The 2013/2014 ranking list will be calculated using a 2 year rolling points system. Please refer to the calendar for seeding cut off dates.

Players losing their first match will receive points detailed in the rows marked 'seeded loser'. Players competing in the Pre Qualifier will be awarded the respective Round 1 (Last 128) losers points for losing in either the Last 128 round or the Pre-Qualifying round. No additional points will be awarded for winning the Pre-qualifying round.

Players who have joined The Tour commencing the 2013/2014 season will not receive starter points as they will receive a two year exemption from falling off the tour. Players who finished outside of the top 64 in the 2012/2013 season but regain a tour place by any means will start on zero points. Players starting on zero points will be ranked in alphabetical order until points are earned to determine a ranking.

At the end of the season players on equal points will be ranked according to the most points earned in the last season. Should this not determine positions, points in events working backwards from the World Championship 2014 will be considered. Finally, if still equal, frames won in losing final match would be used from events working backwards from the World Championship 2014.

The tournaments in season 2014/15 will be seeded based on the prize money ranking list to be published following the 2014 World Snooker Championship. Rankings will be based upon all prize money earned for Ranking Events in the previous two seasons. Where players are not required to play in the first round of an event as a result of being seeded through into a later round, and lose their first match, only 50% of the prize money earned will count towards the prize money ranking system although they will still receive their prize money in full. All players not in the top 64 of the prize money ranking list after the 2014 World Snooker Championship will fall off the main tour unless they have received a 2 year exemption at the start of the 2013/14 season.

WSL will continue to publish in parallel to the ranking list a prize money based list. This is for indicative purposes only.
