CLs build community in their residence hall area, serve as a resource to their residents, and assist Residential Life with department processes, in addition to other responsibilities.

The position is truly rewarding and provides excellent experience for any career path. The CL role is an important and impactful one, and so it is important that well qualified individuals occupy the position. Skills and attributes we are looking for in candidates include:

- Excellent communication skills
- Positive, can-do attitude
- Flexibility and willingness to learn
- Team mentality
- Problem solving ability and creativity
- Ability to prioritize
- Initiative and motivation
- Follow-through; ability to complete tasks as requested
- Ability to follow directions
- Attention to detail
- Timeliness (in completing tasks, submitting materials, and arriving to commitments)
- Approachability / 'personable-ness'
- Willingness to make the time commitment

About the Recruitment/Application Process:

There are several steps to the CL selection process, consisting of:

- Interest sessions (optional, but highly encouraged)

 - o Wednesday, Nov. 28, 2012, 8:00 p.m., Ho 101
 - o Thursday, **Jan. 24**, 2013, 6:00 p.m., Ho 101
- Application Completion/Submission
 - DUE IN HARDCOPY TO RESIDENTIAL LIFE BY MONDAY, JANUARY 28TH, 2013, 5:00 p.m.
 - o Please type applications; handwriting is discouraged
 - o Application must be accompanied by a current copy of the candidate's resume
 - Application must include two (2) completed recommendation forms, provided with the application.
 - One recommendation form is to be completed by a current or previous CL who is able to speak on behalf of the candidate; the second form is to be completed by a professional Colgate employee who is able to speak on behalf of the candidate. Only the two required *forms* will be considered; written letters or additional recommendations will not be reviewed. Recommendation forms must be submitted directly by the candidate, not the recommender, in a signed, sealed envelope along with the application. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that all application materials are submitted together and in their entirety. We recommend that candidate's give their recommenders ample time for form completion, sufficient notice, reminders if necessary, and thanks.

• Application Review

Candidates who pass the initial screening will be invited to attend a mandatory group
process interview; those who do not pass the initial screening will be removed from the
process at this time. All candidates will be notified of their status by Feb. 1, 2013.

• Group Process Interviews

- Candidates who are invited to a group process interview will attend one of two date options: Wednesday, Feb. 6, 2013, 6:00 8:00 p.m.; or Friday, Feb. 8, 2013, 5:00 7:00 p.m.
- Candidates who pass the group process interview will be invited to attend an individual interview; those who do not pass the initial screening will be removed from the process at this time. All candidates will be notified of their status by **Feb. 12**, 2013.

• Individual Interviews

- Candidates who are invited to an individual interview will visit the Residential Life Office in Drake Hall between Wednesday, **Feb. 13 15**, 2013, 8:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m., to sign up for an interview slot.
- o Interviews will occur the week of **Feb. 18 22**; interviews will be scheduled for an hour, and will be conducted by 2-3 current Residential Life staff members

Notification

All candidates will be notified of their status by Friday, **March 1**, 2013 at 5:00 p.m. Successful candidates who have been selected for a CL position will be notified of their placement at this time. Candidates who have been offered a position will need to accept or decline their position in writing by Tuesday, **March 5**, 2013, at 5:00 p.m.
