n i r u d h a n Chandrasekaran, 18, seldom bunks classes. "Even if I have to miss a class I ask my professors what they are going to teach and go home and look it up," says the SRM University student. So what is it so interesting that he is studying? It's nanotechnology. He is learning to reduce the size of particles. "It is not a course, it's more like a novel; you want to know what happens next," he says.

Two years ago when Anirudhan decided to study nanotechnology, he was told there was no scope for it. "I did not want to be stuck doing IT or electronic engineering. It's not something that interests me nor is it special," he says. So he took up the course and has even thought about what he wants to do after graduating. "I plan to go abroad for my master's and then do research in nanotechnology," he says.

Like Anirudhan, a growing number of students are opting for what interests them, not what is lucrative or what others take up. While there is a long way to go before nanotechnol-

ogy replaces information technology or electrical engineering as the preferred choice of students, there is a noticeable shift. Says Prof. Ankita Chakravarthy Bhattacharjee, dean, Amity School of Business, Kolkata: "Although there are not many institutes offering the course, it is replacing biotechnology in popularity."

It seems students know what they want, and becoming a doctor or an engineer is just part of a larger universe of opportunities. As a result, specialisation begins early. Ashish Agarwal decided right after higher secondary that science was not his cup of tea. He chose a bachelor's in finance and investment analysis at Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies, Delhi University. "I was fascinated by banking and investment and I wanted to pursue a career in this," he says. In fact, he is sure about what he wants to do in the future, too. "I will try to get a job and then do an MBA in finance or a master's in finance after getting some work experience," he says.

Students are not averse to experimenting to find the right fit; in fact, it is the most important thing for many of them. Take the case of Yashi

Shukla, who loves sports shoes and has a talent for designing. So when she came across a course that gave her the opportunity to design shoes, she knew she had found the right fit. "Designing shoes is quite creative and my course combines design and management," she says. And what? The sector offers quite some opportunities. Says Sandeep Bhatia of Footwear Design and Development Institute of India, Noida: "Since many international brands have come to India. it has become necessary to train students in footwear-right from footwear technology, merchandising to material management." The institute offers BSc and MSc courses in everything related to footwear.

Students also prefer courses that offer more in less time. Take, for example, the five-year MBA Tech degree offered by NMIMS University, which has been steadily gaining popularity among students. Dr Sunil Rai, dean (technology management) of Mukesh Patel School of Technology Management and Engineering, says, "Itmakes economical sense for MNCs to hire a 22-year-old MBA graduate at ₹6 lakh per annum instead of taking someone who is older at a higher pay scale." came to know about the course (MBA Tech) through a bookseller when I had gone to look for books to prepare for my engineering entrance exams. So I decided to take a look and realised that I would be merging engineering and finance and also saving a year. This course has made me a techno manager thanks to the focus on blending technology with management. Also, the fact that I will complete my MBA a year earlier gives me the early bird advantage.

Career counsellors see an economic divide in education, but it has nothing to do with the course fees. While those who come from low-income brackets prefer the safe options, such as IT, engineering or business management, those who are well-off tend to experiment. "Many may not want to do engineering, they would rather do a BSc IT course or biomedical engineering or even forensic science," says education counsellor Usha Albuquerque.

There are a few courses, such as animation and computer gaming, that gained popularity lately thanks to the increasing demand for professionals in these streams. Jitendra Chaudhury, manager at Graphiti School of Animation, Mumbai, says the perception of animation itself is changing and that is what is drawing in more students to it. "Two years ago, animation was related only to entertainment. Now people see that it has uses in architecture, education, medicine and a lot of other areas and then there is the new era of gaming which depends on anima-

tion, too," he says. This is one field, he says, where a student's talent can take him really far.

The colleges also are responding positively to the growing demand for new courses. Dr Jagmeet Madan of SVT College of Home Science, Mumbai, has seen many courses added to the curriculum to accommodate industry demand and the interest of students. "Nowadays, it's not just about medicine or engineering. Choosing a career is not so slotted. Students are innovative, they look for other options," he says.

With the enormous growth of the wellness industry, says Madan, there has been an increased interest in courses like clinical nutrition and hospitality. While fashion design has always been popular, students today want to supplement their degrees with specialised postgraduate degrees such as fashion merchandising. "A fashion merchandising degree can get you into the top retail chains right after graduation," he says.

Parveen Shaikh, head psychologist at the career counselling firm Young Buzz, sees students opt for courses that have an industry interface, as they want to know that what they are studying will be applicable

to a job. "Students today are more aware than their parents. They want to make sure that the course they opt for can be applicable to the industry. They want courses which also have internships as part of the curriculum," she says.

Family businesses have always been characteristic of India Inc., and the booming economy has given birth to many successful first-generation entrepreneurs. As a result, courses in family business management

Field-based experiential learning and classroom lectures ensure that students develop economically sustainable entrepreneurial activities.

Why are some courses more popular than others? Education counsellor Jayanti Ghosh says, "They are popular because they are in the news, and, hence, are better known and socially more acceptable." Some conventional courses, such as MBA,

♦ Status

Going for a course perceived as prestigious and not because of genuine interest

◆ Marks scored

continue to be popular because they ensure a well-paid job. MBA degrees these days, however, go beyond marketing, finance and human resources. Be it telecommunications, retail, hospitality or fashion, every field needs trained managers in a booming economy, and specialisation is available for almost every industry.

Saanya Sanghvi, a second-year hospitality management student who had done her degree in psychology, has seen a shift in her personality and attitude since she began her course at Amity University, Delhi. "Even out of the classroom, our department always makes sure hospitality students are there to take care of all events in the college. This constant interaction does instil confidence in a person," she says.

Specialisation is a process of distillation. For example, a course in retail management offers a graduate the expertise to work specifically in the retail industry. Students are taught everything from planning to customer service. And such freshers

are of great demand in the industry. Says Prof. Ramawamy Iyengar of L.N. Welingkar Institute of Management, Mumbai: "The retail industry has been booming and there is a short supply of talented manpower."

Employers prefer recruits with specialisation for obvious reasons. "While hiring, companies take into account the overall packaging of a prospective student. Since these courses are industry-specific and have an updated course curriculum, the students are geared in a much

The evaluation of colleges was done by educational experts (principals/deans/heads of departments/faculty) and current students. Only experts were approached in the first phase and were asked to identify the top colleges. We, thus, identified about 15-20 colleges in each city for each discipline. In the second phase, these colleges were evaluated by experts and students alike and a composite score was arrived at for each college to be ranked. 

earning is an ongoing process. As more and more professionals realise this, online education is gaining popularity among them. "Online courses are gaining popularity because of their flexibility, scope for utilising time effectively, convenience and reinforcement of learning," says

> Education, an online education centre. "A working professional enrolled

> > with our programme easily gets a 25 to 40 per cent hike in salarv."

Swati Salunkhe of the career counselling firm Growth Centre, however, thinks it has a long way to go. "In India, online cours-

es are still at a nascent stage as recognition from the industry as well as the educational departments matters a lot. The biggest advantage of online courses is that one can study from any part of the world the course of his/her inclination without undergoing the selection competition as well as financial burden," she says.

So how do you choose a good course? Parveen Shaikh, head psychologist at Young Buzz, a career counselling firm, says there is no way of figuring out the absolute best course, but the ones offered by the Indian Institutes of Management are a safe bet. But the world of online education works on different parameters, she says. "These courses are more about building knowledge online, so the content matters a lot more than brand name," she says.

Career counsellors say doing an online course cannot be considered a stand-alone option for direct placement. "They are usually supportive in establishing formal credibility for individuals who lack the professional training or qualifications," says education counsellor Javanti Ghosh.
