**TAR HEELS RETURN HOME TO MEET BROWN WEDNESDAY:** North Carolina's 2013 men's lacrosse team returns home this Wednesday against 20th-ranked Brown for a nationally-televised game on ESPNU. The game will also be simulcast on <u>ESPN3</u> on the web. The match will be played at Fetzer Field in Chapel Hill, N.C. with face-off scheduled for 6:00 p.m.

Joe Beninati will call the play-by-play for ESPNU with Quint Kessenich and Paul Carcaterra handling the color analysis.

Coach Joe Breschi's team carries a 5-3 overall record into this Wednesday's matchup while the Bears are on a five-game winning streak and come to Chapel Hill at 5-1. In their most recent outings, Carolina won at Maryland last Saturday 10-8 while Brown beat High Point 21-8 on Sunday.

**TWO WINS IN A ROW FOR THE HEELS:** Last Saturday's win at Maryland 10-8 provided Carolina with its first two-game winning streak of the season. The Tar Heels had beaten Dartmouth 13-5 the previous Monday. Prior to that, North Carolina's season had been a see saw affair with each victory followed by a defeat.

The Tar Heels opened the season with a win over Air Force, followed by a loss against UMass. The Heels bounced back with a win over Fairfield followed by a triple overtime loss at Notre Dame. The Heels recovered with a last-second win against Princeton but followed that up with a loss to Duke. Carolina's 13-5 win over Dartmouth last week matched its largest victory margin of the season. The Tar Heels also beat Air Force by eight goals in the season opener. Carolina then followed up the win over the Big Green with a crucial victory at #1 Maryland.

**WINS OVER NUMBER ONE**: North Carolina's 10-8 win at top-ranked Maryland last Saturday created a piece of history for the Tar Heel historical archives. It marked the first time in school history that Carolina had beaten teams ranked #1 in the nation in back-to-back seasons.

Prior to whipping the Terrapins, the Tar Heels' last win against a No. 1 team came on April 1, 2012 when Carolina toppled top-ranked Johns Hopkins 13-9 at MetLife Stadium in East Rutherford, N.J. in the Big City Classic.

That win over Johns Hopkins had been an accomplishment in itself as prior to that win over the Blue Jays, Carolina had gone 16 years without beating a #1 team. On that occasion, Carolina outlasted topranked Virginia 19-18 on April 6, 1996.

**THIS WEEK'S RANKINGS:** Brown is ranked #19 this week in the USILA coaches' poll and 20th in the Nike/Inside Lacrosse media poll. The Tar Heels are sixth in the USILA poll this week and seventh in the Nike/Inside Lacrosse ranking.

**SANKEY & BURKE NOTCH ACC PLAYER OF WEEK HONORS:** North Carolina sophomore attackman Joey Sankey and freshman goalkeeper Kieran Burke were named Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Lacrosse Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, as announced March 26 by the conference.

Sankey had a pair of career games as he led North Carolina to a victory over Dartmouth, 13-5, and over

No. 1 Maryland, 10-8. He scored four goals in each game on only 12 total shots in the two games combined. The two four-goal performances set and then matched his career high. The native of Warminster, Pa., now has seven career hat tricks. His seven points against Dartmouth were also a career high for a game as he added assists on three goals, contributing on seven of North Carolina's 13 tallies versus the Big Green. This was Sankey's second ACC weekly honor of the season and of his career. Sankey was also named this week as the National Player of the Week by the Baltimore Sun and will be featured in Friday's edition of the newspaper.

Burke had two of the best games of his eight-game career as he led North Carolina in the wins over Dartmouth and No. 1 Maryland. In the victory over Dartmouth, he made 10 saves and allowed only five goals in 56-plus minutes. His .667 save percentage in the game was the best of his freshman campaign. The native of Fort Salonga, N.Y., then followed that by making 15 saves and allowing only eight goals in a win over Maryland, the first loss of the season for the Terrapins. He faced 37 shots in the game, improving his record to 4-3 and matching his career high for saves set earlier this year against Notre Dame. It is the first weekly award for Burke.

ATTACK UNIT & BURKE POWER UNC PAST TERPS: Freshman goalkeeper Kieran Burke made 15 saves, Joey Sankey rang up a four-goal game and Jimmy Bitter chipped in with a five-point effort as #14 North Carolina defeated #1 Maryland 10-8 on March 26 at Capital One Field at Byrd Stadium.

The Tar Heels bolted to a 9-3 lead in the game midway through the third quarter before weathering a late run by the Terrapins, who scored five of the last six goals of the game. But Burke repeatedly came up big in the cage for Carolina, matching his career high for saves, set previously against Notre Dame on March 2. With the Tar Heels holding a four-goal lead heading into the fourth quarter, Burke was at his best. The Terps outshot Carolina 15-4 in the fourth quarter as the Tar Heels struggled to hold on to the ball, committing seven turnovers in the fourth period. But Burke made six fourth-quarter saves and the Tar Heels earned a much-needed win while evening their league record.

Bitter and Sankey led the Tar Heels with five and four-point games, respectively. Bitter scored twice and passed for three assists while <u>Marcus Holman</u> had two goals and a helper. For the second straight game, Sankey scored four goals, matching his career high set last Monday versus Dartmouth. It was the seventh career hat trick for Sankey.

It marked the fourth time in his career that Bitter has passed for a career-high three assists. Three of those four games have come this season, against Notre Dame, Princeton and Maryland.

**LONGEST DEFENSIVE STAND IN FIVE SEASONS:** Over a stretch from the first to the third quarters of the win over Maryland, Carolina held the Terps scoreless for a span of 33 minutes and 16 seconds, the longest of the <u>Joe Breschi</u> coaching era. The last time the Tar Heels had held a team scoreless for that long a period was March 18, 2008 when Carolina held Marist scoreless for the final 34:04 of a 12-3 win at Fetzer Field.

**SANKEY & HOLMAN LEAD HEELS PAST DARTMOUTH:** Marcus Holman scored his 100th career goal and Joey Sankey had career highs for goals in a game and points in a game as the Tar Heels beat Dartmouth 13-5 last Monday.

Holman became only the ninth Tar Heel in history to score 100 goals when he tallied an unassisted goal with 35 seconds left to play in the second quarter, giving the Tar Heels a 5-3 lead at intermission. Prior to the next face-off the officials took that ball out of play to give Holman a well-earned keepsake. His four goals on the day gave him 102 for his career, at that point tying him with Jeff Sonke (1998-2001) and Mike McCall (2002-05) for sixth place on Carolina's career goal scoring list. Holman's four goals earned him another hat trick, giving him 14 career hat tricks.

Joey Sankey's four goals were a new career high and his sixth career hat trick. He had scored three goals in a match on five previous occasions (versus Mercer, Lehigh, Duke and Maryland in 2012 and versus Air Force in 2013). His three assists were one short of his career high set against Princeton on March 9. His seven points broke his previous career high of six (vs. Mercer and Duke last season and Princeton this year).

**FIRST CAREER GOALS:** A pair of North Carolina players tallied the first goals of their careers in the Tar Heels' 13-5 win over Dartmouth on March 18. Senior defensive midfielder William Scroggs scored in the opening minute of the fourth quarter on a fast break to notch his initial tally. Later in the fourth quarter,

freshman attackman Patrick Kelly scored an unassisted goal, earning the first marker of his career.

**GOOD ON THE DEFENSIVE END:** Carolina allowed only five goals in its 13-5 win over Dartmouth last Monday. That was the fewest goals given up by UNC since a 19-5 win over Michigan on May 5, 2012. The last time Carolina has allowed fewer than five goals was February 13, 2010 when the Tar Heels beat Bryant 5-4 in Chapel Hill.

Goalkeeper Kieran Burke had 10 saves in the win over the Big Green while allowing five goals. His .667 save percentage was the best of his seven-game career.

In Carolina's 10-8 win over Maryland, the Tar Heels gave up their fewest goals in a winning effort against an ACC team since March 26, 2011 when Carolina won 11-6 at Maryland. Burke matched his career high for saves in a game with 15 versus the Terps.

**GIVING UP 15 AND WINNING:** Princeton's high-powered offense was all the Tar Heels could handle as the Tigers proved their mettle on the offensive end of the field in Carolina's 16-15 win over the Tigers on March 9. But the Tar Heels battled back to score one more time than Princeton to come out with the victory. The 15 goals were the most conceded by Carolina in a victorious situation since UNC beat topranked Virginia 19-18 at Fetzer Field on April 6, 1996.

**OFFENSIVE STANDOUTS VERSUS PRINCETON:** Carolina had nine different goal scorers in the win over Princeton March 9 with Jimmy Bitter, Chad Tutton and Davey Emala each scoring three goals. Bitter also had three assists in the game, giving him six points in the match, just one short of his career high set against Hofstra on April 14, 2012. Joey Sankey finished with six points, as well, on two goals and four assists. Sankey's six points matched his career high in a game, a total he eclipsed in the win over Dartmouth on March 18. Sankey's four assists were a career high for the sophomore attackman. On six different occasions as a freshman, he had recorded three in a game. Emala's three goals were the most he had scored since tallying four in the opening game of his junior season against Penn State on February 11, 2012. Tutton also matched his career high for goals in a game. He also had three against Mercer, Virginia and Duke last season.

**KEENAN'S CAREER DAY:** Another key in the win over Princeton was R.G. Keenan's work at the face-off X for Carolina. Facing four different Princeton face-off men, Keenan won 20 of his 34 attempts and had a game-high eight ground balls. The 20 face-off victories were a career high for Keenan, who took every draw in the game for Carolina. His previous best total was 19 face-off victories against Penn State on February 11, 2012. It marked only the sixth time in UNC history that a Tar Heel player has won 20 or more face-offs in a match. Shane Walterhoefer did it four times, including a school record 23 wins against Ohio State in 2008 while Todd Oudemool was the long-time record holder with 22 wins against Towson in 1989. Keenan has won 15 or more face-offs in a game 12 times in his career. Only 12 times during the 2013 NCAA Division I season so far has a player won 20 or more face-offs in a game.

A STEAK OF ONE-GOAL GAMES: Prior to the game against Duke on March 13, Carolina played four successive games decided by a single goal with a loss to Massachusetts 12-11, a win over Fairfield 10-9, a triple overtime loss to Notre Dame 10-9 and the 16-15 win over Princeton. The last time that the Tar Heels had played four straight games decided by a single goal came in 2009 when during a mid-season streak Carolina lost to Maryland 8-7, beat Johns Hopkins 10-9 in overtime, lost to Virginia 11-10 and beat Ohio State 12-11. In 1996, Carolina played a string of five successive games decided by a single goal during a mid-season stretch. During that particular stretch, UNC lost to Duke 11-10, beat Maryland 17-16, lost to Johns Hopkins 9-8, beat Virginia 19-18 and beat Notre Dame 11-10.

SANKEY SHARES ACC PLAYER OF WEEK NOD: North Carolina sophomore attackman Joey Sankey shared Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Lacrosse Offensive Player of the Week honors on March 12, 2013. Sankey had a career-high four assists and matched his career high with six points in Carolina's 16-15 upset win over No. 5 Princeton on March 9. His previous career high for assists was three, and his six points matched a career high he achieved twice in his freshman year. He also led all-non Tar Heel faceoff men with five ground balls in the contest. The native of Warminster, Pa., has tallied multiple goals in six of seven games played this season.

**HOLMAN NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE:** UNC senior captain Marcus Holman (Baltimore, Md.) was named February 20 as one of the final 20 candidates for the 2013 Senior CLASS Award in men's lacrosse. Ten finalists for the award will be named later this spring. Carolina has had three previous Senior CLASS Award finalists — Fletcher Gregory in 2007, Grant Zimmerman in 2009 and Ryan Flanagan in 2011.

**SEEKING ANOTHER DOUBLE DIGIT WIN SEASON:** Despite playing against one of the nation's toughest schedules, the Tar Heels are seeking a double digit win total for the fifth successive year under the tutelage of head coach Joe Breschi, who was hired in June 2008.

Last year, Breschi became only the second coach in UNC history to win 10 games in each of his first four seasons as head coach. Dave Klarmann also accomplished the feat from 1991-94. No Tar Heel coach has ever won 10 or more games in his first five seasons as head coach

Over his first four seasons, under Breschi's leadership, UNC went 12-6 in 2009, 13-3 in 2010,10-6 in 2011 and 11-6 in 2012.

Prior to 2009-12, the last time Carolina had patched together four successive seasons with 10 or more wins was 1989-94 when the Tar Heels had at least double digits in wins six years in a row.

Contrast the current success with the fact over a 12-year span from 1997-2008, Carolina got to the 10-win plateau only twice, going 10-5 in 2004 and 10-6 in 2007.

**TAR HEELS AND BEARS MEET FOR THE THIRD TIME WEDNESDAY:** North Carolina and Brown will be meeting for the third time on the lacrosse field when they meet up Wednesday night in Chapel Hill, N.C. It will also be the first regular season meeting between the two teams. The Tar Heels currently lead the series 2-0.

The only two previous meetings came in NCAA Tournament quarterfinals games and both of those were played in Chapel Hill with UNC winning 16-14 on May 15, 1985 and 16-10 on May 16, 1992.

In the latter of those games, Joe Breschi was in the second year of a two-year assistant coaching stint at Carolina and current Virginia coach Dom Starsia was in his final season as coach of the Bears. Starsia left Providence that summer to coach the Cavaliers and Breschi moved on to Brown shortly thereafter as the head assistant coach. Breschi helped lead the Bears to the NCAA Final Four in 1994 before moving on to be the head coach at Ohio State in the summer of 1997.

**UNC VERSUS RANKED OPPONENTS UNDER COACH BRESCHI:** North Carolina has played ranked opponents 47 times in Joe Breschi's five-year coaching tenure. UNC is 26-21 in those games. Conversely, the Tar Heels are 25-3 against unranked opponents in his five seasons. Breschi is 51-24 overall at Carolina in his five seasons as head coach.

During Breschi's tenure, UNC's only losses to unranked teams came to Ohio State in 2011 and to Lehigh and Pennsylvania in 2012.

**CAROLINA IN ONE-GOAL DECISIONS:** Prior to Joe Breschi taking over as head coach in 2009, UNC went 1-7 in games decided by one goal from midway through the 2004 season through the end of the 2008 campaign.

Carolina has improved tremendously in one-goal games since Breschi arrived for the 2009 season. UNC is 12-9 in games decided by one goal over the past five years.

**A YOUTHFUL STARTING LINEUP**: During the first eight games of the season, the Tar Heels have relied on a youthful set of players to compete against a host of nationally-ranked opponents. Particularly on the defensive end, the Tar Heels are playing a lot of young players.

The starting lineup against the Terrapins last Saturday included three seniors (Marcus Holman, Davey Emala, Kieran McDonald), one junior (Jordan Smith), three sophomores (Jimmy Bitter, Joey Sankey, Chad Tutton) and three freshmen (Spencer Parks, Evan Connell, Kieran Burke).

The Tar Heels have been playing anywhere between 25 and 30 players on average in a game. The depth chart over the past several games has included four seniors, eight juniors, seven sophomores and seven freshmen.

Carolina has one of the youngest rosters in the nation with 57.8 percent of the team composed of freshmen and sophomores, including 33.3 percent of the squad size consisting of freshmen.

SCORING STREAKS FOR TAR HEEL PLAYERS: Senior attackman Marcus Holman has recorded at least one point in 23 successive games. His streak started on February 12, 2012. During the past 23 games he has tallied 56 goals and added 49 assists for 105 points. His 23-game streak equals the 11th longest run amongst NCAA Division I players.

Holman has scored a goal in each of the past 23 games and he has recorded at least one assist in 21 of the past 23 games.

Jimmy Bitter has recorded at least one point in 18 successive games dating back to March 16, 2012. He has scored at least one goal in 16 of the past 18 games.

Joey Sankey has gone 12 successive games with at least one point, a streak dating back to April 20, 2012. During that scoring run, he has recorded goals in 11 of the past 12 games.

Over the last 19 matches dating back to the middle of the 2012 campaign, midfielder Chad Tutton has recorded at least one goal in 18 matches. The only time he was shut out in that streak was at Notre Dame on March 2 of this season.

**HOLMAN IN UNC CENTURY CLUB IN POINTS:** Senior attackman Marcus Holman has recorded 35 points during the 2013 season.

Holman is one of just 36 players in UNC history to reach the 100-point plateau. He currently is in 10th place in Carolina history with 168 career points. Mac Ford and Jed Prossner are tied for eighth place with 172 points.

Holman scored five goals in UNC's win over Fairfield on February 23 after recording six assists in the season opener against Air Force on February 8. His five tallies against the Stags is one goal short of his career high of six established against both Michigan and Denver in 2012.

**HOLMAN ON UNC GOAL & ASSIST CHARTS:** Senior Marcus Holman has scored 104 goals in his career at UNC. That number is the sixth highest total in Tar Heel history. Dennis Goldstein (1987-90) ranks fifth with 108 goals. With four goals against Dartmouth on March 18, he became only the ninth Tar Heel to ever reach the 100-goal standard. Holman's 104 goals equal the 12th most among all NCAA Division I players currently active.

Holman has registered 64 career assists. That equals the 11th most in Tar Heel history. Holman is currently in 13th place in career assists amongst all active NCAA Division I players.

**ASSISTS IN A GAME:** When Marcus Holman recorded six assists in Carolina's season-opening victory versus Air Force on February 8, it marked the most assists in a game by a Tar Heel player in 16 years. The last time a UNC player had as many as six assists in a game was April 12, 1997 when Spencer Deering recorded six assists against Delaware.

**CAREER GOAL HIGHS VERSUS AIR FORCE:** Three Tar Heel players either set or matched their career highs for goals in a game when Carolina beat Air Force 16-8 in the opening game of the season on February 8.

Sophomore Jimmy Bitter scored five goals against the Falcons, breaking his previous career high of four goals against Hofstra on April 12, 2012. Junior Ryan Creighton tallied three goals in the win over Air Force. He had scored two goals in a game on four prior occasions. Sophomore Joey Sankey had a hat trick against the Falcons, equaling his career high. He also had four hat tricks in his freshman year in 2012.

**KEENAN'S UPDATED FACEOFF NUMBERS:** R.G. Keenan has now won 489 face-offs in his career heading into the game against Brown. That is the second most face-off wins in UNC history. Against Fairfield, he moved passed Jude Collins (1993-96), who now ranks fourth in all-time face-off wins with 429. Against Princeton, Keenan passed Kevin Frew (2001-04), who now ranks third with a total of 446 face-off victories. Shane Walterhoefer (2006-09) is the UNC career leader with 723 face-off victories. Keenan has 265 career ground balls, the ninth most in UNC history, one more than Donnie McNichol (1990-93).

**THE CLEARING GAME:** North Carolina is currently clearing at an 88.4 percent success rate during the 2013 season, including an 18 for 18 performance at Maryland on March 23. There are only seven seasons in NCAA Division I lacrosse history in which teams have cleared at least 90 percent of the time

successfully. North Carolina has two of those seasons, including the fifth best (.905 in 1988) and the sixth best (.902 in 2012).

**UNC AMONG ATTENDANCE LEADERS:** The Tar Heels are amongst NCAA Division I attendance leaders in 2013. UNC is sixth in average home attendance at 1,965 per game and ninth in all games attendance at 2,665 per contest.

**BURKE FIRST TRUE FRESHMAN STARTER IN GOAL SINCE 2002:** True freshman Kieran Burke of Fort Salonga, N.Y., has started the first eight games of the season for the Tar Heels in goal. He is the first true freshman to start for the Tar Heels from the opening game of a season since Paul Spellman in 2002. Grant Zimmerman started for the Tar Heels in 2006 as a red-shirt freshman for the second half of that campaign.

Burke recorded a career high 15 saves in UNC's triple overtime loss at Notre Dame on March 2 and matched that total in UNC's win at Maryland on March 23. He had a season best save percentage of .667 against Dartmouth.

**UNC's CAREER HAT TRICKS:** Marcus Holman leads all Tar Heels with 14 career hat tricks. That equals the 13th most career hat tricks of any active player in NCAA Division I.

Other Tar Heels with multiple career hat tricks include Davey Emala with 10, Joey Sankey with seven, Jimmy Bitter with five, Chad Tutton with four and Pat Foster with two.

**THREE HEELS NAMED TO TEWAARATON LIST:** Three Tar Heel players were named February 22 to the Tewaaraton Watch List for 2013. The Tar Heels so tapped are sophomore attackman Jimmy Bitter, senior attackman Marcus Holman and junior midfielder R.G. Keenan.

**HOLMAN NAMED ACC PLAYER OF WEEK:** North Carolina senior attackman Marcus Holman was named Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Lacrosse Offensive Player of the Week for the week ending on Monday, Feb 11. Holman led the Tar Heel attack unit, which produced 10 goals and 8 assists in North Carolina's 16-8 season-opening win over Air Force. The native of Baltimore, Md., had two goals and six assists for the Tar Heels, the most assists in a game by a Tar Heel since April 12, 1997. His eight points were just two short of his career high of 10 and matched his second highest total in his career.

**SIX TAR HEEL GAMES ON ESPN PLATFORMS:** Six UNC men's lacrosse games are being televised this year on the ESPN family of networks. Four Carolina games will air on ESPNU and two more on ESPN3.

The Tar Heels hosted Duke on March 13 on ESPNU at 7:30 p.m., hosted Dartmouth on March 18 on ESPN3 at 4 p.m., visited Maryland on March 23 on ESPN3 at 12 noon, host Brown on March 27 on ESPNU at 6 p.m., meet Johns Hopkins on March 30 on ESPNU at 12 noon and play at Virginia on April 6 on ESPN3 at 3:30 p.m.

In addition, all three ACC Tournament games will be telecast on ESPNU. UNC hosts the conference tournament at Kenan Stadium on April 26 and 28.

**FIVE TAR HEELS WERE RECENTLY CHOSEN IN 2013 MLL DRAFTS:** Senior Marcus Holman was chosen by the Ohio Machine on January 11 in the Collegiate Draft. He was a second round pick of the Ohio Machine and the 12th selection overall.

On December 13, the MLL conducted its annual supplemental draft. Thomas Wood, '12, was taken in the second round by the Rochester Rattlers with the 12th overall pick. Tim Kaiser, '08, was chosen 25th overall in the fourth round by the Ohio Machine. Mark Staines, '12, was the 35th pick, nabbed in the fifth round by the Chesapeake Bayhawks. Chris Hunt, '11, was chosen 96th overall and in the 12th round by the Bayhawks.

**THREE TAR HEELS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC:** Face-Off Yearbook tapped three Tar Heels as 2013 preseason All-ACC choices. The trio includes attackmen Marcus Holman and Jimmy Bitter and face-off man R.G. Keenan.

FACE-OFF PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAS: Four Tar Heel players notched spots on the Face-Off

Yearbook preseason All-America Team for 2013. Marcus Holman was named first team on attack and R.G. Keenan was named second team at the face-off position. Attackmen Jimmy Bitter and Joey Sankey were both tapped for honorable mention accolades.

**HOLMAN ELECTED SINGLE CAPTAIN:** Senior Marcus Holman was elected as the sole captain of the 2013 Tar Heels, the first time that has happened in 23 years. According to research done through Athletic Communications archives, other single captains have been Randy Roden in 1973, Tom Federico in 1991, Randy Cox in 1984, Paul Fitzpatrick in 1989 and Joe Breschi in 1990.

FOUR TAR HEELS EARN WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP RINGS: Four current and future Tar Heel players won gold medal rings at the U19 World Championships in Finland last July. Freshmen midfielders Brent Armstrong, Steve Pontrello and Michael Tagliaferri all played for the U.S. side and midfielder Stephen Kelly, who signed a National Letter of Intent with Carolina last November and will enroll in UNC next August, was also a member of the U.S. Team. Carolina sophomore midfielder Chad Tutton was a member of Team Canada, which captured the silver medal.

**CAROLINA'S STELLAR MARK IN NON-CONFERENCE GAMES:** UNC's record in non-conference games continues to be one of the best in the nation over the past eight seasons.

The Tar Heels have won 64 of their past 75 games against non-conference teams dating back to April 15, 2006.

In Joe Breschi's five seasons as head coach, the Tar Heels are 43-8 against non-conference teams. The only losses were to Notre Dame in 2009, to Ohio State and Johns Hopkins in 2011, to Lehigh, Pennsylvania and Denver in 2012 and to Massachusetts and Notre Dame in 2013.

**CAROLINA'S DOUBLE DIGIT SCORING GAMES:** In Coach Joe Breschi's five years as head lacrosse coach at UNC, Carolina's success has clearly been tied to hitting the 10-goal plateau in a game. In fact UNC's 12-11 loss to Massachusetts on February 16, marked only the eighth time in Breschi's coaching tenure that the Tar Heels have lost when they have reached the 10-goal plateau. UNC has scored at least 10 goals in a game in 52 of 75 games under Coach Breschi's direction dating back to the opening game of the 2009 season.

Carolina is 44-8 in those 52 games, losing only 11-10 to Virginia on April 4, 2009, 15-13 to Duke on April 26, 2009, 12-11 to Duke on May 17, 2009, 11-10 to Virginia on April 9, 2011, 13-11 to Duke on March 16, 2012, 15-10 to Virginia on April 7, 2012, 16-14 to Denver on May 12, 2012 and 12-11 to Massachusetts on February 16, 2013.

In the 23 games under Coach Breschi's tutelage in which the Tar Heels have not reached the 10-goal mark, UNC has not fared nearly as well as when scoring in double figures. In fact their record in those 23 games is just 7-16.

NEAR DOMINANCE AT FETZER FIELD UNDER BRESCHI: UNC is 30-7 in home games in Coach Joe Breschi's five years at the helm of the Tar Heels. That's a winning percentage of 81.1 percent. The Tar Heels had a 17-game Fetzer Field winning streak from 2009-11 under Breschi's tenure. UNC's only home losses during Breschi's four-year tenure include regular-season and ACC Tournament games to Duke in 2009 (both at Kenan Stadium), a regular-season loss to Duke in 2011, an NCAA Tournament loss to Maryland in 2011, regular-season losses to Lehigh and Virginia and an NCAA Tournament loss to Denver in 2012 and a regular-season loss to Duke in 2013.

**HEAD COACH JOE BRESCHI:** Joe Breschi is now in his fifth season as the head coach at his alma mater. His Tar Heel teams have a cumulative record of 51-24 for a winning percentage of 68.0 percent. He is in his 16th year overall as a collegiate head coach, including 11 seasons at Ohio State prior to coming to Chapel Hill. His career coaching record is 143-87 and his career winning percentage is 62.2 percent.

**CAROLINA SNARES 250TH ALL-TIME WIN AT FETZER FIELD:** Carolina's 11-10 win over Maryland on March 24, 2012 marked the 250th all-time win for the Tar Heels at Fetzer Field. North Carolina will head into its next home game against Brown on March 27 with an all-time record of 255-119-2 at Fetzer Field.

UNC has a 68.0 winning percentage all-time in history at Fetzer Field.

**ANOTHER SEASON OPENING WIN:** Carolina's 16-8 win over Air Force in the 2013 season opener was the 15th victory in a row in a season opener for the Tar Heels.

The last time UNC lost a season opener was February 22, 1998 when the Tar Heels fell 13-12 to Butler at Fezter Field.

**THE ALL-TIME RECORD:** North Carolina has an all-time record of 436-272-2 in the sport of men's lacrosse. That is a winning percentage of .614.

**NEXT UP FOR THE TAR HEELS:** After meeting Brown on Wednesday evening, Carolina will have just three days to prepare for its matchup against Johns Hopkins this Saturday at 12 p.m. at Kenan Stadium. That game will be nationally televised by ESPNU.
