

Welcome to your CityRail timetable

The following information will help you plan and enjoy your journey.

You can also visit the CityRail website for the most up-to-date information about our services. At www.cityrail.info you can:

- Compare ticket types and fares and purchase longer term tickets
- Get trackwork updates for your line
- Check CityRail station facilities and much more.

Travel well

Our busiest services arrive in the City between 6.00am and 9.00am and depart the City between 4.00pm and 7.00pm. If you can, why not travel earlier or later? If you travel later you can save money with off-peak return fares.

If your preferred train is crowded, consider travelling on alternative services that may be less crowded. These are often limited stops services stopping at major interchange stations and all stations services stopping at intermediate stations to the City.

We encourage you to always plan your journey, particularly if connections are needed. **Connections are not guaranteed** and trains may not be held in the event of late running services.

To assist on-time departure, train doors may begin closing up to 20 seconds before the scheduled departure time.

Help us to help you

Please follow these tips for your comfort and personal safety:

- Arrive at your station earlier than your timetabled service to give you enough time to purchase your ticket and board your train safely
- Spread out along the platform this helps avoid crowding carriages
- · Wait behind the yellow line until the train has stopped
- Stand aside and allow other people to get off before you board the train
- Ask station staff or train guard if you need assistance
- Travel near the guard's compartment, marked with a blue light, if travelling with a pram or small children, or if you have restricted difficulty
- Mind the gap between the platform and the train hold small children's hand

- Move inside the carriage to allow other people to get on board
- Don't block train doorways and stairwells, or sit on stairs
- When moving around the train, please ensure you are holding on at all times to avoid falling
- Please do not run on platforms, stairs or escalators as this could cause serious injury to yourself or others
- Please leave the wide gates at stations for people with vision impairment, restricted mobility and mobility aids. People who are pregnant, carrying suitcases or travelling with prams, bikes or young children may also use the wide gates.

To allow the train to depart punctually, please do not attempt to hold the doors open or attempt to board the train after the whistle and/or doors closing warning has been given.

Trackwork and special event timetables

Trackwork takes place on train lines on a regular basis. We also operate special timetables for major events. It is sometimes necessary to alter or replace train services with buses, particularly at weekends. Please check the weekly Trackwork posters and Special Event posters at your local station or at www.cityrail.info for the latest service alterations on your line. Alternatively, call 131 500 and then press 2.

During Christmas and the New Year, we operate holiday timetables. These are usually based on the Saturday timetable with additional services operating in the morning and afternoon peak periods during working days, and on New Year's Eve.

Trackwork e-mail notifications

A **free** e-mail notification service is available to advise you every week of upcoming trackwork on the CityRail lines which are relevant to you. To register to receive advance e-mail notifications, visit **www.cityrail.info**.

NightRide bus network

Most trains do not operate between midnight and around 4.00am. Instead, NightRide bus services operate during this time covering most Sydney suburban lines. You can use your normal ticket or purchase a single journey NightRide bus ticket from the bus driver. Single train tickets are not valid on NightRide services. All buses have radio contact with taxi operators and a taxi can be requested to meet you at your destination. Most NightRide buses are wheelchair accessible but not for motorised scooters.

Restrictions on intercity services

The South Coast, Southern Highlands, Blue Mountains and Newcastle & Central Coast lines are serviced by intercity trains. Some intercity services during the morning and afternoon peaks have 'pick-up' or 'set-down' only stops at suburban stations – please check the timetable for services with either 'u' or 'd' annotated. This is necessary to provide enough capacity for customers travelling to or from intercity stations which have fewer services. Fines apply for travelling inappropriately on these services; you should use the relevant suburban service instead.

Accessing stations and trains

Many of our stations are wheelchair accessible and work is progressing to make more stations accessible each year. Accessing CityRail, a brochure listing all facilities at each of our stations and containing information for people with mobility restrictions, is available at staffed CityRail stations and on our website **www.cityrail.info**. All suburban and outer-suburban carriages are wheelchair accessible with the use of a portable ramp. Only some intercity carriages are accessible to wheelchairs – look for the wheelchair accessibility symbol next to the door on the outside of the carriage.

Pets and animals

Pets and animals are not permitted on stations or trains, with the exception of guide dogs and assistance dogs accompanying people with a disability. Assistance dogs in training and Police dogs when on duty are also allowed. Except for registered guide or hearing dogs, people with assistance dogs must carry a valid CityRail Assistance Animal Permit.

Bicycles and other wheels

Bicycles are permitted on CityRail trains free of charge, except if any part of your journey is made between 6.00am and 9.00am or between 3.30pm and 7.30pm on weekdays. During these times you must purchase a child ticket for the bicycle in addition to your own ticket. If you are travelling with a bicycle, keep a firm hold of your bicycle and please do not block doorways or aisles.

Motorised scooters or bicycles with petrol motors are **not permitted** to be carried or ridden on CityRail services. Toxic, inflammable and/or hazardous materials **are not permitted** on trains or stations.

Riding bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades or other recreational vehicles on CityRail stations and trains is not permitted.

Short platforms

Lost property

The Lost Property Office is located on the Grand Concourse at Central Station (opposite Platform 1) and is open from 8.30am to 4.20pm, Monday to Friday. For lost property enquiries call 9379 3341 or 9379 3343 or visit **www.cityrail.info**. Lost property is held by the Lost Property Office for 28 days and then disposed of according to RailCorp policies and procedures.

Tickets

A range of MyTrain tickets (train travel only) are available together with MyMulti tickets that combine train, bus and ferry travel in three zones. Go to **www.cityrail.info** to look up the fare calculator and other ticket information.

Tickets can be purchased from the ticket offices and ticket vending machines. Please note that the maximum amount of change the ticket vending machines give is \$19.90 in coins.

Remember to carry a valid ticket for your journey on any CityRail train or bus service. If you are travelling on a concession fare, you must carry a valid concession pass. Fare evasion is a crime and fines apply to customers who cannot produce a valid ticket or concession pass.

City Circle

Most lines in Sydney either lead directly or indirectly to City Circle stations, the loop around the central business district of Sydney. There are six stations in the City Circle:

CentralWynyardSt JamesTown HallCircular QuayMuseum

If you ask for a ticket to the City, your ticket will allow you to get off at any of the City Circle stations as well as Martin Place or Kings Cross. You can also return from any station in the City area with a return ticket to the City.

Other CityRail publications

Accessing CityRail (for a full list of station facilities) and the Welcome Aboard (for a complete CityRail network and Sydney CBD map) are the most popular and provide you with comprehensive information on our services.

Safety – we are all responsible

If you see something, say something

If you see an unattended item or bag, don't touch it, but report it to staff. If you notice something that doesn't look quite right or witness suspicious behaviour, don't keep it to yourself, see a staff member, call the CityRail security hotline on 1800 657 926 or the police on 000. Remember, 'if you see something, say something'.

CityRail's number one priority is the safety and security of our customers and staff. For your safety there are more than 8,600 CCTV cameras across the CityRail network and 700 Emergency Help Points are installed, with at least one on every CityRail station. Our Tangara, Millennium, Oscar and Hunter trains also have Emergency Help Points near the entrance doors.

Remember, for your personal safety

Please take care on steps and platforms and always stand behind the yellow line. Tactile tiles on outdoor platforms may be slippery in wet or icy conditions.

Always cross the train tracks using the footbridge or underpass, or at designated pedestrian railway crossings. Crossing anywhere else is illegal and extremely dangerous.

Customers with prams or strollers should keep a firm hold at all times and apply the brakes when standing still. While waiting for your train, place the pram parallel with the edge of the platform, as platforms can slope towards the tracks.

If you are travelling alone or late at night, travel in the carriage closest to the guard's compartment, indicated by a blue light on the outside of the carriage.

Must mentions

- Smoking is not permitted in enclosed and/or covered areas of stations and on trains.
- Consumption of alcohol or being in possession of an open container of alcohol is not permitted on stations and trains.
- Drunk and disorderly people are not permitted on stations and trains.
- Begging, soliciting or touting on stations and trains is not permitted.

Please assist in keeping stations and trains clean by taking your rubbish with you.

- **F** Friday only service. May include stops early on Saturday morning
- Fx Friday excluded, ie. Monday-Thursday service only. May include stops early on Tuesday-Friday morning
- S Saturday only service. May include stops early on Sunday morning
- Y Sunday service only.
 May include stops early on Monday morning

Timetable layout

CityRail services begin around 4.00am in the morning and finish around midnight to 1.00am the following morning.

Services after midnight and prior to start of the following morning services will be shown at the end of the timetable in their natural time order.

Suffixes for limited days of operations (F, S, etc.) will relate to the day to which the service belongs (eg. a Friday-only service will be suffixed F even after midnight).

Catching a train to Sydney airport

The train is one of the best and most economical ways to get to the airport from Sydney's suburban stations. On weekdays there are approximately six to eight services per hour until 10.00pm, and then four per hour until the last train. On weekends there are four services per hour. Services to the airport run from City Circle stations, Central Station and Airport & East Hills Line stations. The airport stations are located inside both the Domestic and International terminals.

The journey time between Central and Domestic Terminal stations is only 10 minutes and between Central and International Terminal stations is only 13 minutes. All City Circle stations offer a direct service to the Airport Line so travelling by train is the fastest way to reach the airport from the city.

1. Tickets

Your ticket to the airport stations can be purchased from any CityRail station. A station access fee applies to the Domestic Airport and International Airport stations. For most ticket types this fee is included in the ticket price. Please check with the station staff when purchasing your ticket.

2. Changing trains for the Airport Line

- Change onto the Airport Line at Central (Platform 23) from these lines:
 - Eastern Suburbs Line
 - Bankstown Line
 - Inner West Line
 - South Line
 - North Shore Line
 - Western Line
 - Northern Line
 - Blue Mountains Line
 - Newcastle & Central Coast Line
- Change onto the Airport Line at Wolli Creek (Platform 1) from these lines:
 - Illawarra Line
 - South Coast Line
- Trains travelling to the airport are clearly shown on the platform indicators by an aeroplane pictogram.
