- **2:35 2:50** Payload Processing Facility: The Payload Processing Facility offers a new capability at Wallops. The facility provides two large, clean bays for processing spacecraft for launch and office space for temporary projects at Wallops.
- **2:55 3:15** Sounding Rocket Facility: Personnel provide all the necessary components to prepare a sounding rocket payload for flight. Wallops personnel prepare and conduct on average 20 sounding rocket missions annually
- **3:20 3:40** Range Control Center: The RCC is the heart of launch operations at Wallops. From the facility, personnel direct launch operations and provide range safety support for the mission.
