#### Materials

FIBRA NATURA MERMAID, Shade No # 40605 - 9 (10, 11, 12) Balls Straight knitting Needle Size # 7 and 6. Plastic Button – Medium – 6 Buttons OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE.

Sizes

Directions are for women size Small, Medium, Large, X-Large. Skill Level – Intermediate.

#### **Finished Measurement**

Width – 17.5" – (18.5, 19.5, 20.5) Length – 19.5" – (20, 21, 21) Sleeve Length - 18" Gauge 22 sts - 4" ; 28 rows - 4" in St st on Needle Size # 7 TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

ABBREVIATION

C2B (Cross 2 Back) – slip next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next st from left-hand needle, then st from cable needle. C4B(Cable 4 Back) - Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2 sts from left-hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

**C12F(Cable 12 Front)** – Slip next 6 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, knit next 6 sts from left hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

### PATTERN

2 st Cable Panel of 2 sts on a background of reverse st st. 1<sup>st</sup> row (right side) – C2B. 2<sup>nd</sup> Row – p2. Rep these 2 rows. 4 st Cable 1<sup>st</sup> row(right side) - knit 2<sup>nd</sup> Row – Purl 3<sup>rd</sup> Row - C4B. 4<sup>th</sup> Row – Purl. Rep these 4 rows. The cable as given above twists to the right. To work the 4 st cable twisted to the left work C4F instead of C4B in the 3rd row. 12 sts cable Panel of 12 sts on a background of reverse st st. 1<sup>st</sup> row(right side) – k12. 2<sup>nd</sup> Row – p12 3<sup>rd</sup> Row – C12F 4<sup>th</sup> Row- p12. 5<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> – Rep 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> rows 3times. Rep these 12 rows. BACK Using Needle Size # 6 and Shade No # 40605. Cast on 116(116, 124, 124) sts and work as follows -Row 1(RS) - \* p1, C2B, p1, C4B \* rep \* to \* up to last 4 st, p1, C2B, p1. Note – C2B crosses at every 2<sup>nd</sup> row and C4B crosses at every 4<sup>th</sup> row. WS - knit the knit and purl the purl st. By rep this pattern until pcs measures 6". Change to Needle Size # 7 and dec 28(28, 30, 24) sts and work in St st. - 86(88, 94, 100) sts Work even for 7 rows. Inc 1 st both side. Rep inc at every 8<sup>th</sup> row. – 4 times more Work even until pcs measures 12"(12, 13, 13) from cast on edge. - 96 (98, 104, 110)sts

#### ARMHOLE SHAPING

Bind off 5 sts at the beg of next 2 rows. - 86(88, 94, 100) Dec 1 st both side at every row. -5 times -76(78, 84, 90)Work even until armhole measures 7"(7, 7.5,8) BACK NECK AND SHOULDER SHAPING Bind off central 32(34,34,38) sts and work on both part separately. From armhole edge bind off 6(6,7,7) sts - 4(4, 4, 5) times at every alternate row and 3(4,4,5) sts from neck edge - once. **RIGHT FRONT** Using Needle Size # 6 and Shade No # 40605 . Cast on 57 (57, 65, 65) sts and work as follows -Row 1(RS) - P1,2 sts cable ,p1, 12 sts cable, p1,\* 2 sts cable, p1, 4 sts cable, p1\*, rep \* to \*. By continuing all pattern work even for 6". Change to Needle Size # 7 and dec 9 (8, 13, 9)sts evenly (there is no dec in 12 sts cable) - 48(49,52, 56) sts Continue 12 sts cable pattern and work on St st remaining part. Work even up to armhole same as back. - 53(54, 57, 61) Armhole shaping is same as back. At the same time of armhole shaping start front neck shaping. - 43(44, 47, 51)

#### FRONT NECK SHAPING - 53 sts

Note- Before shoulder shaping dec 5 sts in front cable. From neck side dec 1 st after 12 st cable,p1 at every RS row. – 15(16, 16, 19) times Dec 1 st at every 4<sup>th</sup> row. - 5(5,3,3) times Shoulder shaping is same as back. **LEFT FRONT** Same as right with reverse shaping.

#### SLEEVES

Using Needle Size # 6 and Shade No # 40605 . Cast on 57 sts and work same as back border for 4". - 57(57, 65, 65)sts Dec 14 sts evenly in last row of border. - 43(43, 51, 51) sts Change to Needle Size # 7 and work in St st for 4 rows. Inc 1 st both side. 45(45, 53, 53) sts Rep inc at every 4<sup>th</sup> row. - 4 times - 53(53, 61, 61) sts And rep inc at every  $6^{th}$  row. - 4 times - 61(61,69,69) sts Rep inc at every 8<sup>th</sup> row -2 times - 65 (65, 73, 73)sts Work even until sleeve measures 18". SLEEVE CAP Bind off 5 sts at the beg of next 2 rows. - 55(55, 63, 63) sts Dec 1 st both side at every RS row. - 6(6,6,6) times - 43(43, 51, 51) sts Dec 1 st both side at every row. - 6(6,6,6) times - 31(31,39,39) sts Dec 1 st both st at every RS row. - 3(3,3,3) times - 25(25,33,33) sts Dec 1 st both side at every row. -4(4,6,6) times -17(17,21,21) sts Bind off all sts. FRONT BAND After stitching the shoulder pick 129(131, 135, 137) sts from right front, 54(56,58,60) sts from back and 130(132, 136, 138) sts from left front. Work k1 x p1 rib for .5". Button Hole Row - Work on 4 sts, \*yo, k2tog, work over 12 sts \* Rep \* to \* - 4 times more. End with yo , work over remaining sts. - Total 6 **Button Holes** Work even .5" more.

Bind off rib wise.

#### FINISHING

Sew side seam, sleeves, armholes and button corresponding to button holes.

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
