- Electric duct bank construction at Union
- Manhole reconstruction at Madison

Weekend Work:

- Manhole reconstruction at Howell
- Electric duct bank construction at Pine and at Union
- Tree removal

Work Hours:

- Wednesday through Friday
- 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- Saturday 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
 - Loud impact work under a noise variance, including concrete breaking, may begin at 8:00 a.m.
- Sunday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Expect During This Week's Construction:

- Beginning June 6th watch for relocation of the Metro bus stop at Union for southbound passengers. Metro Rider Alerts will be posted at the stop
- On street parking and loading restrictions
- One travel lane in each direction
- Pedestrian detours
- Construction noise, dust and increased truck activity
- Dates of work may change due to weather
