TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

Please read carefully before completing the attached entry form. The ACT Open Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the laws of Badminton as adopted by the Badminton World Federation (BWF), except where modified by these conditions or at the discretion of the tournament committee.

All entries must be lodged on official entry forms or via the web form (at www.badmintonact.asn.au). Each player must submit an individual entry form accompanied by the appropriate entry fees.

Payment must accompany the entry form in the following methods:

- Via the web Money transfer. Account details for transfer are available on the web form. Please enter your name as a reference.
- Via the web followed by mail If you cannot do a money transfer, then payment must be made by mail with the entry form before the closing date
- Via mail Payment must accompany the entry form before the closing date

Entries without payment will not be accepted.

Players taking part in the tournament do so at their own risk.

The tournament committee reserves the right to re-grade or reject any entry or combine or cancel events for which insufficient entries are received. The committee has the final say in matters pertaining to the tournament.

Only approved racquets, sports attire, and non-marking shoes may be used by competition players.

Any player not available to play or umpire when so directed, or who otherwise interferes with the successful conduct of the tournament will be disqualified.



Grades

Open, B and C grade players.

Draw

Depending on the number of entries, the draws will be either elimination format or round-robin format as deemed appropriate and will be under the discretion of the Organiser.

In the case of where there are low numbers of entries in the event, a round-robin preliminary elimination method will be used.

Playing Day

Players will be required to play on both Saturday and Sunday, depending on the number of entries.
