referred House Bill 208C (Eisenberg) to JCDTS . The bill would require consumers to be notified of the presence of a Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) Tag in consumer goods. The issue of RFID is new to JCDTS. Lisa Wallmeyer will provide an overview of RFID technology and policy issues that it raises.
- UETA Updates: The Uniform Electronic Transactions Act was adapted in 200] at the reocmmendation of JCDTS. Recent legislation, such as 20T's Electronic Notaries Act, has highlighted that technical language may be outdated in UETA. Lisa Wallmeyer will provide an overview of possible updates for UETA.
- UUSAFE: Danna Leaman, with USAA, will present a proposal for legislation to facilitate the sending of official documents and notices in an e-commerce environment -- USAFE, or Uniform State Act to Facilitate E-Commerce.
