## **Devon Rex**

The Devon Rex is a cat of unique appearance. Its wavy coat, large eyes, short muzzle, prominent cheekbones and large, low-set ears create the characteristic elfin look.

**HEAD** Short wedge with full-cheeked face. Short muzzle with firm chin and whisker break.

Nose with a strongly marked stop. Forehead curving back to a flat skull.

**EARS** Very large, set rather low, very wide at base, tapering to rounded tops and well covered

with fine fur. Inner ear furnishing sparse. With or without ear muffs.

**EYES** Wide set, large, prominent, oval-shaped and slanting towards outer edges of ears.

**NECK** Neck slender

**BODY AND** Body hard and muscular, broad chest, slender and of medium length. Carried high on

**LEGS** long slim legs. Hind legs slightly longer than front legs.

PAWS Paws small and oval

**TAIL** Long, fine and tapering, well covered with short wavy fur

**COAT** Short and fine, wavy and soft. Crinkled whiskers and eyebrows preferred, coarse and of

medium length.

Many Devon Rex cats have down on their underparts. This should not be interpreted as

bareness.

**EYE COLOUR** Any colour acceptable

**COAT COLOUR** All coat colours acceptable
