



The FedEx Express Hub in Newark, NJ

The FedEx Express Hub at Newark Liberty International Airport provides strategic access to a major urban area in the United States while connecting the market with other centers of commerce throughout the country and internationally.

FedEx Express Hub

- Began Operations: 1986, with a major expansion in 2000
- Workforce: More than 2,500 FedEx Express employees
- Facilities: Three buildings on approximately two million square feet within the Newark Liberty International Airport complex.
- Operations: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year
- Volume: More than 1,200 flights per month provide the Hub with connectivity to domestic and international markets throughout the FedEx network.

Key Facts and Figures

- The Newark Hub, located in the center of the Greater New York metropolitan/northern New Jersey region, serves as "distribution central" for FedEx Express in the Northeast corridor.
- The FedEx Express Hub at Newark provides a direct connection for cargo traveling to and from Canada and Europe, in addition to many markets within the U.S.
- The Newark Hub is located in close proximity to both the Port of Newark and Elizabeth Marine Terminal, one of the largest cargo container ports in the United States.
