b. 8 Jul 1900 Frankfurt/M
Lived: 1949-55 Frankfurt/M and Neu Isenburg
Died: 15 Jul 55 (suicide)

Camp-following Party member. Former Kriminalrat. WW-II officer commanding a Wehrmacht security police unit (Geheime Feldpolizei-GFP/Kommissar).

Prior 1949, joined ZIPPER's major CI/CE group, Org. 114, Recommended June '49 as one of Germany's most able "criminalists" by ZIPPER for participation in planned political police organization of W. Germany. 1950-53: as head of GV L (Org. 114) regional office in Frankfurt/M, concerned with legal and illegal KP activities and security clearances of contemplated new agent personnel living Hesse and British Zone, his chief was LEIDL, who had many personal contacts to police and Ministry of Interior personnel. Fall '50: leader of GV L district agency BV 2600/NORD with 7 subordinate offices, their mission being security of operations in W. Germany. Early '51: leader BV 2600/NORD, living Neu Isenburg, operating in Hesse area and British Zone with 9 branch offices. Early '52: leader BV 2600/WEST, operating in same area. Apr '53: leader BV 2600, operating area Hesse; but by Dec '53 he was appointed to GV L hqs staff as Co-chief of security and remained leader of WK/Hesse (Waldkapelle: investigative squad) also concerned with special connections in that area. Aug '54: reported as deputy leader of Dienststelle 142 (GV L's new designation), chief of agency security and leader WK/Hesse concerned with special connections, his operating area expanded to W. Germany. During 1950-early '55, Subject was UTILITY's contact to Hesse gov't official Karl A. PFORR, dismissed Jan '55 for using his offices on ZIPPER's behalf. Exposed as an Sfs agent by Herbert BURKHARDT in May '55. Subject was arrested 4 Jul and hanged himself 15 Jul in jail without confessing. Evidence in his home incriminated him as long-time Eastern agent also employed by unidentified American IS in addition to ZIPPER.

ZIPPER Career

? EOD w/Org. 114, ZIPPER's chief CI/CE group.
1949, feb-mar ALBERT assigned as special investigator by Org. 114 to assist Org. 13 re Fall HANNES, case of Rumanian HANNES KLOECKNER @ SCHLURBES, original agent leader of Org. 13 who was arrested and doubled by Rumanian Security Police in mid-'48. In Jan '49 KLOECKNER returned to Austria and contacted Org. 13. ZIPPER report of 14 Sep '49 stated "...he was interrogated for weeks by MALLNER, HACHENBUCHNER and LUDWIG (cover name) from organization LEIDL...it leaked out that 'Hannes' then

confessed...details were strictly withheld from US knowledge for reasons imperceptible, all files and records pertaining to the investigation were kept from anybody but WALLNER, HACKENBUCHNER and LUDWIG. WALLNER and LUDWIG...on several occasions went to Munich, where they had discussions with Dr. KLAUSNER and SCHACK, taking complete files with them. In the end WALLNER, HACKENBUCHNER and LUDWIG in seclusion made up a report...destined for Org. 23."

Ludwig ALBERT (liv. Frankfurt-Sued, Am Wendelsweg 12) was recommended by ZIPPER for participation in the planned political police organization of West Germany; he was described as a former Kriminalrat and WW-II GPP/Kommissar (assigned special cases) and one of Germany's most able criminalists; classified as a camp-following Party member. Slotted for Land Hesse, ALBERT was marked as one of those best fitted and seriously recommended by ZIPPER out of the 35 selected from "11A", a large organization of agents covering Amzone with mission of performing CI functions ensuring security Zipper's op'l communications with Zone; ZIPPER claimed most of these men had worked in the Political Police prior to Hitler's seizure of power, had unobjectionable political backgrounds, and were largely men with professional police experience; their relations with police authorities and other German agencies in the Amzone were claimed to be good and effective; in keeping under surveillance possible points of danger to ZIPPER ops, the group reportedly unearthed considerable material chiefly of political police interest.

Chief, GV L's EV 2600/WORD; his Frankfurt/M hqs a regional office covering Frankfurt-Kassel area, Hesse and British Zone. Main emphasis legal and illegal KP activities and security clearances of contemplated new ZIPPER agent personnel living Hesse or British Zone. His chief, @ LEIDL, has many personal contacts to police and Ministry of Interior personnel. See ANNEX "A" for detailed master list info including staff.

Fnu ALBERT, Gary MILLER, Oskar REILE, fnu ZOELLNER named by Hans Jochem RUDLOFF to RICOG as members of Munich group cooperating with an American intelligence office; RUDLOFF stated he personally knew 3 of them were concerned with CE.

- 1951, feb Arranged contact with Police Vice-President (former director of railways in East Zone) in connection with suspected Communist penetration of Frankfurt/M Police Praesidium, and thereby hoped to clarify situation re Kannkarten procured through Inspektor SCHMIDT of Praesidium.
- " , ? Reported prior June '51 in untdt GV L master list as leader of BV 2600/NORD, living Neu-Isenburg, operating Hesse area and British Zone. See ANNEX "B".
- 1952, feb Reported in untdt GV L master list, rec'd Feb., as leader of BV 2600/WEST, living Neu-Isenburg, operating Hesse area and British Zone. See ANNEX "C".
- " , feb-jul As Chief of GV L's BV WEST (working completely under German cover), Subject returned Opel-Kapitean AN-68-3042 (in which he had an accident 28 Jul 51, details unknown); as Presse-Korrespondent Albert LUDWIG, Neu Isenburg, Rheinstr 80, he purchased on 28 May 52 from Otto GLOECKLER, Frankfurt/M, Darmstaedter Landstr 154, a blue Volkswagen Export, licensed AN-85-4809. He executed 2 papers for ZIPPER: (1) 8 Jul 52, a receipt in which Siegert & Co. GmbH, Industrie-Vertretungen, Mainich 2, Augustenstr 78 appears as source of funds and (2) 17 Jul 52, a contract acknowledging receipt of DM 5,523 and custody of vehicle for his official use.
- " , apr Known to ODFPAL by true name.
- " , " In pay bracket II ('55: av. DM 700-925 monthly) as district agency leader, BV WEST (Frankfurt-Hesse and northern part of Frankfurt/M zone, with 30 agents and informants). See ANNEX "D".
- " , " Reported by ZIPPER to have handled, since early '50, double-agent @ WALTER in CE case UJ-DROLLERY #4; @ WALTER was identified by ZIPPER as Lt. Col. Arthur WEBER and brother-in-law of "45:0 (Maxra HIRLAND)". (Note: This case seemed dead until Jun '54, when @ WALTER was approached by an SRIS courier; Subject, in @ WALTER's absence, was informed by Fran WALTER. ZIPPER decided, in view of control difficulties, not to play the case further.)
- " , may-nov Received tel. calls at his home no. Neu-Isenburg 8692 from 2 ZIPPER cover units, according to intercepted ZIPPER hqs toll slips; also,
- " , sep-nov from 29.2 office in Frankfurt/M, as reported by US officer there.
- 1953 Ludwig ALBERT, Kriminalrat, Frankfurt/M, Wendelsweg 12 still listed in Frankfurt/M City Directory (1953) name section only, probably in error since from the address section it appears Henninger Bräu AG controls the address.
- " , apr Reported in GV L master list as leader of BV 2600, living Neu-Isenburg, operating in Hesse area with a considerably reduced staff. See ANNEX "E".
- " , may-jun Identified as PFORR (see 1950) contact to UTILITY, during interrogation by LfV of Paul SCHEMIDT (former Hesse LfV Chief, dismissed Dec '52), who stated he had personally investigated matter and knew PFORR, at that time Chief LKA, was using that office on

behalf of UTILITY. On 8 Jun 53 PFORR signed Hesse Ministry of Interior order directing him to cease his activities for UTILITY and to discontinue using his office on behalf of UTILITY's org.

- 1953, Jul GV L's report of activities for first half '53 indicated that BV 2600 and Subject were involved in and knowledgeable of ZIPPER's penetration ops against Soviet Mission/Pfm, Polish Society in Germany, Czech Liaison Mission/Pfm; also cases UJ-DROLLERY #112 and #112-D, concerned with SovZone NDFP and Hesse NPD political and psychological warfare ops in and against West Germany, and ZIPPER's most important RIS double agent op; it is presumed likely that Subject knew true names of agents.
- " , dec Reported in GV L organization list as now on agency hqs staff as co-chief of Security for the GV (hqs Karlsruhe) and at the same time leader (living Neu-Isenburg) of WK/Hesse and special connections in that area. See ANNEX "A"
- " , " Accurately identified in DDR press expose on ZIPPER, following which GV L was redesignated as Dienststelle 142.
- 1953-54 ALBERT's neighbors at Neu Isenburg, Rheinstr 13, according to information ZIPPER submitted in connection with the emergency evacuation program, may have been:
BERGER, Georg (V-7856): b. 13.5.06 Kemberg/Bez. Nalle, teletype operator w/D. 161, Darmstadt.
BERGER, Karl-Heinz: b. 28.12.32 Berlin, radio operator w/Sec. 400; reportedly living Nikolaus.
MATTHESS, Otto: b. 14.9.09 Kemberg-Willenberg, driver/courier and substitute air courier to Berlin.
- 1954, Jun Subject's Hesse gov't contact, Karl A. PFORR, appointed Chief of LfV/Hesse. (See 1950 and May 1953).
- " , " Bodo FROMM (Sov agent arrested 27 Jan 55) discovered dead letter drop containing material on ZIPPER presumably originating with a ZIPPER member acting as a penetration agent for a hostile service; agent source virtually identified himself as a member of D. 142, and finger pointed strongly to Subject's chief @ LEIDL.
- " , sep Ludwig ALBERT received duty rail ticket for travel under 7924 Army Procurement Team cover; destination unknown.
- " , aug D. 142 (GV L) organizational list reports Subject now as deputy GV leader, chief of GV security, and also continuing as leader of WK/Hesse with special connection responsibilities. See ANNEX "B"
- 1955, Jan 21 Visited PFORR's office, signed visitors' register as ANDERS but was greeted by PFORR as ALBERT in the secretary's presence; revisited this office 3 days later.

- 1955, Jan 28. PFORR was interrogated by LfV on charge of having (1) denied an LfV official permission to pass certain info on right wing activities to the Ministry of Interior and (2) received ALBERT's visits. PFORR finally admitted charges, and with respect to (2) confessed: 4-5 years' employment by UTILITY, the contact being ALBERT who paid him DM 500 monthly; use of his official offices on UTILITY's behalf before and after being ordered to cease; infrequent transmittal of LKA and LfV info from the Amts themselves but use of office personnel to conduct investigations, surveillances, etc. as assigned by ALBERT; receiving UTILITY's "Auftrag" to investigate certain Hesse Ministry of Interior personnel for alleged rightist ties.
- " , Jan 29 PFORR forced into retirement.
- " , Jan 31 ALBERT's removal from Land Hesse to be requested of UTILITY by LfV.
- " , feb UTILITY told [] that ALBERT had maintained liaison to PFORR when he was head of LKA Hesse but strongly denied ALBERT paid him, later repeating his denial officially to the Hessian government. (Note: subsequently it appears the DM 500 monthly payment could have been SFS or unidentified American IS (?) money.)
- " , mid-may Subject exposed as SFS agent by Herbert BURKHARDT (SFS), arrested Aug '54 for 1945 blackmarketing, now seeking freedom from prosecution in exchange for revelation FedRep persons with Eastern Intelligence contacts. BURKHARDT and his SFS case officer Sam BERGER (see 1953-54) visited Neu-Isenburg 24 Apr '53 and in nearby woods BERGER debriefed ALBERT. BURKHARDT furnished exact personal description of ALBERT, his house and automobile.
- " , Jul 4 Arrested by Security Group; denied treasonable activity on behalf Eastern service; interrogation commenced by SG/BfV/ZIPPER. Incriminating evidence found in his costly home (about which he lied to ZIPPER re financing and which was filled with Persian rugs) included: DM 9,000; film emulsions, Sovzone manufactured microfilm reading device; voluminous files; carbon copies reports (some originating with SAERVECKE); detailed breakdown Amt BLANK and SG personnel; documents and info typed on American type typewriter seemingly prepared for American office,
- all initially indicating that ALBERT:
1. was for some time an Eastern agent (which would explain unresolved question LILI MARLEN/Bodo FROMM-see Jun '54- operation where distinct evidence of source near @ LEIDL;
 2. was possible source of info which turned up in ROERERER revelations;
 3. passed 1953 SG (Sicherungsgruppe) personnel list, unclassified, but ZIPPER apparently unaware he had it;
 4. worked for SFS, ZIPPER and also an unidentified American IS;
 5. submitted his own reports based on material received during past 2 years from Heinrich SCHMIDT, retired Kripo and SD officer who regularly informed ALBERT on his service with a US intel. officer under one Col. THOMAS;

6. had somehow received carbons of reports prepared by Theodor SAEVECKE for another consumer. (Note: SAEVECKE recently stated he and ALBERT had known each other since 1930 when SAEVECKE as instructor and ALBERT as pupil were both at Kolonialschule)
