ELIGIBILITIES

- Senior High School (SMU) or equivalent Graduates of 2012, 2011, 2010.
- English language proficiency as indicated by TOEFL/IELTS score for applicants from non English speaking country.

PROCEDURES

1. Pay non refundable application fee via Multi-Payment System of Bank Mandiri.
2. Complete the application form.
3. Print out and send them with this following attachment:
 - A legalized copy of high school certificate
 - A legalized copy of score transcript
 - A copy of high school academic record from grade X-XII
 - English course certificate (if available)
 - SAT/A Level/IB or equivalent certificate (if available)
 - Letter of financial support
4. Undertake the Academic Verification held by Universitas Gadjah Mada as follows:
 - Gadjah Mada Scholastic Test*
 - TOEFL-Like**
 - Interview
 - Psychological Assessment***

THE INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM (IUP) IN CHEMISTRY

WHY CHEMISTRY?

The Department of Chemistry, UGM, offers international undergraduate students:

- Small size of class of about 30 students
- A personal supervisor to oversee academic progress and personal welfare
- A teaching program which ensures a highly supportive learning environment
- Lectures supported by small-group tutorials and workshops
- Advanced research facilities
- Choice of elective chemistry courses is flexible
- A range of industrial and international university collaborations
- Support for exchange program with foreign universities
- Direct entry to the M.Sc. Program at Technische Universität Braunschweig (TUBS), Germany

INTERNATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS

Since 2007 The Department of Chemistry UGM has started a joint M.Sc. Dual Degree Program with TUBS, Germany, in the field of Sustainability and Chemical Safety. The aim of the program is to enable students towards the application of chemical principles in lifting the quality of human life without degrading the biotic and abiotic environmental quality. Up to early 2012, it has granted 4 M.Sc. degrees and there are 7 students currently working on their respective thesis projects in TUBS. Some teaching staffs have various joint researches with their international counterparts such as from Keio University, Chiba University, Hokkaido University, TUBS, etc. The department is also actively involved in Excellence Center for Development (EXCEED) Cooperation, i.e. an international organization for sustainable water management in developing countries.

Our staff members develop 5 research groups that are Life Sciences, Industrial Chemistry, Environmental Chemistry, Material Chemistry and Theoretical and Computational Chemistry. In the last five years, they published more than 30 papers in international journals and 60 in national journals. Some of the faculty members even serve as editors and reviewers of international journals, as well as Scientific Adviser for International Foundation for Sciences, Sweden.

THE INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM (IUP) IN CHEMISTRY

FACILITIES

Array of state-of-the-art research equipments such as AAS, UV-Vis, DTA-TGA, Electrophoresis, Potentiometer, Bomb Calorimeter, GC-MS, HPLC, H-NMR, IR, UV-VIS, TLC Scanner etc. are available. In January 2010, the department acquired a new Transmission Electron Microscope (TEM), a major equipment to support quality of nano-research. It is also home to the Austrian-Indonesian Centre for Computational Chemistry (AIC).

WHY MEDICINE?

Faculty of Medicine Universitas Gadjah Mada (FM-UGM) has positioned itself to become a leading university in Indonesia, Asia and in the world. In October 2010 UGM is accredited in A category by National Accreditation Board of Higher Education (BAN PT). TIMES Higher Education Series has placed FM-UGM in rank 153 in 2010 for its Life Sciences & Biomedicine category. According to THE-QS World University Rankings 2010, FM-UGM is ranked 23 in Asia for Life Sciences & Biomedicine. In 2011 is ranked 21 in Asian University for Life Sciences and medicine category.

The program aims to educate students by applying a teaching – learning processes that compels the completion of a curriculum package in order that students would obtain sufficient knowledge, skills and behavior. Starting from 2007/2008 academic year, the Faculty of Medicine Universitas Gadjah Mada applies the Competence Based Curriculum (CBC) according to the standards imposed by the Indonesian Medical Council in 2006.

The curriculum model used is competence-based education. This model requires integration of scientific disciplines and a multi disciplinary approach in curriculum delivery. A balance between specific and general courses is obtained in each block as the learning outcomes are mixture of generic and specific competencies.
