

Bert T. Combs Lake

LOCATION AND FACILITIES

Bert T. Combs Lake is located in Clay County approximately 2 miles northeast of Manchester. This lake, owned by the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, was built in 1963 and opened to fishing in 1964. A launching ramp is the only facility available.

THE FISHERY

Species that may be harvested by the angler include largemouth bass, bluegill, channel catfish, and rainbow trout.
