## CASUALTY STATISTICS AND INVESTIGATIONS

## Very serious and serious casualties for the year 2001

- The Sub-Committee on Flag State Implementation (FSI), at its eighth (24 to 28 January 2001) and tenth (8 to 12 April 2002) sessions, agreed that the lists of very serious and serious casualties to be investigated as soon as identified, using the data received from Rescue Co-ordination Centres (RCCs) in the form of situation reports (SITREPs) and other sources, should be prepared in the form of FSI circulars and made available, together with other casualty-related data, in an electronic format on the IMO web server (FSI 8/19, paragraph 11.17 and FSI 10/17, paragraphs 9.18 and 9.21).
- The Marine Environment Protection Committee, at its forty-third (19 to 28 May 1999) and forty-eighth (7 to 11 October 2002) sessions, and the Maritime Safety Committee, at its seventy-first (19 to 28 May 1999) and seventy-sixth (2 to 13 December 2002) sessions, endorsed the Sub-Committee's instruction to the Secretariat to publish information on casualties on the IMO website after its content has been agreed by the FSI Sub-Committee (MSC 71/23, paragraph 10.3, MEPC 43/21, paragraph 8.6, MEPC 48/21, paragraph 9.3.17 and MSC 76/23, paragraph 9.7).
- Attached, as annex 1, is a list of selected "very serious" and "serious casualties" for the year 2001.
- 4 Two additional annexes containing:
  - statistics on "very serious" and "serious casualties", which occurred during the period 1995 to 2001 (annex 2), and
  - maps showing the location of casualties involving collisions, contacts, strandings, groundings and severe pollution for the year 2001 (annex 3)

will be issued separately, as an addendum, based on the population of records attached to this circular at the time of issuance. These two annexes containing statistical data and maps will not be updated following the procedure explained in paragraph 5 below.

5 The information contained in the electronic version of the circular will be updated when additional information becomes available and is recorded in IMO's relevant databases.
