## Triangles

Skill Level: 1
Approximate Time to Make: 68 hours

## AFGHAN measures approximately $55 " \times 89 "$

RED HEART® "Super Saver®" (economy size), Art.E300 (7 ounce/364 solid): 7 skeins No. 0886 Blue CA, 7 skeins No. 0385 Royal CB, 7 skeins No. 0885 Delft Blue CC.
TLC® "Essentials ${ }^{\text {TM } ", ~ A r t . ~} 512$ (6 ounce/312 yard solid): 2 skeins No. 2672 Lt Thyme CD.

Color Option 1: TLC®"Essentials ${ }^{\text {TM" }}$ : 24 skeins 2323 Aran CA and 2 Skeins No. 2335 CB.
Color Option 2: TLC® "Essentials"TM: 12 skeins each No. 2672 Lt. Thyme CA, 2673 Medium Thyme CB, and 2 skeins No. 2675 CC.
Color Option 3: TLC ${ }^{\circledR}$ "Essentials" ${ }^{\text {TM: }} 12$ skeins each No. 2327 Sandstone CA, No. 2254 Persimmon CB and 2 skeins No. 2958 Falling Leaves CC.

Crochet Hook: 5.0mm [US H-8]
Yarn needle
Susan Bates Trim tool

GAUGE: 16 sts $=4$ " Triangle measures $61 / 2 "$ on each side (point to point)
CHECK YOUR GAUGE: Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Special Stitches:

bpdc $=$ Dc around the post of the next dc from the back.
$\mathbf{f p d} \mathbf{c}=\mathrm{DC}$ around the post of the next dc from the front.

TRIANGLE (Make 56 Royal, 56 Delft Blue, and 84 Blue)
Ch 8 ; join with a sl st to form a ring.
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (first dc), 4 dc in ring, ch 3 [5 dc, ch 3] 2 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 2: Sl st in next dc, ch 3 (counts as first bpdc), fpdc around the post of the next dc, bpdc around the next dc, fpdc in next dc, $*(2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 3 , 2 dc ) all in next ch-3 sp**, fpdc, bpdc, fpdc, bpdc, fpdc; rep from * around, ending at ${ }^{* *}$, fpdc; join with sl st to beg ch $3-9$ sts each side.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, [fpdc, bpdc] 2 times, fpdc, *(2 dc, ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in next ch-3 $\mathrm{sp}^{* *}$, fpdc [bpdc, fpdc] 4 times; rep from * around, ending at **, fpdc, bpdc, fpdc; join with sl st to beg ch $3-13$ sts each side.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, [fpdc, bpdc] 3 times, fpdc, *(2 dc, ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in next ch-3 sp**, [fpdc, bpdc] 6 times, fpdc; rep from ${ }^{*}$ around, ending at ${ }^{* *}$, fpdc [bpdc, fpdc] 2 times; join with a sl st to beg ch-3-17 sts each side.

Rnd 5: Ch 3, fpdc, [bpdc, fpdc] 4 times, *(2 dc, ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in next ch-3 sp**, [fpdc, bpdc ] 8 times; fpdc; rep from * around ending at ${ }^{* *}$, [fpdc, bpdc] 3 times, fpdc; join with sl st to beg ch 3-21 sts each side.

Fasten off.

## ASSEMBLY:

Place triangles according to the diagram. With CD (or color used for edging) and wrong sides together, join motifs with sc, beg at any ch-3 corner, working the inside lps only. Complete one direction of diagonals first, then all the horizontals, then the opposite rows of diagonals. Be careful to make the corners of the triangles meet.

## EDGING:

Work one row sc even spaced on each side - do not edging top and bottom. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## TASSELS:

Using the Susan Bates Trim tool, make tassels using three strands of CA, CB, and CC. Place the cut yarn through the corners of the indicated triangles. Tie the tassels at the neck securely with Royal blue. Cut the royal blue ties even with the tassel yarn.
