

Professional ACCA Qualification

The ACCA qualification comprises of two levels (Fundamentals and Professional) which you need to pass in order to qualify as a Chartered Certified Accountant, provided you also complete the Ethics Module and the Practical Experience Requirements (PER):

- The Fundamentals level consists of 9 papers (3 Knowledge and 6 Skills)
- The Professional level consists of 5 papers (3 Essentials and 2 Options)
- The Ethics Module must be attempted before applying for membership. It can be completed once you are eligible to take P1.


Foundations in Accountancy (FIA)

These flexible awards focus on the core skills of financial accounting and management accounting and the wider role of the accountant in business.


