Once the home of a prestigious hotel, Skinner State Park offers outstanding views of the Connecticut Valley and is primarily used for hiking, public programs, and scenic viewing. It is part of the Massachusetts state park system and is managed by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), an agency of the Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs. DCR oversees 450,000 acres of parks, forests, beaches, bike trails, watersheds, and dams. Its mission is to protect, promote, and enhance the state's natural, cultural, and recreational resources. - TRAIL USE GUIDELINES AT SKINNER
- Stay on designated trails and roads.
  - Observe all posted rules and regulations.
  - Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) use prohibited.
  - Respect private property.
  - Be alert for other trail users:
- Hikers: Allow bicyclists and equestrians to pass.  
Bicyclists: Control your bike-do not skid.  
Avoid startling horses and hikers-announce yourself.  
Equestrians: Control your horse.
