INTERMEDIATE

## SIZE

One size fits most adults.
FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Neck opening circumference19 1/2"
(49.5 cm)

Length 20" (51 cm) long.

## MATERIALS

- 5 balls $13 / 4$ oz/50 g (65 oz/59 m)
N.Y. Yarns TWINKLE (58\% Nylon, 40\% Acrylic, 2\% Polyester) in color \#34.
- Size H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge.
- Yarn needle.


## GAUGE

First 3 rounds of motif = $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}(9 \mathrm{~cm})$ in diameter; motif $=61 / 2 \times 61 / 2$ " (16.5 x 16.6 cm ).
TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

shell: (2 dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same space.

## FIRST MOTIF

Ch 4 and join with slip st to form ring. Round 1 Ch 1, (sc, ch 3) 6 times in ring, sc in ring, ch 1, hdc in beg sc to join and form last space -6 spaces. Round 2 Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc, ch 3) in each space around, ending with ch 1, hdc in 1st sc instead of last ch-3 space - 12 space.

Round 3 Ch 1, (sc, ch 3 ) in each space around, ending with ch 1, hdc in 1st sc instead of last ch-3 space - 12 space.
Round 4 Ch 1, *sc in space, ch 2, sc in next space, ch 1 , shell in next ch-3 space, ch 1; rep from * around, join with slip st in 1st sc - 4 corner shells.
Round 5 Slip st in 1st ch-2 space, ch 3 (dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in same space, *sc in next ch-1 space, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc ) in next corner ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space **, shell in next ch-2 space; rep from * around, ending at **, join with slip st in 3rd ch of beg ch 3.
Round 6 Slip st to 1st ch-2 space, ch 1, *(sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space, ch 2, skip next 2 dc, sc in next sc, ch 2, skip next dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next dc, ch 2 (sc, ch 4, sc) in next corner ch-2 space, ch 2, skip next dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next dc, ch 2, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc, ch 2, skip next 2 dc; rep from * around, join with slip st in 1st sc. Fasten off.

## SECOND AND SUCCESSIVE MOTIFS

Make 13 more motifs same as first motif, joining each to previous motif(s) while completing round 6 as follows, following construction chart for placement.
Round 6 (joining round) Work same as round 6 of first motif, joining to previous motif(s) at each corner ch-4 loop and at each of 3 (sc, ch 2, sc) spaces across each adjacent side as follows: To join each ch-4 loop, work ch 2, drop loop from hook, draw loop under to over through corresponding ch-4 loop on other motif, ch 2 and continue. To join each (sc, ch 2, sc) space, work ch 1, drop loop from hook, draw loop under to over through corresponding ch-2 space on other motif, ch 1 and continue. To join where 4 corners meet: ch 2, drop loop from hook, draw loop under to over through next corresponding ch-4 loop, ch 1, drop loop, skip next ch-4 loop, draw loop under to over through next ch-4 loop, ch 2 and continue.

## BORDER

Round 1 With RS facing, skip 1st ch-2 space to the left of right-hand corner ch-4 loop on 1 short end of ponchette, join yarn in next (sc, ch 2, sc) space, ch 1 , *(sc, ch $2, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch-2 space, [ch 3, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next sc, ch 3 , skip next ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 space] twice, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, sc in next joined ch-4 loop to the right of seam, ch 2, sc in side edge of same sc, sc in next joined ch-4 loop to the left of seam, ch 2; rep from * around to last 2 motifs on lower right-hand corner of ponchette, working (sc, ch 4, sc) in each corner ch-4 space. Work in pattern across last 2 motifs, joining last 2 motifs to corresponding spaces on opposite long side edge in same manner as motifs were joined (see construction
diagram). At end of round, join with slip st in 1st sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## FRINGE

Cut 14" ( 35.5 cm ) lengths of yarn. Using 4 strands for each fringe, attach one fringe to each ch-4 loop, each (sc, ch 2, sc) space, and in center sc at each junction between motifs on bottom edge of ponchette as follows: pull 4 strands of yarn through space and draw ends even, tie fringe in an overhand knot close to edge. Trim fringe to 6 " $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$.
