What does the season entail?

The 2011 season is contested over ten weekends, all supporting the British Touring Car Championship (BTCC). There are 20 races throughout the season, with 18 races counting towards the final championship positions. Across the 2010 season, 350,000 people attended the ten rounds, and the ITV coverage reached over 11 million viewers in the UK. This provides the perfect platform for drivers to display their talents and the exposure the championship receives, creates an ideal proposition for potential sponsors.

A typical weekend comprises of the following:

Friday: 2 x 30 minutes testing (optional)
Saturday: 1 x 15 minute free practice
1 x 15 minute qualifying
Sunday: 2 x 15 minute races



How much will it cost?

The Ginetta G40 Junior Championship entry fee includes the following:

- 10 round/20 race championship in support of the BTCC
- Live ITV4 coverage on race days
- Summary footage on ITV1 (Motorsport UK program)
- ITV.com live streaming on race days
- BARC membership
- Championship registration
- Championship race suit
- Hire of an on-board judicial camera

- Race weekend hospitality
