History of Weightlifting

As a basic athletic activity, weightlifting was among those few sports (alongside athletics, swimming, gymnastics, fencing, wrestling, shooting and cycling) which featured on the program of the first Modern Olympic Games, in 1896, Athens. The first World Championships in this sport, however, had been staged five years earlier on 28 March 1891 in London, with seven athletes representing six countries.

The current Federation was founded in 1905 as the Fédération Internationale Haltérophile, although world championships were officially recognised dating back to the late 19th century.

In 1972, it adopted the name of International Weightlifting Federation. The IWF now has 166 member federations.

Weightlifting Today

Approximately, 100,000 weightlifters participate annually in official competitions, but with weight training being an indispensable tool for strength development for all sport - billions of people all over the world have workouts with the barbell for the sake of their fitness. Entry figures of World Championships have increased gradually over the years. In 1999, a participation record was registered when 395 male competitors from 79 countries and 231 women representing 51 nations took part in the World Championships in Athens, Greece.

The power-relations have undergone major changes over the past decades. At the beginning of the century, Austria, Germany and France used to be the most successful nations. Later on, Egypt, then the United States of America reigned. In the 1950s and the following three decades the Soviet Union's weightlifters played the protagonists' role - with Bulgaria becoming a main challenger. Since the mid 90s, however, Turkey, Greece and China have also catapulted to the lead. In the women's field, China has been dominant since the very beginning, with other Asian countries emerging as strong contenders for the champion titles.

Weightlifting at the Olympic Games

Weightlifting, with one arm and two arm lifts of a dumbbell, was included as events within the athletics program at the first Olympic Games in Athens in 1896 and also featured in this manner in St Louis in 1904.

The sport was not included in the Games of 1900, 1908 or 1912 and when it returned to the Olympic arena, contests were decided on the aggregate of a one-hand snatch, a one-hand jerk and a two-hand jerk. After an absence, weightlifting returned as a separate Olympic sport in Antwerp in 1920, with a barbell rather than dumbbells being used by competitors. The sport has been a regular on the Olympic program since. The format continued to change with the introduction of a two-hand press and snatch in 1924. From 1928 to 1972, the result depended on the aggregate of three two-handed lifts: the press, the snatch and the clean and jerk. The press was eliminated in 1976, leaving the total score to be a combination of the snatch and the clean and jerk.



Olympic weightlifting takes a big step forward with women included on the program for Sydney. there will be seven *bodyweight categories* for women, with the number of men's *categories* reduced from ten in Atlanta to eight in Sydney. *New bodyweight category limits* were introduced after Atlanta, which means new Olympic records will be set in all *categories* in 2000.

In Olympic competition, only one gold medal is awarded in each *bodyweight category* - this being a combined total of the best snatch and clean and jerk results. At World Championships, three gold medals are awarded, one for the best lift in the snatch, one for the best lift in the clean and jerk, and one for the best combined total.

Organised weightlifting began in Australia with the formation of the Victorian Weightlifting Association in May, 1920. Other states soon formed their own associations and in January, 1947, the national governing body, known as the Australian Amateur Weightlifting Federation (AAWLF) came into being. It is now known as the Australian Weightlifting Federation Inc.

Australia first competed in weightlifting at the London 1948 Olympic Games. Four years later at the Helsinki Olympic Games, Victorian Vern Barberis, who had won the Australian Championship five times between 1946 and 1951, snared his country's first medal in the sport - a bronze medal.

Australian weightlifting has been successful at the Olympic Games with the following medal winners:

1952 Helsinki -Vern Barberis (bronze)
1984 Los Angeles - Robert Kabbas (silver)
1984 Los Angeles - Dean Lukin (gold)
1996 Atlanta - Stefan Botev (bronze)



Historique de l'haltérophilie

En tant qu'activité physique de base, l'haltérophilie faisait partie des quelques sports (l'athlétisme, la natation, la gymnastique, l'escrime, la lutte, le tir et le cyclisme) inscrits au programme des premiers Jeux Olympiques modernes à Athènes, en 1896. Les premiers Championnats du monde d'haltérophilie s'étaient cependant disputés cinq ans plus tôt, le 28 mars 1891 à Londres, sept athlètes représentant six pays.

La Fédération actuelle a été fondée en 1905 sous le nom de Fédération Internationale d'Haltérophilie, bien que les Championnats du monde soient reconnus officiellement depuis la fin du XIX^e siècle. En 1972, elle adopta la version anglaise de son nom (International Weightlifting Federation). L'IWF compte maintenant 163 Fédérations membres.

L'haltérophilie de nos jours

Environ 100 000 haltérophiles participent chaque année aux compétitions officielles mais les poids étant un matériel indispensable à tous les sports pour développer sa force, des milliards de personnes à travers le monde soulèvent des haltères dans un souci de forme physique. Le nombre de participants aux Championnats du monde a progressivement augmenté au cours des dernières années. En 1999, un nombre record de concurrents a été enregistré aux Championnats du monde à Athènes, en Grèce, avec 395 hommes originaires de 79 pays et 231 femmes représentant 51 pays.

Différents pays ont tour à tour dominé la compétition au cours des dernières décennies. Au début du siècle, l'Autriche, l'Allemagne et la France s'imposaient. Plus tard, l'Egypte puis les Etats-Unis d'Amérique se sont taillés la part du lion. Dans les années 50 et au cours des trois décennies qui ont suivi, les haltérophiles d'Union Soviétique ont régné sur la compétition, la Bulgarie arrivant en force. Vers le milieu des années 90, cependant, la Turquie, la Grèce et la Chine sont également arrivés sur le devant de la scène. Chez les femmes, la Chine a dominé la compétition depuis le tout début, d'autres pays asiatiques évoluant comme possibles prétendants au titre de champion.

L'haltérophilie aux Jeux Olympiques

L'haltérophilie a été inscrite au programme d'athlétisme des premiers Jeux Olympiques modernes, à Athènes, en 1896 et à St Louis en 1904.

Elle disparut du programme olympique en 1900, 1908 et 1912. Lorsqu'elle refit son apparition, à l'occasion des Jeux d'Anvers, en 1920, la compétition se joua alors sur l'arraché à une main, ainsi que sur le jeté à une main et à deux mains, avec une barre au lieu de deux haltères. Le sport a maintenant sa place attirée aux Jeux Olympiques. Les règles ont continué d'évoluer avec l'introduction, en 1924, du développé à deux mains et de l'arraché. Entre 1928 et 1972, les compétitions d'haltérophilie comportaient trois mouvements à deux mains : le développé, l'arraché et l'épaulé-jeté. Le développé a été éliminé de la compétition en 1976, le score total résultant de la combinaison de l'arraché et de l'épaulé-jeté.



Une nouvelle étape a été franchie avec la féminisation de ce sport, les Jeux de Sydney 2000 voyant des haltérophiles femmes pour la première fois. Sept catégories de poids ont été mises en place pour les femmes, le nombre de catégories de poids pour les hommes étant passé de dix à Atlanta à huit pour Sydney. *De nouvelles limites de catégories de poids* ont été introduites après Atlanta, et de nouveaux records olympiques ont ainsi été établis dans toutes les catégories en l'an 2000.

Dans la compétition olympique, seule une médaille d'or est attribuée *dans chaque catégorie de poids* - le score total étant calculé en additionnant les poids les plus lourds levés lors de chaque mouvement. Lors des Championnats du monde, trois médailles d'or sont attribuées, l'une pour le meilleur arraché, l'autre pour le meilleur épaulé-jeté et la dernière pour le meilleur total.

L'haltérophilie, en tant que sport organisé, a fait ses débuts en Australie en mai 1920 avec la création de la Victorian Weightlifting Association. Très vite, les autres Etats suivirent l'exemple du Victoria et créèrent leurs propres associations jusqu'à ce que, en janvier 1947, fût créé l'organisme national directeur connu sous le nom d'Australian Amateur Weightlifting Federation, l'ancêtre de l'actuelle Australian Weightlifting Federation (Fédération Australienne d'Haltérophilie).

C'est à Londres, en 1948, que les haltérophiles australiens participèrent pour la première fois aux Jeux Olympiques. Quatre ans plus tard, aux Jeux d'Helsinki, Vern Barberis de l'Etat du Victoria, cinq fois vainqueur des Championnats d'Australie entre 1946 et 1951, décrocha la première médaille olympique en haltérophilie pour l'Australie - une médaille de bronze.

L'Australie s'est taillée une place dans l'haltérophilie olympique avec les médaillés suivants :

The Olympic weightlifting competition will be held from Saturday 16 September (Day 1) to Tuesday 26 September (Day 11) in the Sydney Convention Centre, Darling Harbour.

The weightlifting competition will be broken up into bodyweight categories for both men and women. There will be eight bodyweight categories for men and seven for women.

Weightlifters must complete two lifts; the snatch and the clean and jerk:

- **The Snatch** - the athlete gets three attempts. This is a single movement lift. The athlete must lift the bar from the floor to arm's length above his head in one movement.
- **The Clean and jerk** - the athlete gets three attempts. This is a two movement lift. The athlete must lift the bar from the floor in a single movement to the shoulders and then raise the bar to arm's length over their head.

Athletes get three attempts in the snatch and three attempts in the clean and jerk. The best snatch and the best clean and jerk lifts are added together to make a total. The weightlifter with the best total wins. If two lifters total the same, the lifter with the lighter body weight wins. If two lifters have the same bodyweight and the same total, the lifter who totalled first is declared the winner.

If a lifter misses all three attempts in the snatch *or* the clean and jerk, they cannot register a total and must be eliminated from the competition. This is commonly known as a 'bomb out'.

RULES OF WEIGHTLIFTING

The weightlifting competitions at the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games will be held in accordance with the *International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) Rule Book 1998-2000, second edition*, and the Olympic Charter which are in force at the time of the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games.

The competition lifts will be the snatch and the clean-and-jerk. One or two bodyweight categories will be contested each day and there will be a final each day. The weightlifters will be in one of two groups according to their qualifying totals. Those with the highest totals will be in group A, the others in group B.



Les compétitions olympiques d'haltérophilie se dérouleront du 16 septembre (jour 1) au 26 septembre (jour 11) au Palais des congrès de Sydney. Les compétitions d'haltérophilie aux Jeux Olympiques de Sydney 2000 compteront un nombre maximal de 250 athlètes, soit 176 hommes et 74 femmes.

Dates importantes pour l'IWF pendant les Jeux Olympiques

Deux jours avant le premier jour de compétition (le 14 septembre 2000) à 15 h 00, l'IWF tiendra un congrès technique pour finaliser les inscriptions et répartir les athlètes et les officiels techniques en groupes. Ce congrès technique aura lieu dans le site de compétition, le Palais des congrès de Sydney, à *Darling Harbour*.

Les compétitions olympiques d'haltérophilie seront organisées en 8 catégories de poids pour les hommes et 7 catégories de poids pour les femmes.

Chaque haltérophile doit se présenter à la pesée avant la compétition. Celle-ci commence deux heures avant chaque épreuve et dure une heure. Après la pesée, les concurrents peuvent manger et boire avant de se préparer pour leur compétition.

Les haltérophiles doivent exécuter deux mouvements : l'arraché et l'épaulé-jeté. Ils ont droit à trois essais pour chacun des mouvements. La meilleure performance de l'arraché et la meilleure performance de l'épaulé-jeté sont additionnées pour former un total. L'haltérophile qui a réalisé le meilleur total est déclaré vainqueur. En cas d'égalité, c'est le concurrent le plus léger qui est déclaré vainqueur. Si les deux concurrents ont exactement le même poids, c'est le concurrent qui a réalisé le premier le meilleur total qui est déclaré vainqueur.

Si un concurrent échoue aux trois essais de l'arraché ou de l'épaulé-jeté, il ne peut réaliser de total et est donc éliminé.

- Arraché : le concurrent a droit à trois essais. Ce mouvement se fait en un seul temps. Il doit soulever la barre du sol et l'amener au-dessus de sa tête à bout de bras en un seul mouvement.



- Epaulé-jeté : le concurrent a droit à trois essais. Ce mouvement se fait en deux temps. Il doit d'abord soulever la barre du sol et l'amener, en un seul mouvement, jusqu'à ses épaules, puis la lever à bout de bras au-dessus de sa tête.

REGLEMENT DES COMPETITIONS

Règlement général

Les compétitions d'haltérophilie des Jeux Olympiques de Sydney 2000 se dérouleront conformément au règlement de la Fédération Internationale d'Haltérophilie (1998-2000, seconde édition) et à la Charte olympique en vigueur durant les Jeux.

En vertu de la Charte olympique, l'IWF assume la responsabilité du contrôle et de la direction techniques de l'haltérophilie aux Jeux Olympiques.

Les compétitions

Les mouvements à exécuter seront l'arraché et l'épaulé-jeté. Les épreuves se disputeront à raison d'une ou deux catégories de poids par jour, finales comprises. Les concurrents seront répartis en deux groupes en fonction de leur total de qualification. Les haltérophiles qui auront réalisé les meilleures performances seront placés dans le groupe A et les autres dans le groupe B.
