

How to reach Laubach:

BY PLANE:

Frankfurt International Airport is located approx 80 kilometres south of Laubach. Trains are leaving directly from the airport. Not advisable to rent a car here if you arrive on Friday afternoon or evening because of high traffic on both the highway and country roads.

Airport "Frankfurt-Hahn" is used by lowfare carriers but is appr ox 200 ki I omet r es away. If you rent a car here arriving Friday p.m., take motorway 61 north direction Köln up to Kreuz Koblenz, there you turn East on A 48 passing Koblenz and the river Rhine. At Dernbacher Dreieck go South on A3 direction Frankfurt and leave on exit 42 (Limburg Nord). Go direction Giessen up to the end of Highway 49. Near Gießen turn on A 485 direction Marburg/Kassel and use exit 5 (Licher Strasse). Go direction Lich

and then follow signs to Laubach.

BY TRAIN:

Nearest railway station is Grünberg (only 6 Km away), which can be reached via Giessen. Friedberg and Giessen railway stations are approx 30 Km away.

BY CAR:

From the North: Use A 5 direction Frankfurt and use exit Homberg (Ohm)/Laubach (Exit 6). (Attn: there is another exit called Homberg (Efze) but this is approx 100 Km further north!). Follow signs Grunberg, and from there to Laubach.

From the South: Use A 5 direction Kassel and use exit Giessen Ost/Fernwald (Exit 10) Follow signs to Lich and from there to Laubach

Arriving in Laubach: follow mainroad direction Alsfeld/Schotten. You pass Fire Department building and a traffic light. 300 mtrs further down the street takes a 90° left turn (at hotel "Solmser Hof"), 150 m further you find the town hall (marked as RATHAUS), another 200 metres further the street takes a 90° right turn and you are in the "Schottener Strasse". First building on your left hand (there is a bus station and a parking area in front of it) is the former hospital, where we stay. Entrance is from the rear.

 $Please \ \textit{note:} \ \textit{If you see the ARAL gas-station on your right, you have passed the place!!!!}$

EuroCamp 2006: Only 8 months to go! Pre-registration is due now!



This great event is getting closer and closer, while the planning and preparation makes more and more progress. No WFIS member should miss it! Now is the time to pre-register – please do so in order to help us organize it even better.

The 2006 edition of the EuroCamp will be a unique opportunity to experience a very special camp in one of the most beautiful landscapes in Switzerland, close to the lake of Lauerz, in the heart of our country. Here is some important information about the camp:

- Date: Saturday, July 22nd thru Saturday, July 29th 2006
- **Attendance fee: EUR 105 per person**, including food, wood for fire and for building, a EuroCamp batch, a diversified program for all three age levels and a lot more. The price without food is EUR 75.-, but we recommend everybody to include the food.
- The camp will have four sub-camps; each association and nation can stay together.

Welcome to the WFIS Jamboree 2007

Jamboree is an English word meaning Meeting of Scouts.

From the birth of the Scouting in 1907, the Jamborees has been the form of narrowing hands intercultural, interracially and interlinguistic among hundred and hundred of children and young that attend and they share the living of the Scouting together and in a single place. The first one took place in London, in the year 1920 when Robert Baden Powell was acclaimed as World Scout Chief.

Our federation founded in 1996, carried out the 1st World Jamboree in Denmark in 2002; with the attendance of 850 Scouts of different countries like Denmark, England, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Switzerland and Japan. The traditional Scouts met around of the fire to scream the motto of the event: "Together we are strongest".

This time, corresponds to Latin America represented by the South American Region, the organization of the second version of this event according to the decision in the World Conference of the federation in 2004. Our country COLOMBIA has been chosen as host of this event and in these pages, you will find all the necessary information to attend and share this great camp of adventures with brothers Scouts from all over the world.

When?

The 2nd WFIS World Jamboree will take place from the 7th to July 14th 2007.

Where?

2nd Jamboree will be held in Colombia, South America. The host city will be Medellin.

Where is Colombia?

Colombia is a democratic republic, located in the northern area of South America, bordering whit Panama, Venezuela, Peru and Ecuador.

Is secure travel to Colombia?

Yes is completely secure. The event will get all the necessary security conditions to guarantee the joyful realization of the Jamboree. Know more about the security conditions that this event will bring to all their participants.

How much it cost?

The final price of the event has not still been defined, but the value will be in the range of $\in 60 - \in 80$.

Who's invited?

All affiliated associations to the federation of its 7 regions.
