HISTORY OF MADERA

On May 16, 1893 Madera County officially became a County of the State of California, but it was in 1876 that the first lots of the proposed village were put on the auction block and the future Madera County seat had its beginning.

Actually, Madera was a Johnny-come-lately. As the Southern Pacific Railroad laid its tracks south through the San Joaquin Valley in 1872, it brought into existence the towns of Modesto, Merced, Minturn, Borden, and Berenda - but not Madera. Likewise, before Madera was even conceived, in the foothills the older mining communities of Buchanan, and Grub Gulch flourished, as did the towns of Coarsegold, Finegold, and Fresno Flats (now Oakhurst) higher up in the mountains.

Finally Madera came on the scene, and the announcement of its founding was greeted with something less than excitement, given the fact that it had no connection with mining and was not part of the Southern Pacific's plan for the San Joaquin Valley. Madera's birth certificate was issued in a story in the October 11, 1876 issue of the Fresno Expositor. It read in part, "The new town laid out by the California Lumber Company at the point where the company's flume intersects the railroad has been graced with the name of Madera - the Spanish word for lumber. It promises to be quite a flourishing town, and the demand for lots is great."

The Expositor went on to report that a public sale of lots was scheduled to take place on Tuesday, October 24th, at the town site. The lumber company was ready to bring its raw product down the recently completed flume, where it would be finished at the new planing mill. Everything was set; Madera was ready to roll.

On January 10, 1877, the Expositor sent a reporter to Madera to determine for himself precisely what the current status of the valley's newest burg was. What he found was astounding! From the sands of the Fresno Plains, in a matter of weeks, a town had arisen where formerly only jackrabbits and antelope played. "But a few weeks ago there was not a dwelling within a mile of here," noted the reporter. "Today there are probably 25, some of which are better by far than the casual observer would at the first glance believe could be built and fitted up in such a short time."

At this time there were no merchandise stores in Madera, although there were about 20 private residences. As promising as the upand-coming town of Madera appeared, not everyone welcomed this upstart newcomer. The Expositor reported that "just a slight tinge of jealousy is now and again manifested between Borden and Madera." This apprehension on the part of the citizens in the town just four miles south of Madera was well justified. In a few short years, it was totally eclipsed by its lumber town neighbor.

Within a few months, the residents of Madera were thinking about the education of their youth. On March 21, 1877, a public meeting was held to discuss the erection of a school building. Those early Maderans decided that evening to begin work at once. The building was 50 feet by 30 feet, had a 16-foot ceiling, and embraced all of the "modern improvements." The school was built on two acres of land and was fenced and planted with numerous shade trees. Upon completion of the school, plans were made for the first church.

By April 1877, Madera, having no newspaper of its own, was getting regular press coverage in the Fresno Expositor. Under the heading of "Madera Items," it was reported that a drove of antelope had crossed the railroad tracks at Madera on April 4th. Additionally, C.H. Evans had built a handsome verandah in front of his saloon and planned to cover it with an awning like the one above the entrance to the El Capitan Hotel in Merced. Further, Dr. Brown had purchased Sanford's saloon, poured the whiskey out into the dirt street, and fitted up the building as a drug store.

In 1896, Madera became the county seat of newly created Madera County. During the same year construction on a new courthouse, jail, zoo and county park began. In March of 1898 the first Chamber of Commerce was formed. Forty-nine men paid \$2.50 charter membership dues.

Madera soon moved into the 20th century and continued to grow with the main part of town being three blocks long. The City of Madera was incorporated on March 27, 1907. Until paving in 1912, those three blocks and the rest of the wide main street named Yosemite Avenue were chuck-holed and billowing with dust in the summer, thick with mud miring wagons to their axles in winter. The only relief from the dirt were several lengths of wooden sidewalks.

So, within half a year of its founding, the town of Madera began building its destiny, but not without some growing pains. Such was downtown Madera through the first two decades of the century and now we begin the first decade of the new century in which "history" will be created, then described in some future period. It's all just a matter of time!

CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION... CELEBRATING 100 YEARS 1907-2007

On March 27, 2007, the City of Madera celebrated its 100th Anniversary. The City of Madera organized a Centennial Committee to develop plans for a series of events throughout the year. The following Centennial events were held and the public was invited and encourage to attend: the Old Timer's Parade in September 2006 kicked off the year with a Centennial Theme; the City of Madera hosted a Centennial Kick-Off Celebration in January 2007 with an Open House at City Hall, followed by a City Council meeting with the reading of a Proclamation, by Bill Coate, designating 2007 as our Centennial Celebration year; the Madera Chamber of Commerce, along with the Madera Rotary Club and Madera Sunrise Rotary, hosted a Century Luncheon on March 27, 1907 celebrating our City's 100th Birthday and heritage - a look at Madera's Past, Madera Today, and Madera's Future. This event also honored Jay Chapel and the Madera Tribune, celebrating over 100 years in business in Madera; the Madera City Council and Staff hosted the dedication of 'Centennial Park' (renaming Swimming Pool Park) located at the corner of 4th and Flume Streets. Mr. Mike Hinton and students of Madera High School presented the city with a Time Capsule; the Madera Chamber of Commerce hosted the annual Mayor's Prayer Breakfast in celebration of the City's century mark, the event honored individuals that have, and continue, to play a key role in defining the City of Madera. The City of Madera Parks and Community Services Department invited members of the community to join in the celebration of the City of Madera's 100th birthday by adopting a Centennial Tree. Trees were planted on April 27th and October 20, 2007.

CITY OF MADERA

On March 27, 2007, the City of Madera celebrated its 100th Anniversary. The City is a general law city and operates under the Council/Manager form of government. It is governed by a five-member City Council, all of whose members are elected at large, and who serve four-year terms, with the Mayor elected by the City Council, serving for one year.

An annual budget of \$97 million and a work force of 265 full time employees provide the services of our Finance, Police, Public Works (including the Airport Division, Equipment Maintenance Division, Facilities Maintenance Division, Street Division and Wastewater Treatment Plant), Community Development (including Planning, Engineering, and Building Divisions), Parks and Community Services (including Madera Municipal Golf Course), City Clerk, Administration, and City Attorney Departments.

The city also oversees the Planning Commission, Civil Service Commission, Development Review Committee, Traffic Safety Committee, Airport Advisory Commission, Madera Redevelopment Agency & Code Enforcement, and Madera Housing Authority.

VISION MADERA 2025

Beginning in July 2005, Madera engaged in a community process to develop a plan to guide the city to a preferred future. This community-wide effort, the Vision Madera 2025 program, was conducted over two years (2005-2007) and involved hundreds of citizens representing dozens of community interests including business, environment, neighborhood, social service, healthcare, education, government and many others. The product of this endeavor was an Action Plan identifying the programs and projects necessary to achieve that Vision. With the help and input from community volunteers, the City of Madera and other public agencies, the community now has a Vision and Action Plan. The Vision includes descriptive language describing a preferred future for Vision Madera 2025 in four focus areas:

- A Well-Planned City
- A Strong Community and Great Schools
- Good Jobs and Economic Opportunity
- A Safe, Healthy Environment

The resulting Vision Action Plan lists specific activities that will help move the community in the direction of the Vision. It also assigns these activities to individuals, groups or agencies that will take the lead on these activities, often with the help of supporting partners. The Action Plan listed 55 strategies and 167 actions to bring the Vision to life. The plan outlines opportunities to enhance community identity, connections and livability.



GENERAL PLAN

Our local General Plan can be described as the "blueprint" for future development. It represents the community's vision of Madera's future, a constitution made up of the goals and policies upon which the City Council and Planning Commission will base their land use decisions.

State law requires that each city and each county adopt a general plan containing the following seven components or "elements": land use, circulation, housing, conservation, open-space, noise, and safety. At the same time, each jurisdiction is free to adopt a wide variety of additional elements covering subjects of particular interest to that jurisdiction such as recreation, urban design, or public facilities. In addition to the mandatory elements, Madera is including community character, community design and sustainability elements in their General Plan.

The process of adopting or amending a general plan requires public participation. Madera will hold public hearings and provide advance notice of the place and time of the hearings via the newspaper and local postings. Prior to approval of the update, hearings will be held by the Planning Commission. Adoption is required by the legislative bodies of the City of Madera and the County of Madera.

MADERA DOWNTOWN BUSINESS & PARKING DISTRICT

The City of Madera coordinates the operation of a small downtown business promotion and parking district. The assessment district encompasses about 18 blocks and funds a variety of activities throughout the year designed to attract retail customers and potential new businesses. The promotional activities include parades, wine strolls, promotional street bannering and attractive building, lighting, and beautification landscaping services. The district also provides two-hour parking control during the weekday. Madera's Downtown Association, a non-profit group, contracts with the City to provide day-to-day operation of the district.

MADERA FIXED AND DIAL-A-RIDE TRANSIT SERVICES (MAX - MADERA AREA EXPRESS)

The City offers two public transit services. A dial-a-ride service operates curb-to-curb primarily for those who have difficulty using the fixed route service. Dial-a-ride service is provided to city and county residents within approximately a five-mile circle of downtown and is usually used for work, medical appointments, school meetings, college classes, senior services, events and much more. Vehicles are wheel-chair lift equipped. To schedule a trip, one must call (559) 661-7433 at least two hours in advance.

Madera's fixed route bus service operates six days a week and offers services on a 30-minute and hourly schedule throughout the community. All buses are air-conditioned and wheel chair accessible. For a schedule of services, contact (559) 661-7433 or speak to a First Transit Services representative.

MADERA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT (MAE)

The airport is situated three miles northwest of the City of Madera and is operated by the City under the supervision of the Administrative Services Director. The main runway is 5,544 feet long, lighted for night operations, equipped with visual glide-slope indicators, has a straight-in, non-precision instrument approach and will accommodate most business jet and turbojet aircraft. A 3,700-foot secondary runway is in service for restricted daylight operations. Aviation gasoline and jet fuel is available 24 hours a day from two card operated facilities.

Facilities consist of the Terminal/Administration building, T-hangars, permanent and transient tie-down spaces, three (3) Fixed Base Operations (FBO) hangars, corporate hangars, and an agricultural aerial application complex. The Madera Parachute Center, fully accredited by the United States Parachute Association, operates year-round at the Madera Airport and various special events are staged at the airport. OUR SISTER CITY... THE CITY OF I-LAN, TAIWAN, REPUBLIC OF CHINA

The Madera/I-Lan Sister City relationship was established in November 1994, by the Madera City Council to promote cultural, educational and economic exchanges. The City of I-Lan is located at the northeast part of Taiwan. Their mayors, with their respective delegations, have visited Madera in 1995 and 2000; respectively the City of Madera mayors and delegations visited I-Lan in 1994 and 2002. In 2005, a delegation from an elementary school in I-Lan visited Madera in hopes of establishing an exchange program between the two countries.

Maderans have hosted the Chinese youth music group from I-Lan in 1996, 1997, 1999, 2001, 2003 and 2007. During their visits, they have performed outstanding classical music for our students and the community at large. Madera and I-Lan continue to foster this very special international relationship.

The Madera/I-Lan Sister City Corporation is a non-profit organization in Madera. It organizes the Sister City events and programs and hosts fundraisers each year, the Chinese New Year Dinner being the most popular.

TAX INFORMATION

Madera County levies the 1% Proposition 13 Tax Rate (i.e. \$1 for every \$100.00 of Assessed Valuation) plus various voter approved debt service tax rates depending on the particular area within the County.

Retail sales tax rate is 7.75 percent.

GOVERNMENT

The Board of Supervisors is the legislative and executive governing body of Madera County government. One Supervisor is elected from each of the five supervisory districts of the County, each serving a four-year term.

The City of Madera operates under the Council/Manager form of government. It is governed by a five-member City Council, all of whose members are elected at large, and who serve four-year terms, with the Mayor elected by the City Council, serving for one year.

ECONOMIC INCENTIVES

The City of Madera has several designated Enterprise Zone areas. Enterprise Zone businesses can earn in excess of \$37,000 in state tax credits over a five year period for each qualified employee. The Enterprise Zone is administered by the Madera County Economic Development Commission (EDC). The Madera County EDC is also responsible for Foreign Trade Zones, Recycling Market Development Zones and a Small Business Revolving Loan Program. AGRICULTURE

Madera County is located in California's San Joaquin Valley, the most productive agricultural region in the world. As remarkable as the productivity is the diversity of commodities produced. Of the estimated 350 crops grown in California, more than 100 crops are cultivated within the boundaries of the San Joaquin Valley. The total value of agricultural commodities produced in Madera County exceeds over one billion dollars annually.

The diversity of Madera County agriculture is apparent in a listing of the county's top ten products for 2007. Ranked by dollar value the list includes: milk, almonds (nuts & hulls), grapes, pistachios, replacement heifers, alfalfa, cattle & calves, nursery stock, poultry, and corn. Other major field crops include beans, cotton, and wheat. Important fruit and nut crops, in addition to those listed above include cherries, figs, nectarines, olives, oranges, peaches, plums, pomegranates, prunes, and walnuts. Rounding out this impressive list, a wide array of miscellaneous commodities that are also produced include: honey, beeswax, orchids, Christmas trees, timber, firewood, fish, frogs, hogs, lamb and wool.


The commodities of Madera County are exported to destinations around the world. Sixty countries receive shipments comprised of many of our principle commodities, as well as figs, kiwis, pomegranates, pecans, peaches, gladiola corms, and ornamental plants. Growers are justifiably proud of the quality of food and fiber produced here in Madera County. California has led the nation in total farm revenues every year since 1948. Madera County ranks thirteenth amongst California counties in overall agriculture production and twenty-third among the 4,000 counties in the United States. Further, our county ranks first in the production of figs. We rank second in the production of raisin grapes and pistachios. Farming is a renewable economic resource in Madera County, creating income that is replenished each succeeding year.

Less than half of 1 percent of California's 37 million people are farmers, but their impact reaches far. Economists note that the impact of gross agricultural receipts is multiplied three to five times in the local economy. About 30 percent of the San Joaquin Valley's total personal income is derived from agriculture. Many residents





hold jobs that are directly farm-related, associated with fertilizer companies, farm vehicles, supermarkets, truck driving, wineries, and other processing plants. Many more jobs are in areas indirectly related to agriculture, such as packaging, construction, and finance. California's farms are the beginning of a cycle that adds over \$90 billion in value to the State's economy; this constitutes about 6.5 percent of the annual total value added by all California businesses. Without its farms California would lose the wealth that flows into her economy from agriculture.



In the late 1800's, ninety percent of our nation's population was engaged in farming. By 1920, only thirty percent were farmers. Today, just 2% of the U.S. population is in farming and this 2% feeds the entire nation! One farmer feeds 96 Americans and exports food for 32 additional people. To be good stewards of the land, we must be vigilant in our concern for the future of this fertile acreage.

MUSD Is Building New Schools

Madera Unified has experienced a construction boom in recent years, and students are reaping the benefits. Since 2005, MUSD has opened four new elementary schools, a new middle school and a new high school. Each new site boasts modern design and state-of-the-art technology, making Madera Unified's new schools the envy of surrounding districts. The construction has also helped reduce overcrowding at schools and allowed all district sites to transition to a traditional calendar and away from a year-round schedule. MUSD has a master plan in place for further school construction should the city's population continue to grow.

Modern Facilities

Since 2005, the district has opened six new schools and modernized many others. Now, our schools are fitted for the latest in technological needs and are well maintained with fresh paint, spacious playgrounds and well-kept classrooms. We take great pride in our commitment to updating existing facilities to provide all students with an atmosphere perfect for learning.

A Challenging Curriculum

The core curriculum is aligned to state content standards. Core curriculum is outlined in standards documents, which are available to all teachers. All textbooks are state approved and/or aligned to state content standards and several supplemental programs are available in MUSD. Students are administered benchmark examinations to ensure they are proficient in state standards.

Health and Fitness

Research links physical fitness to high academic achievement and overall wellness among young people in the United States. Trained physical education specialists are on staff to provide nutrition and fitness lessons for students in many grade levels. We believe that healthy minds and healthy bodies go hand in hand.

Special Needs Students

The neighborhood schools model serves the majority of students with special needs. Our students with mild handicaps attend their neighborhood schools, along with siblings and friends. Children with more intense needs are often served through the Madera County Office of Education-operated special classes, located at selected MUSD sites.

Technology

Madera Unified works hard to seamlessly integrate technology into the daily curriculum, helping teachers deliver California academic content standards through the use of educational software tools from core curriculum publishers as well as other educational software leaders. Assessment tools are available that help teachers make wise curriculum planning decisions based on data-driven information. Technology coaches are available at each school site to help integrate technology into daily lessons. Our District technology plan has brought the average student to computer ratio to 5:1 at all Madera Unified school sites, while the California statewide average is 7:1.

Career Schools

Madera Unified employs the career school model at Madera High and Madera South High. Career schools offer a unique approach to the high school experience. There are five career schools in total. Both sites feature the following career schools: humanities, health sciences, business/human services. Madera High also offers a career school in engineering and technology, while Madera South High offers a career school in agriculture. Career Schools give students a chance to connect with faculty one to one and the chance to leave high school with the skills future employers and universities are looking for. Each school offers a series of career paths based on employment needs for the future. Curriculum is developed with the guidance of community business advisors who help staff stay current in their knowledge of the world of work.

MADERA COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION

The vision of the Madera County Office of Education (MCOE) is to enhance the quality of life through education. To achieve this vision, the mission of the Madera County Office of Education is to identify and provide programs, services and resources for the benefit of students, families, school districts, agencies and the community.

The Madera County Office of Education provides direct services to students including: instruction for special needs students; court and community school, boot camp, juvenile hall, Cal-Safe (pregnant and parenting teens) instruction; a variety of services including psychological, school nursing, speech therapy, occupational therapy, and other specialized instruction. Services are delivered in the home, preschools, and classroom settings as appropriate to the needs of the students.

Pioneer Technical Center, a charter school, opened in September 2002, for students who wanted to emphasize a vocational-technical program in their quest to meet California State Standards.

The Madera County Office of Education provides a variety of opportunities for students to demonstrate their academic abilities in a competitive format. The Academic Decathlon is a high school competition challenging students in 10 areas. The Mock Trial competition uses the courtroom for students to study, prepare, and present legal cases before local judges and attorneys. The Academic Pentathlon is a junior high school venue for performance in five separate competitions.

The Madera County Office of Education assists teachers with technology integration, professional development activities, and coordinating county technology services. Providing professional development training for teachers and assisting in the classroom designs for teaching students to produce multi-media presentations and guiding their use of the Internet are important support services.

The Madera County Office of Education provides an important role in monitoring the fiscal stability of our school districts. Fingerprinting of all new school employees is another valued service offered by MCOE. Additionally, all teachers in Madera County are required to register their teaching credentials with the Madera County Office of Education.

The Madera County Office of Education actively participates in the regional service delivery system established by the California County Superintendents of Schools Educational Services Association. The following educational services are offered to all school districts and county offices throughout the Central Valley Service Region of Fresno, Kings, Madera, Mariposa, Merced and Tulare counties: Medi-Cal Administrative Activities, Regional System of District and School Support, School Assistance and Intervention Teams (SAIT) and School Leadership Services.

STATE CENTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (SCCCD) Madera Center



The Madera Center has been in existence for over 20 years, initially operating at Madera High School. In August 1996 the State Center Community College District (SCCCD) opened a dedicated site for the Madera Community College Center situated on 114 acres. The original development comprises approximately 25 of the 114 acres. The Madera campus is located on Avenue 12 just east of Highway 99 at the edge of the City of Madera. The initial cam-

pus consisted of 24 relocatable classrooms and a permanent student services building, along with a relocatable classroom to house the Child Development Learning Center and child care-related programs.

A permanent 26,000 square foot education and administrative building and utility/maintenance facility were completed for the 2000-01 school year. Funding from the 2001-02 State Budget Act funded the Academic Village Complex completed in January 2004. The 50,000 square feet of classroom, laboratory, and office space includes academic classrooms and offices, as well as components and laboratory space for biology, physical science, chemistry, computer studies, business, art, and a Licensed Vocational Nursing Program. The project also provided funding to retrofit the educational/administrative building to house the library, student services and administrative offices.

As a result of funding from the local bond and business donations, a full-service physical education program and facilities have been completed, including a fitness center, aerobic center, and softball field complex. Final plans have also been developed for the construction of a Center for Advanced Manufacturing facility scheduled to open in 2009.

The Madera Center serves 2,600 students, generating a full-time equivalency of approximately 1,300 students per year. The Center offers a wide variety of academic and occupational programs and opportunities for students. Utilizing services and course catalogs from its sister institution, Reedley College, the Madera Center offers over 360 courses each year in 38 areas of study and gives students a choice of transfer, Associate Degree, Certificates of Achievement, and Certificates of Completion. The first cohort of the Licensed Vocational Nursing Program completed the 18-month Certificate program in May 2004, with a 12 month LVN-RN program in the final stages of development.

It is anticipated that the Madera area will continue to be one of the fastest growing population centers in the Central Valley and will, therefore, continue with its facilities expansion and student growth.

ARTS IN MADERA COUNTY

Cultural opportunities abound in Madera County from the valley floor to higher elevations. Many artists reside in the county inspired by the visual grandeur of the Sierras and Yosemite National Park.

MADERA

The Circle Art Gallery located at 1653 North Schnoor Avenue, Suite 113, in Madera, displays and sells works by over 40 professional artists. It also houses the Madera County Arts Council, a non-profit arts or ganization that provides residents and visitors access to art and culture through diverse programs and services, including an extensive visiting-artist in the schools program. The gallery hosts an annual fine art exhibition entitled Celebrate Agriculture with the Arts, in September including artists from all over the state. In November, they host a Holiday Arts & Crafts Fair. For more information visit www.maderaarts.org.

Each summer the Madera County Arts Council and the City of Madera organize a Free Summer Concert Series at Lions Town and Country Park. Concerts take place at 7 p.m. on alternate Sunday evenings. Funded through the generosity of local businesses the selections include: Jazz Music, Rock Music, Military Bands, Big Band Sounds, and Latin Music. Check the calendar in the Madera Tribune for exact dates and times.

Quady Winery located at 13181 Road 24, organizes an annual art exhibition called the Revillier Art Exhibition in mid-February, displaying contemporary fine art, photography and sculptural installations. The high quality of the show and the added benefit of tasting wine while viewing the work are lots of fun!

The Madera County Historical Society Museum located at 210 West Yosemite Avenue is a storehouse of artifacts ranging from farm implements to papers and paintings from the personal collections of Madera's earliest residents. The museum is open Tuesdays and by appointment. The first Sunday in December they host an open house fundraiser showcasing decorated rooms and antiques from their permanent collection.

The first weekend of October in Courthouse Park, next to the Historical Society, there is an annual Fiesta in the Park sponsored by Latinas Unidas. This event includes free music and cultural foods.

CHOWCHILLA

The Art Guild in Chowchilla organizes an Art Exhibition during the Madera County Fair each spring. Also, do not miss the artwork on display at Koffee Kat on Robertson Boulevard.

Down the road in Fairmead, next to the landfill lies the Archeological Dig and home of the San Joaquin Valley Paleontology Foundation. Tours are available by appointment.

HEALTH CARE IN MADERA

PUBLIC HEALTH CARE

MADERA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Madera County provides a wide range of health services through the Madera County Public Health Department and in partnership with private medical offices and facilities. The primary responsibility of the Public Health Department is to protect and preserve the health of the community by providing education and information to the public regarding emergency and on-going health issues in the community; providing specialized clinical services, including health screening for senior citizens, immunizations and Tuberculosis skin tests; and monitoring, controlling and investigating reportable communicable diseases. The Department is neither a doctor's office nor a hospital. Nearly all services provided by the health department are free of charge. The Madera Services are located at 14215 Road 28 in Madera. Mental health services are provided through Madera County Behavioral Health Services (BHS).

MADERA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Madera County Behavioral Health Services (BHS) is a public agency offering alcohol, drug, and mental health recovery and treatment programs. CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL CENTRAL CALIFORNIA

Today, Children's Hospital is a 297 bed pediatric medical center on a 50 acre campus with more than 500 doctors practicing in over 40 pediatric subspecialties with centers and services throughout Central California.

In 2004, Children's Hospital received the prestigious Magnet Nursing Services Award from the American Nurses Credentialing Center. The Magnet Award is given to less than 3 percent of all hospitals in the country. Children's was the first pediatric hospital in California to receive the prestigious Magnet designation. The Hospital's effect on kids is not just felt in the Valley; our primary service area encompasses over 45,000 square miles - stretching from Stockton to Bakersfield and the Sierra Nevada Mountains to the Pacific Ocean. It is one of the largest service areas of any children's hospital in the nation.

Children's is not only one of the biggest pediatric hospitals - it's one of the best. In national benchmark studies, the hospital is routinely recognized as one of the top hospitals in its peer group. Children's has received exceptional ratings in key areas such as pain management, cleanliness, and responsiveness to special needs. Children's Hospital's Jane Seddon Willson Heart Center, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, are particularly noteworthy for annually ranking among the highest in their peer groups for survival rates.

The mission of Children's Hospital is to provide high quality, comprehensive health care services to the children regardless of their ability to pay. Thanks to the generous donations the Hospital receives from its many guilds, private donors, and corporate gifts, it is able to help fulfill its mission and make sure that children have access to excellent health care.

DARIN M. CAMARENA HEALTH CENTERS, INC.

Darin M. Camarena Health Centers, Inc. (DMCHC) is a nonprofit health center which focuses on the primary health care needs of the diverse community of Madera County. DMCHC practices an integrated health model which includes services in health education, chronic illness management, and dental care. This model empowers the patient to take charge of their wellbeing through a combination of good nutrition, healthy practices and modern medicine. DMCHC celebrated 28 years of service to Madera in September of 2008.

In December of 2005 DMCHC opened a site in Chowchilla through a grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). In addition to the Chowchilla site, DMCHC has two sites located in Madera. Our Family Center built in 2001 houses Walk-in Care, Family Dental, Pediatrics, Family Medicine, Geriatric Care, Diabetes and Asthma Educators as well as car seat education and a literacy program. The Women's Health Center is located directly across from the Family Center and provides family planning, preand post-natal care and other female health services.

In 2002 DMCHC developed a technology high infrastructure and implemented the Electronic Medical Records program. This groundbreaking use of technology is already redefining and increasing the quality of health care delivered to patients, and positively impacting chronic disease outcomes.

Darin M. Camarena Health Centers, Inc. is located on the corner of 6th and "B" Streets in downtown Madera and on Trinity Avenue, one block south of Robertson Boulevard, in Chowchilla. The Board of Directors is comprised of dedicated professional community leaders of Madera County. Richard Walker is the Chief Executive Officer, and Kenneth E. Bernstein, MD, FAAFP is the Chief Medical Officer. Strong community support, public need, sound management, as well as state, federal and foundation grants and funding have helped Darin M. Camarena Health Centers, Inc. prosper and evolve into a prominent provider of medical and dental services for all community members without regard for social or economic status.



MADERA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

Madera Community Hospital (MCH) is a 106 bed accredited acute care institution offering a wide range of sophisticated diagnostic and treatment services. It is a private, not for profit community hospital. MCH opened it doors on October 1, 1971 and is dedicated to providing quality healthcare services to Madera and the surrounding communities.

Madera is one of the fastest growing communities in the San Joaquin Valley. In order to meet the growing needs of our community MCH opened a 16 bed Emergency Department and a 10 bed Intensive Care Unit in December of 2000. The building is approximately 15,000 square feet. The facility has a separate ambulance entrance along with a decontamination area. There is a separate elevator for transporting patients from ER to ICU. This is a state of the art facility located on the south side of the hospital.

Services at MCH include: surgery (both inpatient and outpatient), diagnostic radiology, physical therapy, respiratory therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, back classes, special therapy for stroke patients, health education, maternity care (including private birthing suites), 24 hour emergency services, in-house pharmacy service, specialized intensive care unit, cardiac care unit, nursing care, medical and surgical nursing care, and a home health care agency.

The MCH medical staff consists of 62 active staff, 5 provisional, 2 honorary (retired), 6 consulting and 15 courtesy staff, encompassing a wide range of specialties. The hospital employs over 900 people in over 40 different departments.

Outpatient buildings on campus include:

MCH Outpatient Center: August 2, 1993 marked the opening day of the newly constructed Outpatient Center, located in front of the hospital. Outpatient services include: radiology (x-ray), a drawing station (lab) and physical, occupational, and speech therapy.

MCH Family Health Services Clinic: On October 8, 1998 the Family Health Services Clinic relocated to 1210 East Almond Avenue in front of the hospital. The Clinic has been open since April 13, 1992. Nurse Practitioners and their staff see over 1,800 patients a month. Patients requiring non-urgent care can be seen in the Family Health Services Clinic, allowing the Emergency Department to treat urgent patient care needs.

MCH Children's Visitors Center: The Children's Visitors Center opened for children on April 5, 2004. The Children's Visitor Center is available to clients who have a medical appointment, hospital emergency care or person visiting patients on the hospital grounds. Children can visit for up to two hours while their parents are using hospital services or visiting patients

MCH Outpatient Surgery Center: The Outpatient Surgery Center opened September 26, 1995. 70% of surgeries are done on an outpatient basis. The Surgery Center is 7,300 square feet and has three operating rooms as well as Pre-Op and Post-Op holding areas which are complete with private recovery beds and six recliners.

MCH Home Health Agency: Established in 1985, the Madera Community Hospital Home Health Agency provides Skilled Nursing, Physical Therapy, Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Social Services. Medicare, Medi-Cal, and most private insurance plans are accepted. The Home Health Agency serves patients in Madera, South Merced, and Northwest Fresno Counties.

Rehabilitation Services: MCH Rehabilitation Services include Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Speech Therapy. Programs include: work and sport-related injuries, stroke rehabilitation, balance and walk training, back care, osteoporosis, women's health issues, hand injuries, post-amputation recovery, swallowing disorders, joint replacement, incontinence, retraining for activities of daily living, and more. Medicare, Medi-Cal, Workers' Compensation, and most private insurance plans are accepted.

Madera Community Hospital Fundraising Organizations include:

MCH Foundation: The Foundation is made up of 25 community leaders whose main purpose is fundraising for Madera Community Hospital. The President of the Foundation serves on the Board of Trustees. MCH League Of Volunteers: Madera Community Hospital has a very active League of Volunteers who volunteer their time to provide assistance throughout the hospital. The League began in 1968, even before the Hospital opened. They have earned over \$1,200,000.00 since their beginning and have volunteered over 600,000 hours. Madera County, "The Perfect Location," encompasses an area of 2,147 square miles and offers two distinct regions. REDEVELOPMENT

The Madera Redevelopment Agency was created by the City to alleviate conditions of blight in older areas of the community. The Redevelopment Agency is able to use special legal and financial mechanisms to eliminate blight and improve economic and physical conditions in designated areas. The Project Area includes 4,207 acres and includes most of the older neighborhoods within the City limits.

The primary goal of redevelopment is to encourage private investment in the Project Area. Past programs and projects have been based upon the following principles.

- Improve the physical and economic condition of Downtown Madera.
- Increase employment opportunities for area residents.
- Improve the quality of the community's housing stock.
- Improve and upgrade community infrastructure.

California state law makes available to redevelopment agencies a method of obtaining funds called "tax increment financing." On the date the City Council approves the Redevelopment Plan, the property within the boundaries of the plan has a certain total property tax value. If this total assessed valuation increases over time, most of the taxes that are derived from this increase go to the Redevelopment Agency. These funds are called tax increment. Tax increment revenues, which are expected to be generated in upcoming years, are outlined as follows:

Currently, the amount of tax increment is not sufficient to finance the full scope of redevelopment activities and development projects. Consequently, in October 2003, the Agency issued a \$19.4 million dollar bond to fund future redevelopment activities. The Agency will be issuing a $35\pm$ million bond in 2008.





Redevelopment activities have focused on the following areas:

DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION

Improving the physical and economic conditions of the "central business district" has been a focal point of Agency programs and projects. Activities have included façade renovation programs, streetscape improvements and the acquisition and demolition of substandard buildings and incompatible land uses. The most effective revitalization strategy is to either remove or rehabilitate substandard or obsolete structures.

COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

The Redevelopment Agency is aggressively addressing infrastructure deficiencies in older neighborhoods throughout the City. Activities include rehabilitation of parks, installation of curb, gutter, sidewalks and streetlights, storm drainage projects and the construction of raised landscaped medians.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Agency activities continue to focus on the acquisition of irregular and under-utilized parcels to facilitate larger retail, professional office or high density residential projects. Projects such as the Crossroads Shopping Center and Sugar Pine Village Subdivision are under construction. Current projects include the South E Street corridor, Yosemite Avenue and A Street, Fifth Street and C Street, and Central Avenue and Fresno River corridor.

HOUSING

Redevelopment law provides that 20% of our tax increment be set aside to increase and improve the supply of affordable housing. Through a number of public and private partnerships, the Agency has created affordable housing opportunities for hundreds of families and generated millions of dollars in private investment.

NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION

The purpose of the program is to ensure the absence of blight and nuisances and to maintain a clean environment for the citizens of our community. Specifically, the program addresses graffiti, abandoned vehicles, public nuisance and zoning violations, substandard buildings, waste tires and illegal dumping.



TOURISM

Gateway to the vast tourism experiences of Madera County and the southern Yosemite region, the City of Madera offers travel services and tourist amenities for nearly everyone. Restaurants, gas stations, and affordable lodging are readily available. Madera serves as the hub for visitors accessing the region from the west on Highway 152, and from the north and south on State Highway 99 traveling to Yosemite National Park or the Sierra National Forest via the Southern Yosemite Highway 41.

Each year the Yosemite Sierra Visitors Bureau publishes a regional Visitors Guide. This colorful and informative guide to the southern Yosemite region is ideal for planning your next outing in the area or

for sending to friends coming to visit. It is also a great tool along with this directory for showing clients about our area. Contact the Madera District Chamber office for your free copy.

Tourism is an important economic development tool for Madera County. Over \$195 million dollars in visitor spending occurs annually. This includes spending for accommodations, food and beverage, fuel, recreation, entertainment and shopping. Over 3,000 jobs are generated by tourism with earnings of about \$67 million. Local tax receipts generated by travel spending exceeded \$3.2 million in 2006. The Transient Occupancy Tax (T.O.T.) or Bed Tax has reached over \$1.8 million per year. The County of Madera collected \$1,863,968 in T.O.T. for the fiscal year 2007-08. The City of Madera accounts for an additional \$426,000 per year in T.O.T. that goes into the city general fund.

THINGS TO DO IN MADERA...

The Madera Parks & Community Services Department is the focal point of a variety of services and facilities, which benefit the citizens of the City and County of Madera. Young and older residents alike may avail themselves of its services. When the City and the citizens met at a series of town-hall and focus group meetings during 2006 in order to create a cohesive, shared image for Madera in the future; the result was the Madera Vision 2025 Plan. Using Vision 2025 as a guide, the department's mission and focus is centered around a plan that is truly community created and community driven.

PARKS DIVISION

The City Parks Division maintains numerous city-owned parks and facilities. Picnic accommodations are available and open to the public. However, popular areas require a reservation and a fee is attached to their use. Lions Town & Country Park on Howard Road between Schnoor and Granada, Sunrise Rotary Sports Complex on Clinton Avenue and Rotary Park on North Gateway Drive are the largest and most popular areas. Lions Town & Country Park and the Millview Sports Complex offer ball fields. Rotary Park and the Millview Sports Complex offer soccer fields. All three locations offer grassy picnic sites with tables and small barbeques. Each has a large covered pavilion area and restrooms. An amphitheater at Lions Town & Country Park has become a popular summer weekend concert site with the Madera County Arts Council sponsoring free outdoor entertainment - a pleasant, cool evening under the stars. Centennial Park at Fourth and Flume Streets is the site of the municipal swim pool. Summer recreational swimming, swim lessons and the park's grassy area are favorite summer uses.

OLDER ADULT SERVICES DIVISION

The Older Adult Services Division is a county-wide program where the goal is to improve the quality of life for older adults of Madera County. A weekday meal program, a variety of recreational activities, entertainment, classes, trips, educational programs, health and wellness programs, summer swim and Adult Day Care and Respite are offered.

The program center sites serve as information and assistance centers. These sites are prepared to assist in the areas of tax assistance, housing information, agency referrals and public information. Health clinics (blood pressure, hearing screening and various related screenings) are held monthly. A flu shot clinic is offered in the fall courtesy of the Madera County Health Department.

The Madera Adult Day Care and Respite Center provides a compassionate alternative to families caring for loved ones who have Dementia, Parkinson's disease, Alzheimer's disease or other related disorders. The program is available Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. There is a suggested donation for services as well as a nominal charge for a hot meal served daily.

GOLF COURSE DIVISION

The Madera Municipal Golf Course is located at Road 23 and Avenue 17 off Highway 99 and is an 18 hole, par 72, championship golf course. You will find a friendly and professional staff in the pro-shop and lounge as well as an elegant and spacious banquet facility. A golf course membership program is also available.

RECREATION DIVISION

A major part of the Madera Parks and Community Services Department is the Recreation Division. The services of the Recreation Division include after school programs, teen center activities, youth sports, special events, adult sports, developmentally disabled program, aquatics, facility rentals, and operation of grant funded programs.

After school programs are offered by the Department Monday through Friday at the Pan American Center, and Westside Activity Center. Each program is unique and offers a wide variety of activities for ages 6 thru 12. The programs offer quality recreation activities that help to build a child's confidence and self-esteem.

A Teen Program is offered at the Pan American Center Monday through Friday from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The program offers health education classes, speakers, cooking classes, sports, game room, trips, movie/karaoke night, and job development skills. The overall program focuses on teen development, health education and having a fun experience. Call the Pan American Center for further information at (559) 675-2095.

The Youth Sports program operated by the Department includes youth basketball and T-Ball. Registration for the youth basketball program begins in October and T-Ball sign-ups start in January. Other youth sports programs are conducted by a variety of organizations. The organizations include Little League, Youth Soccer, Bobby Sox, Babe Ruth and Youth Football.

Throughout the year the Parks and Community Services Department collaborates with service clubs and community organizations to offer a variety of special events. The special events include Holiday events, Santa's Workshop, Halloween Parade, Easter Egg Hunt, Family Fun Day, the 4th of July Fireworks Spectacular, the Fireman's Muster and the Classic Car Show.

Adult Sports include basketball, softball, co-ed mush ball, volleyball and co-ed dodge ball. Leagues in adult basketball are offered for open division teams, church teams and a business/industrial league. Softball leagues are conducted in the spring, summer and fall. Leagues are offered for lower, middle and upper level teams, along with co-ed and church leagues. In the fall, the Department offers co-ed mush ball, volleyball and co-ed dodge ball.

A program for the developmentally disabled adult population is offered on Saturdays. The program is called the Special Needs Adult Program (SNAP). In addition, the program also serves as a respite for care providers of the developmentally disabled. Activities include dances, arts & crafts, sports, movies, bowling and special events.

The Department operates an aquatics program during the months of June, July and August at the recently renamed Centennial Park. Included in the swimming program are public swimming and swim lessons Monday through Friday. The pool can also be rented on Saturday evenings and on Sundays. Several of the Madera schools utilize the pool as part of their curriculum in the mornings.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Parks and Community Services Department offers several facilities that can be rented. The community centers include the Pan American Center and the Frank Bergon Senior Center. Private events at the centers are ideal for large wedding receptions, social gatherings, baptisms and birthday parties.



Facilities available to rent also include the Westside Activity Center and the Rotary Youth Hut. Both of these facilities are ideal for smaller gatherings such as meetings, social gatherings, church services, birthday parties and classes.

Specific information about these programs are available at the Parks and Community Services Department, 1030 South Gateway, Madera, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. All of the activities are outlined in the Department's Fall/Winter and Spring/ Summer Leisure Line-up that is available at the Parks and Community Services office. Brochures are also available about renting any of the Department's facilities.
