Short biography

Michael Corbey (1963) holds an Engineering degree (ir.) and a Ph.D., both from Eindhoven University of Technology. He worked in the manufacturing industry and as a management consultant until he was appointed Assistant Professor of Business Administration at Tilburg University in 1993. His Ph.D. thesis (1995) dealt with the relationships between Production and Inventory Control and Management Accounting. In 1997-1998, he was *visiting professor* at INSEAD Business School in Fontainebleau (F). In 1999 he went to Maastricht University to become full Professor and the Director of the Maastricht University Postgraduate Controlling Programs (Register Controller, International Chartered Controller). In 2001, he came back to Tilburg to direct new, similar programs at TiasNimbas Business School.

Fields of interest are Management Accounting and Control, Production and Inventory Control, Logistics, and Teaching. Since 1989, he has published (inter)national articles and conference papers about these topics. He is an (ad-hoc) referee for several national and international journals. Prof. Corbey regularly acts as academic opponent and academic promoter at Ph.D. defenses.

As of 2009, Professor Corbey is the Associate Dean of the TiasNimbas Executive Master and Certificate Programmes.

Apart from teaching Management Accounting & Control in the postgraduate controlling programmes, Professor Corbey also teaches in the TiasNimbas part-time and Executive MBA programmes and the Executive Master Programmes.

As for company-specific programmes, Professor Corbey has taught for companies like ABN Amro, BNG, Bekaert, CSM, Fortis, ING, Interpolis, Kluwer, Medisch Centrum Haaglanden, NCD Nederlands Centrum voor Directeuren en Commisarissen, Nutreco, Océ, Randstad, Schuitema, SDWorx, Stork, Syngenta, Quint Wellington Redwood, and more.

He received the NCD best teacher award in 2006, the ING Master of Marketing best teacher award in 2006, 2007, and 2008. He was elected TiasNimbas best teacher in 2006, 2007 and 2010.
