
Monocot and Dicot characteristics

Monocots


one cotyledon (seed leaf)



parallel veins



scattered vascular bundles



stem under a microscope

floral parts in multiples of three



Dicots

two cotyledons (seed leaves)



vascular bundles in a ring



cross section of dicot stem under a microscope

floral parts in multiples of four or five
