

## FEI PARA-EQUESTRIAN DRESSAGE WORLD TEAM RANKING 2013

The yearly Para Equestrian Dressage World Team Rankings range from  $1^{st}$  January  $201\underline{3}$  to  $31^{st}$  December  $201\underline{3}$ . Points are not carried over from one year to another and each Team commences each new year with a score of zero (0).

Para Equestrian Dressage FEI Calendar events counting for the Team Rankings are all CPEDIs3\* and above, judged by at least 2 Foreign Judges in a Ground Jury of 3, or at least 3 Foreign Judges in a Ground Jury of 5 (i.e. always a majority of Foreign Judges). For the Team Ranking, the best total team results from a maximum of three (3) events are added together, within the above stated period.

Only National teams count for the Rankings. No country may enter more than one team in any event. The teams must consist of a maximum of four and a minimum of three competitors of the same nationality. A Grade Ia, Grade Ib or Grade II athlete must be included in each team, riding the relevant test. Teams shall not include more than 3 athletes from any one grade. The three highest placed athletes, determined by their percentage scores in the Individual Test and the Team Test combined, shall be totaled to determine the final team placings.

Only athletes that are registered with the FEI for the current year, competing on horses registered with the FEI for the current year, will be included within the Rankings.

Three decimal points will be used (if the fourth decimal is 0-4, it does not influence the third one; if it is 5-9, the third decimal is rounded up). In case of equality, the highest percentage per team in the Individual Championship test will be decisive.



## FEI PARA-EQUESTRIAN DRESSAGE WORLD INDIVIDUAL RANKING 2013

The yearly Para Equestrian Dressage World Individual Rankings range from  $1^{st}$  January  $201\underline{3}$  to  $31^{st}$  December  $201\underline{3}$ . Points are not carried over from one year to another and each athlete commences each new year with a score of zero (0).

All CPEDI3\* and above Para Equestrian Dressage FEI Calendar events, judged by at least 2 Foreign Judges in a Ground Jury of 3, or at least 3 Foreign Judges in a Ground Jury of 5 (i.e. always a majority of Foreign Judges) are included within the Rankings. An athlete may compete on more than one horse at an event but can only count the highest placed horse (best result) for points from the event.

The FEI Para-Equestrian Dressage World Individual Ranking list is a ranking list of athletes. The ranking list takes into consideration the  $\underline{six}$  (6) best results/percentage scores of the athlete regardless of the horse.

The Rankings include all Para Equestrian Grades, Ia, Ib, II, III and IV for the Team and Individual Championship tests. The results from the Team test and the Individual test each give points according to the below table (the percentages will count with the first digit behind the comma, for example see ranking points 160-170. The second digit behind the comma does not have any influence on the calculation of the ranking points, e.g. a percentage of 66.701 or 66.799 are both awarded with 167 ranking points). The athlete gains separate points from both tests if he rides both tests. All points are added up on the ranking list.

Only athletes that are registered with the FEI for the current year, competing on horses registered with the FEI for the current year, will be included within the Rankings.

Points for the Rankings are distributed according to the table below.
