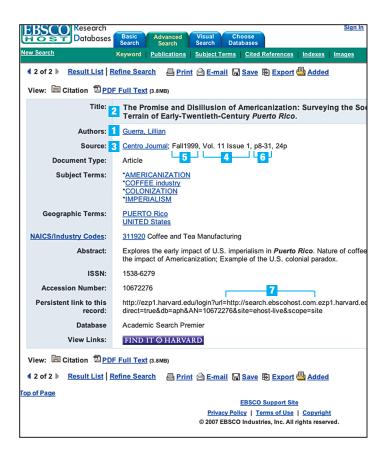
Citation at a glance

Journal article from a database service (Chicago)

To cite a journal article from a database service in *Chicago* style, include the following elements:

- 1 Author
- 2 Title of article
- 3 Title of journal
- 4 Volume and issue numbers
- 5 Date of publication
- Page number(s) (for notes); page range (for bibliography)
- 7 URL of database service
