President's Report

Well, what a year 2011 turned out to be!! 3 teams Minor Premiers, 6 teams in Semi Finals, 4 in Grand Finals, and of course the 1st Grade Premiership as reward for a record breaking year.

Congratulations firstly to our Colts, who were Runners Up in both 1st and 2nd Grade. 3rd Grade were Minor Premiers, but ran into a pretty hot University team one week short of the big one. Grand Final day at Forshaw was a pretty bleak affair, and didn't suit us, but we are proud of the way the boys played, and of the excitement they provided during the season.

Colts are a great barometer of the strength of the Club in the coming years, and to the players, all coaches, managers and support staff I say a huge thanks and well done. For those moving into Grade Rugby, please be assured that it is just as much fun, and that we need you.

In recent years, our Lower Grades have been a weakness at Eastwood. In 2011, we saw resurgence in both 3rd and 4th grade. Whilst the 4ths would have liked a few more wins, it was nice to see them competitive again after a few lean seasons. To Coaches Tyler, Blacker and Kirkby, a big thank you. Fourth Grade is tough, and it is important that we are strong. We can't win the Club Championship without you guys, and I reckon we are getting there.

Chairman's Report

The 2011 year was a very successful one for the Club and was in a large part a result of a range of initiatives that have been put in place over the last few years. These include the role of Director of Rugby, a dedicated first grade coach and a Colts Coaching coordinator. I will detail more on these later in this report but the results speak for themselves.

- o 2nd in the Club Championship (up from 5th in 2010)
- Three teams minor premiers (1st Grade, 2nd Grade and 3rd Grade Colts)
- Six of our seven teams semi finalists (1st, 2nd and 3rd Grade, plus 1st, 2nd and 3rd Colts)
- Four of our teams were grand finalists (1st and 2nd Grade, plus 1st and 2nd Colts)
- o Premiers in 1st Grade

Director of Rugby and Coaching Structure

A key initiative that the Board undertook in 2010 was to strengthen the Club by creating a new position, Director of Rugby, to oversee the operations of all teams and all players and to ensure that the production line of talent which has long been a strength of Eastwood rugby, continues well into the future. The Director of Rugby is an unpaid role and has been very ably filled by Graeme Harrison since 2010. Graeme, as well as being a member of the Board has also been the second grade coach and this year coached the team to the grand final. He has nonetheless very ably fulfilled the broader role as Director of Rugby and worked closely with John Manenti in first grade, along with all other coaches throughout the Club to ensure a quality, coordinated and successful rugby program was delivered in 2011. The results outlined above speak for themselves and I would like to thank all the coaches and support staff that made this possible, in particular the lower grades that had significantly improved performances compared with the previous year.

A key part of the establishment of the Director of Rugby role was that it allowed the first grade coach to

concentrate on our flagship team and the outstanding success of the team in 2011 reflected the benefits of this. Having said this, John Manenti understands the importance of a strong and successful club comes from all teams and was very generous with his time and efforts in this regard with support for all aspects of the club.



Another key appointment was that of Ian Moyes as the Colts Coaching coordinator in 2010 and again in 2011. Ian has also been the first grade colts coach since that time. Ian has built on the great work of 2010 and has once again done a wonderful job in building a strong structure and a very positive culture in colts, and this was reflected in the successes on the rugby field in 2011. The work that Ian and all the Colts coaching team have done will be a key to ensuring the future strength of Eastwood Rugby as these boys move into the grade ranks over the next couple of years. 2011 has already seen the benefit of this with improved results in our lower grades

Sponsorship

Sponsorship is always a challenge for rugby clubs such as Eastwood. After a couple of lean years in this regard, we were fortunate to now have three major sponsors in NRRSL, FilterTex Media and the Bayview Boulevard Hotel.

NRRSL has been a long standing partner and supporter of the Club. I would particularly like to thank Barry Herbert and his Board for their unwavering support.

Our long time supporter Craig Perkins continued his support with his new company FilterTex Media. Craig's sponsorship provided much needed financial stability to the Club so we are very grateful to Craig and FilterTex.

We were also fortunate to have a new sponsor come on board in 2011. The Bayview Boulevard Hotel has provided wonderful support throughout the year; Dave Stavert and his team have also been keen fans throughout the year.

It is also important to note that our other long term sponsors have also largely continued their commitment to the Club, and their ongoing support is equally important to our success. On behalf of all at Eastwood Rugby I would like to thank them all for their enthusiasm and ongoing commitment.

To all our sponsors and supporters, we trust that you gained a great deal of personal satisfaction from knowing the large extent to which you contributed to our great success this year.

Finance

Despite the support from our sponsors, Eastwood Rugby overall operates on about half the revenue of some other Sydney clubs and well below that of the majority of our peers. Nonetheless, the Club continues to punch above our weight. Clearly having the right culture, people, structure and attitude are the necessary requirements for a successful rugby club.

Although operating on a lesser budget than 2010, the Club finished the financial year with a small operating loss of approximately \$11k. In a perverse outcome, this was a result of winning all but one of our games in first grade during the year Whilst admittedly the net position is once again modest, it is nonetheless proves that the Club can operate in an environment of fiscal constraint and still be highly competitive on the field. The success on the field this year, particularly by the first grade team, has brought increased interest from potential sponsors.

Apart from cutting our expenditure, we were able to meet our financial commitments through a number of other means

It has also be a great opportunity to renew and maintain the many friendships developed through our association with Eastwood Rugby. Whilst there has been a promising start to the Friends of Eastwood, there is great opportunity to build on this important initiative for the future success of Eastwood Rugby.

Governance and Volunteers

I would like to thank and acknowledge the efforts of a number of people. My fellow board members, President Brett Papworth, Ian Williams, Sam Manion, Geoff Garland, Graeme Harrison and Russell Gunn for their focus and commitment. Rob Frost has once again done a wonderful in the role of General Manager. Rob has been invaluable in the role and has ensured that Eastwood Rugby Club is always presented as a highly professional rugby club, and continues to be seen as one of the leaders in the Sydney Club Rugby both on and off the field.

In particular I would like to acknowledge the efforts of all the people who volunteer their time and skills for the Club. It is one of our major strengths and it's a wonderful part of the culture of our Club. It is a fact however that now we have a smaller number doing much more, so we need more volunteers. I trust all our players recognise and appreciate that without them, Eastwood Rugby Club would simply not operate.

Our off the field activities, particularly the major functions during the year, continue to be important for our members and supporters as well as providing vital additional revenue. The key function once again was the very successful Eastwood Legends Dinner where we were entertained by 'Slammin' Sam Kekovich and our first world cup winning team members from 1991, Wallaby greats; captain Nick Farr-Jones and our very own Marty Roebuck. It was a wonderful evening and has become a much anticipated event in the rugby calendar as well as being a great showcase for the Club.

The All Stars Night held after the last round of the competition to recognise the efforts of our players and our teams was again a highlight.

The Future

Once again we will be entering a year of uncharted territory in 2012. As well as an extended Super 15 season which will mean the Club is without many our representative players the majority of the season, there is likely to be a change in the format of the club competition with a reduced number of rounds. Rumours of a national club competition also continue to circulate adding to the level of uncertainty.

We will of course remain absolutely focused on keeping the Club viable through a combination of strong cost control and judicious, highly targeted and strategic expenditure. We continue to seek major sponsors for 2012. In addition to this the Board also continues to explore options that will provide a sustainable platform for the Club that will allow it to grow and continue its success into the future and build on the outstanding year the Eastwood Rugby has had on the field in 2011.

In this regard Eastwood Rugby needs to develop a viable business model moving forward if we are to maintain success on the field. To highlight the problem with an example, in 2001 the club had approximately 1,000 members. The numbers have progressively dropped to a point where in 2011 the Club has less than 200 members. As a consequence and despite a stellar year on the field where excellent crowds were achieved, gate takings have fallen from \$32,000 in 2010 to \$19,000 in 2011. The Board will be exploring a number of options to address this matter which is critical to the Club's future.

Eastwood 1st Colts: Consecutive Grand Finals, Third on the table in the Minor Premiership and heading up a Colts Club which acquitted itself meritoriously in all departments in 2011.

But the real story is in the way this team played and statistics help to illustrate that story. Scoring 906 points to 479, with an average game score of 36-19 and 5.6 tries per game, the team was adventurous and enterprising at all times. Alex Del Moro scored an amazing 28 tries in the 23 games and he also played in every minute of every game. Other top try scorers include Blake Sutton 11, Bruce Satiu 10, Jed Gillespie 9, Tannous Ferris 9 and Brad Curtis 9.

We played our rugby with a mix of forward skill and power and expansive back play, developing various attacking methods to make it difficult for our opponents to contain us. That worked. Our defence was resilient and herculean at times, but we quite regularly slipped up and allowed too many tries against us. But that is probably the trade-off for our high risk style of play.

Our most impressive games were: 41-10 v Easts away and 50-plus scores against Warringah, Souths, Norths, Wests & Parramatta (twice); a ridiculous 37-all draw with Gordon; an amazing 6-tries-all 36-43 loss to Uni away in which we scored 36 straight points in the second half; a total rout (62-3) of West Harbour in the Semi and then a highly impressive 36-27 Final victory over Manly. The Grand Final was not our best game, affected by illness and played in very wet conditions not conducive to our style, but Uni's professionalism and efficiency were undeniable.

Throughout the season the pack off Gillespie, Ferris, Lagudi, Shore, White, Larkin, Shewan, Berndt and Kent was dominant, skilful and aggressive, winning quality ball and attacking with flair and telling effect. The back line of Lewthwaite, O'Connor, Sefuiva, Sutton, Satiu, Del Moro, Tamone and Curtis cut opponents to shreds with their exhilarating play.Thanks to Manager Chris, Co-ordinator Paul, Physio Pat and Bee, Veronica and our other assistants for their sterling work. Coaches Moyes & Moore congratulate this team on their outstanding season and thank the Club for the opportunity and its support.

This year saw an influx of new players into the Colts ranks with a lot of the guys having their first season with Eastwood Colts. In 2nd Grade particularly it took some time for the new players to adjust to the way we wanted to play the game and settling on a stable line up took some time with a number of new players being tested. By mid season we were able to achieve a steady line up and the boys worked hard on their skills and structure.

The last 2 months of the season, the business end, the boys played some outstanding football beating very good opposition who were also vying for semi finals places. 

NOTE 1 - STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW) 1984. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW) 1984 and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

AASB 1031 Materiality; and

AASB 110.21 Events Occurring After Balance Date

No other Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report is prepared on an accruals basis. It is based on historic costs which do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non current assets.

The following material accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report:

a) Amortisation

Leasehold improvements, at cost or valuation, are amortised at a rate of 4% per annum based upon their expected useful economic lives, using the prime cost method.

b) Depreciation

All assets, excluding leasehold improvements, are depreciated over their useful lives or at depreciation rates set by the Commissioner of Taxation. Equipment is depreciated at 20% per annum, using the written down value method.

c) Inventories

All inventories are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost includes direct materials and is assigned to individual items of stock mainly on the basis of average cost.

d) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from Income Tax in accordance with Section 50-45 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

e) Comparative Period *

The comparative period noted in the Income & Expenditure Statement relates to the fifteen (15) month period ended 30th September, 2010.
