QUALIFICATIONS FOR COMPACT FUNDS

In order to qualify for Compact financial assistance, students must meet requirements that are based on the type of post-high school education you are seeking.

Four Year College Requirements

- © 95% Attendance
- © 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA
- © A score of 21 or higher on ACT (990 SAT)
- No major violations of the Student Code of Conduct
 - © Meet requirements for college admission
- © Filed a Financial Aid form (www.FAFSA.ed.gov)

Community College/Job Training Requirements

- © 95% Attendance
- © 2.0 cumulative GPA or higher
- \odot A score of 18 or higher on ACT (900 SAT) or at the 40^{th} percentile on standardize tests in reading and math
 - © No major violations of Student Code of Conduct
 - © Meet requirements for college/job training admission
 - © Filed a Financial Aid form (www.FAFSA.ed.gov)

If you have met all the requirements for Compact college/university or job training assistance, you must compile the requested information, complete the forms for the type of school you plan to attend and send all of the information to the...
