

ON THE PURITY OF THE TECH

In the open letter that I wrote in July of this year, I mentioned my concern for the purity and standardness of the tech, and for what appears to be a corruption of the tech. I thought I'd amplify on that with some fairly recent examples.

Over the years from 1978 on up to PT there have been some changes in the grade chart. These started with the announcement of people going Clear on NED, and the subject of Dianetic Clear. After the initial wave of attests I began to notice what might be called simply false attests; large numbers of people were being sent to attest to Clear who hadn't in fact made Clear. Unfortunately, some of these people went on to the OT levels and had a hard time, indeed.

This brings us to the purpose of auditing. The purpose of auditing *isn't* so that one can get a piece of paper, obviously, and it isn't so that one can have different numbers assigned to one. The purpose of auditing is to make gains in life and livingness, and to attain what we could call theta abilities. In short, to *increase abilities*.

Over the years there have been several times when the real purpose of auditing has been set aside, and we've had what is called a "quickie era." Each time that has happened, it has resulted in people's reaching a higher level on the grade chart than what they have actually attained as a being, and invariably there have been a large number of people dissatisfied about lack of results. This is disastrous, both because the person has been cheated out of the gains he should have made, and because he is then a poor example to others.

Since approximately 1979, there have been various waves of Clear attests; some were valid, and some were not. There was an HCOB in 1979 in which the subject of Natural Clear was first introduced, and although that issue said that they were very, very rare, within a few months literally hundreds of people attested to it. It would not matter at all to me if each of these people were a natural clear. What does matter is that if these people came to get auditing to handle the reactive mind, and someone then *mislead* them into thinking they were a natural clear, they would then skip the processes that would have handled the things they *needed handled*.

This makes the entire subject appear to be without real value, to others, because they look at somebody suddenly attesting to this and that, and the next thing you know he's called "an OT 3." It can be quite a bad example if the person does not in fact have the abilities he should have.

Quickies occurred in the late 60's and early 70's. On 21 June 1970, in an HCOB called *Superficial Actions*, LRH stated that there is a point where speed is simply a cover for a cheap, worthless product, and he goes on to give an example of

somebody saying, "Yes, but we sell results. If we can get 200 PC's done in 100 auditing minutes, we would make 18,233 pounds clear profit." He goes on in the HCOB to more or less, say "Well, the cruel answer to that was when orgs begain to do that on lower grades they didn't attain the result on the PC and stats went down. Quickie grades, instead of making fortunes for one and all, crashed the whole Scientology network, because quickie results are lazy and dishonest. Let's just face up to the facts of life: selling out the integrity of the subject for a buck wrecks the subject."

Now there is an SO ED #2379 International, dated November, 1983, which was not written by Ron, it was written by Services Exec International and Senior C/S International. It states that, "At the lower levels of the Bridge, introductory services, the routes on to the Bridge, grades 0-4, NED, right up to Clear, *the route is very very fast*, and looking at the chart you can see that the distance from the first services up to Clear is a short one too." This issue is entitled "Questions and Answers on the New Grade Chart."

Another issue, dated 2 Oct. 83, states that in the instance where a person has started OT 1, yet has not attained the lower levels, (called a bypassed case), the person could be put back on some lower action that was not honestly attained after he finished OT 3. It says it is very important that the person gets these actions, but at the same time we have this "Questions and Answers on the New Grade Chart" that says that it's very very quick. I feel that this heralds another era, with compromises of technical integrity.

All too often we have seen people who are OT 3 or OT 7 in name only, and I feel that we should put an end to that sort of thing.

I'm sure you all know that things can be changed by shifting definitions of words. There is an HCOB of 23 Oct. 1983, which says "The auditor technically is not interested in CONFIDENCES OR OVERTS AGAINST GROUP'S ENEMIES OR WITHHOLDS THEREOF. He's looking for overts against a group, as above, and the withholding of having committed them, by omit or commit." This is quite important as far as the maintaining of the purity and standardness of the tech is concerned. That HCOB is purportedly written by LRH, but LRH said, in the Technical Dictionary, there are three definitions for an overt: 1) an overt act is not just an injuring someone or something. An overt act is an act of omission or commission which does the least good for the least number of dynamics or the most harm to the greatest number of dynamics. 2) an intentionally committed harmful act committed in an effort to resolve a problem. 3) That thing which you do which you aren't willing to have happen to you.

This recent HCOB shifts the definition of a "real overt" to something contrary to the mores of the group. The statement that "The auditor technically is not interested in confidence or overts against a group's enemies or withholds thereof" I feel is a very serious point of technical integrity. It will affect the case gain of PC's generally because if

people don't get off harmful acts, they won't feel the relief and betterment from having confessed them. The door is open here to give license to people to commit harmful actions, provided that they are considered all right by the person's associates. Historically and philosophically there are a tremendous number of precedents for this. Every major war of a religious or holy nature has always been justified by the idea that it was okay to do harmful things to other people if they weren't part of your group. This sounds like a re-introduction of the old "Fair Game Law." Is it really an LRH issue?

Strictly on the basis of decency and honesty, and on the basis that a thetan is basically good, this shift in definition is one to be abhorred, not upheld.

As a final note, I urge you to maintain the purity of our religion and its doctrines and technology as it was originally written by Ron so that we can continue to set people free and not get involved in entrapment. That is part of the reason I am here, and doing what I am doing.

ON SQUIRRELS AND NUTS...

It seems that the "STAMP OUT SQUIRRELS COMMITTEE" (or RTC) has found it necessary to malign the character and technical integrity of the AAC by publishing out-of-context or fabricated statements. Of course.

We have included first the STAMP OUT SQUIRRELS (SOS) statement, in italics, followed by what David *really* said during a SUNDAY TALK. We believe you will find their tactics interesting. And recall, if you will, the number of times the Church has screamed about malicious distortions of the truth that the press has been responsible for.

S.O.S.: The basics of production and exchange as outlined by Ron in the Factors, and education towards application which is stressed in Ron's study tapes is negated by Mayo. Instead Mayo states that he thinks it is vital to do training 'for the sake of getting the data' only.

David Mayo: I hope that what will come about is that more people will start getting trained. Partly because I'd like to see a lot more people auditing and C/Sing and supervising, but quite aside from that, I think it's vital to get training simply for the sake of the data itself.

S.O.S.: With the aplomb of a hangman, Mayo says that duty and allegiance are not something one should stick oneself with. Now that is something we can understand Mayo saying.

David Mayo: There's a lot of investment of one's self into the organization and into making it go and helping to create it. And so one feels very much a part of it; and one wants to see it survive, and one wants to see it succeed. So when something happens that is untoward or unethical, one would rather not - is it and keep on going for the plus-points that exist in it. And I feel mainly out of a sense of duty and having given one's allegiance to the group, one feels that one shouldn't oppose the group. But this argument of always being

loyal to a group that one has given one's allegiance to of course is not something that someone should stick oneself with....If a group starts off with a constructive goal and one supports it, that's a good thing. If one later finds out, or if the group later changes and starts acting along a destructive goal, or towards destructive ends, then one has to re-evaluate one's allegiance and duty. And I feel that that too is a principal that the less ethical tend to use over the more ethical members of the group....One owes one's allegiance to the goals and purposes that one subscribed to.

S.O.S.: LRH's goal of clearing the planet which inspired the first readers of Book One back in the '50's and still acts in 1984 as an inspiration to thousands of Scientologists, is said by Mayo to be too steep a gradient. With subtle inval of the OT abilities inherent in every one of us and Mayo 's mall think' he postulates a target of first coming to people then teaching them the ARC triangle and then who knows somewhere up the line they may possibly go clear. We wouldn't want to rush things, would we.

With complete oblivion to the fact that there are Scientologists involved in every walk of life, in every strata of society, on every Continent, Mayo accuses all Scientologists of individuating from society.

David Mayo: I've heard people express, and I've felt this way myself, that the goal of clearing the planet is somewhat distant, and possibly a little unreal, as an immediate goal. Not that I think there's anything wrong with the idea, but it is a little far-flung, and it's often desirable to have goals or targets that one can reach in the near future, and something that one can work towards and see actual accomplishments on....While I don't want to dwell too much on the errors of the past, there has been over the years an increased individuation of Scientologists and Scientology from what was called 'the public,' or from society,

which I consider to have been quite a bad thing. If we were busy saying that we wanted to help people, and to clear the planet, then the idea of individuating and becoming different from other people tends to get in the way of that as a major barrier. So, I think there should be "a getting rid of," of any ideas about the idea that the other members of society in which we live are 'wogs' or 'raw meat' or whatever---partly because many of them are very capable people, but simply that that tends to preclude having ARC with them first.... The idea is first getting back into ARC with people generally and with society, and then finding ways and means in which we can raise the tone level of that society. So, in the long run I'm sure that we would end up, at that rate, with a cleared planet. S.O.S.: *In a cunning twist Mayo states: It's* people's innate decency that prevents them stopping out-ethics behavior in others. (If this logic holds true guess we'd have to admit that Mayo and his merry band at the AAC are extremely 'decent fellows.'

David Mayo: Some of the sec checks that were being done by people who were normally good auditors and good sec checkers, but particularly were basically good, decent Scientologists....

During one of the sec checks there were three people in a room with one person, and in the middle of the sec check they decided he wasn't coming clean and so one of the executives there picked this guy up (the guy that was being sec checked) and bashed him into the wall several times. And then they dumped him back into the chair and proceeded on with the sec check....In order to have stopped it they would've had to have gotten in some kind of heavy action themselves, like grabbing the guy that was doing the physical stuff, and they would have had to have grabbed him and probably done something physical as well as to stop this beating up from occurring.... They felt that that wasn't the right way to act....I saw a lot of staff members who didn't like things

that way to act....I saw a lot of staff members who didn't like things that were going on and would actually raise objections to them from time to time, even if not strongly enough. But because of the amount of pressure coming down on them, and the various threats and so on, and mainly, I feel, because of their own innate decency, they didn't take sufficient action to put a stop to it or to say 'no' to it.

S.O.S. 'You can't say that people can always operate on what's best for the first and the third dynamics but within reasonable limits they should' (makes one wonder what Mayo's 'reasonable limits' are).

David Mayo: You can't say that people should always operate on the basis of what's good for the first dynamic, nor should they always operate on the basis of what's good for the third dynamic, but within reasonable limits, if the person enhances himself as an individual and improves himself as an individual, he will be a better group member, and the group will be that much better off for it.

BASIC PURPOSE

The basic purpose has always been to change conditions for the better, to create a better civilization, to disseminate knowledge, to eliminate the scourges of insanity, criminality and war and make the universe a more decent and fun place to live. These should be the purposes being worked towards with renewed vigor.

When I recently read in the Advanced Ability Center's journal about Bill Franks working his way up the commodities market, Carl Barney doing well in real estate and Peter Green starting a new, multi-level marketing program I thought "Where has the purpose gone that AAC thinks this is what its readership is interested in?"

There is nothing wrong with anyone doing these things to earn a living or to amass some material wealth. But, where our attention should be as a group · what we should be talking and reading about · is what we can and will do to improve conditions and fulfill our sense of mission and responsibility. The failure of the Scn movement to do this adequately over the past decade may be more responsible for its current condition than we realize.

The US President and other leaders have been mounting massive campaigns to improve the excellence of education; the President's wife is heading up the largest drug abuse program ever seen; even an offshoot of EST is running a program to get military leaders and peace movement activists into better communication so they blow the ridges between them and find pan-determined solutions to maintaining military security while reducing the chances of war.

We should be out in the midst of all these kinds of activities, contributing our knowledge of study tech, of drug withdrawal methods, of data evaluation, etc. Frankly, I don't think the question of whether we do it overtly as Scn or not is as important as the fact that we help improve conditions. And when, by our contribution and results, we have earned the right to do so, we can move from the midst of these activities to their forefront and genuinely spearhead the evolution to a new civilization.

I think the priority is to concentrate our energies on basic purpose, to reconnect up to society and our mission in it, to out-create the entheta by doing so. We can generate new organizational forms around these purposes and programs as they grow, and not otherwise worry too much about them.I think we should get out there and regain our integrity and respect with the world by doing an awful lot of good with what we know. I think we should have a lot of fun doing so and give each other as much support as we can in these efforts. The field groups and newsletters could serve as communication and resource centers to help people do this and be invaluable in this role. If we put our attention back onto the society and doing important things out there in acceptable, effective and determined ways, I think a tremendous amount of good will come of all we have gone through in, the last few years.

Anyone of us can do this by simply choosing an area that excites us, that is close to our *own* purpose, and by beginning energetically to apply the non-existence formula and all our tech and good sense to it.

This is my position - not to Q and A with entheta, but to engulf it with creation and results along the line of basic purpose; to do what we were advised to do in a brighter moment and that is - TO FLOURISH AND PROSPER.

SOME TRUTHS AND CONSEQUENCES

The last few years have been sad and enturbulating times for a great many of us. Our dreams for greater awareness and freedom were moved out of our reach by psychotic pricing, mad dog management, and junta-style justice. The hopeful being went begging for a channel and a chance.

Many beings now find themselves, understandably, in grief and sub-pathy on the whole subject. After spending huge sums of money and/or a large portion of their lives in pursuit of enhancement and a better world they now find themselves adrift and a bit numb.

These recent experiences have led some to wonder if the tech even works. Others have resigned themselves to the idea of never having another session again and never again getting any training. Why? How have we reached this situation?

Organizational actions over the last couple of years have resulted in massive, widespread failed purposes, ARC breaks, and vicious "can't have" run on all of us worldwide.

In the cross-currents of enturbulation it is so easy to confuse the organization and current management with the tech itself. In fact, there has been much propaganda that they are one and the same although nothing could be farther from the truth. This might be likened to denying Newton's Laws of Motion because one fell down or one disliked some personal peculiarities of their discoverer.

Happily, we need not be confused or misled any longer. There is a sequence which runs from oppression to disillusionment to hope. The tech can and does stand alone, and it will outlive any current politics or personality cults. And ironically, when divorced from the atrocities and out-tech of the system that held the tech (and beings) en-

trapped, the tech works far better than before. The tech can fly pure and free when released from the claptrappings of a rigid, authoritarian system. And so can you. The possibility for hope, help and happiness are restored. The monopoly is now irrevocably and forever broken. As John Naisbitt pointed out in *Megatrends*, networking is tumbling down the old pyramidal hierarchies.

Most everyone recognizes that they have had real wins in auditing and training in the past, although these wins may sometimes be' hard to recall through the haze of bypassed charge over recent events. But such wins can be yours again! Many are currently finding these and greater wins at the AAC. You may have forgotten what a safe environment is like but you can find it here. Relief, recovery and grand new wins are a daily occurence around our place. Come and see for yourself.

HAPPINESS

In the last several years many Scientologists have seen the barriers to their dearest goals become more and more numerous, less and less predictable. The barriers seemed to become unknowable. No one, it seemed, could predict what the "trolls under the bridge" would put up next. Our attention was forcibly focused on the barriers rather than the goal or the freedoms of the game, which gave rise to the feeling that we were not free.

Once one has withdrawn from that group, however, one discovers that the freedoms of the game are vast and delightful, and that the barriers are few and know-able, and easily overcome. I am now 34, I have been an auditor since I was 17, and a Class VIII since I was 20. I have discovered to my great joy and relief that the basic barrier is the charge on the PC's case, which I take delight in helping him/her overcome. I have also rediscovered that auditing is *never* an overt. A dear friend, John Galusha, pointed out to me that any auditor's first job is just to get charge off the case; not to keep perfect' records, not to report to Qual, not to perfect his E-Meter drill #22, not to report the PC's overts - just to get charge off. Once the auditor knows he can do that, then he can work on improving his skill. I've rediscovered auditing without fear. After years of training and experience I had fallen into the belief that my auditing would never be worth much because whatever auditing I did this year would be proven wrong next year. The "quickie grades" I ran in '67 were an overt, the Int RDs I did in '71 were an overt, the HSDC and NED I ran on fellow OTs was an overt the list is endless. Now, with the invaluable help of two validative and encouraging CSes (Russ Meadows and David Mayo), I have rediscovered the freedoms of auditing, and the simple purposes of, "Let's get some charge off the case. Let's convert some entheta to theta. Let's restore some

potential to this being." It's a lovely and rewarding way to spend an afternoon.

There were so many freedoms lost over the years that are now returning. One is the freedom to be loyal to our friends, openly. Who among us has not abandoned old friends because they were not instantly smitten with the truth of Scientology? Or because they had made someone's "blacklist"? Or because they urged us to live better, to earn more money, to read more books, to engage in the many games of which the official Church disapproved? Somehow loyalty to the Church made it all right, even necessary, to hurt the feelings of many people of good will. I have regained the freedom to re-connect to those who were dear to me, to mend my fences, to regain my friends' trust. My affinity level has shot up. I am free to admire and enjoy people of skill, of intelligence, of worth, regardless of their religious affiliation or case level. In short I am free to use my Grade 0 abilities, to communicate freely with anyone about anything.

Another newly rediscovered freedom is the freedom to learn, to be curious, to explore the works of earth's other geniuses - to admit that there are and always have been other geniuses. History is largely the story of geniuses and their effects, and followers. If younger Scientologists had been versed in the religious history of this planet we might not now be forced to repeat it. I don't know of any great religion or movement in history which escaped political in-fighting, corruption and eventual schism. Scientology is an aid to learning about and living life, not a substitute for it, any more than automobile owner's manual is a substitute for the car. ence, explore, improve, share, and generally inhabit responsibly. The isolation which many Scientologists, especially staff, subject themselves to is counter-productive and unnecessary.

Sitting with some friends, the other day, lamenting the fact that the young messengers/RTCers that are now running the Church have never had any real world experience, and thus have no real understanding of the vast majority of the occupants of this planet of ours; and thus the inevitability of the "us and them" game, the dedicated Sea Orger versus "those wogs"

"All active mass movements strive to interpose a fact-proof screen between the faithful and the realities of the world. They do this by claiming that the ultimate and absolute truth is already embodied in their doctrine and that there is *no* truth nor certitude outside it. The facts on which the true believer bases his conclusions must not be derived from his experience or observation, but from holy writ.

There is a hypnotic command loose among the majority of Scientologists.

Let's look at an example of the workings of this command. Take Joe--he knows LRH doesn't make a mistake and LRH knows more than he does. So Joe doesn't think, doesn't even bother to learn, about the subject of communism. He doesn't read Marx, he doesn't look at Russia or China. He knows that communism is bad because LRH says so and thats good enough for Joe. Joe never looks into anything else, not eskimos, not tahitians, not anything. He "already knows" that all these things are wrong because LRH says so. I don't mean to say that LRH is incorrect or that I approve of these two subjects, just that Joe has shut his thinking process down to some degree. He can't achieve greater awareness because he can't think and he is much less self-determined because

Could this happen to you? Have you ever squelched an idea of yours because LRH didn't agree or you thought LRH wouldn't agree. Have you ever accepted something LRH has said without really thinking about it?

I just completed the C/S course and apprenticeship at the AAC. I feel very competent to C/S anything from DCSI through Advanced Level Four.

C/Sing is for the pc---this is so obvious that it should never even have to be stated. But this datum can be (and sometimes has been) devaluated in the past. One example would be in going along with executive pressure, like giving a registrar special confessionals and money processes in the middle of Grade 0 to "get the GI up." Less obvious would be

C/Sing while having considerable attention on "How will this look when the pc folder goes on up to AOLA?"--or "If a tech mission ever gets ahold of this, will they bust me?"

So mainly what has happened here at AAC is that I've unstuck my viewpoint from 1976 (when I last C/Sed in an org) and realized that:

1. C/Sing is for the pc;

2. You audit the pc *with* a process, not a process on a pc

3. When the pc or preot has EP'd on a level, they've EP'd, and you do *not* do "a little more to make sure;"

4. A pc or preot audited in a totally safe environment and handled with ARC and *without* pressure can honestly complete a level with full EP and a rave success story in a remarkably shorter time than the same pc or preot would complete in an enturbulated and tension-filled environment. (This seems like a stupid observation as I write it, but I needed to say it).

Thanks to LRH for putting out the tech in such a complete and workable form and to David Mayo for keeping it alive and in its purity. Thanks to Maude and Allen for all the help on course!


