**PREMIERE RADIO NETWORKS LAUNCHES GLENN BECK ON JAN. 2, 2001
-- "The Glenn Beck Program" Already on 47 Stations --**

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 20, 2001 – "The Glenn Beck Program" is a three-hour talk show that combines the topicality of talk radio with entertaining production elements. Debuting Jan. 2, 2002, it will air weekdays, from 9 a.m. to noon ET. Due to the overwhelming demand for live, news oriented programming after Sept. 11, Beck got a jump start on national syndication. This resulted in early affiliations with stations such as KPRC/Houston, WGST/Atlanta and WOAI/San Antonio.

Within one year of doing his first talk show in afternoon drive at WFLA/Tampa, Beck dominated the ratings, giving the station its first #1 program ever. With his ability to inform, analyze current events, and generate passion among his listeners, Beck is still #1 with adults and men 25-54 (Arbitron Spring 2001, AQH Rank, M-F 3-7p, WFLA-AM, Tampa).

"I couldn't be happier about working with Premiere," said Beck. "I feel what we do in radio is more important now than ever before. After Sept. 11, I realized just how great our responsibility is to communicate and connect with people, being real and genuine with each other as we experience the full range of human emotions. Having a national forum to do this in is truly exciting and rewarding."

"Glenn is breaking new ground in talk radio," said Gregory Noack, executive vice president, talk programs/Premiere Radio Networks. "He evokes passion with his on-air frankness as he leads his listeners to laughter, anger, compassion and other emotions people didn't even know they had."
