At the time of the accident, MCB had a current Certificate of Airworthiness issued by the PNG CAA. The aircraft was configured for 19 passengers and two crewand had a maximum takeoff weight of 5,670 kg. Under PNG CAA rules this aircraft was to be operated under Part 125 'Air Operations - Medium Aeroplanes'.

In addition, MCB was fitted with the required equipment for two-pilot IFR flight
