ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

ORDERED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I, SIR JOHN ROBERT KERR, the Governor-General of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approve the following administrative arrangements in substitution for the arrangements in operation immediately before the date of this Order:

1. The matters dealt with by each Department of State include the matters specified in the second column of the Schedule to this Order opposite to the name of that Department in the first column of that Schedule and other matters arising under the enactments administered by the Minister of State administering that Department.

2.
