INTRODUCTION

The **LAGOS ARCHITECTS FORUM 2010** organized by the Nigerian Institute of Architects, Lagos State Chapter will hold from $28^{th} - 30^{th}$ April 2010, at the New Eko Expo Hall of the Eko Hotel & Suites, Victoria Island, Lagos. The theme this year, "**LAGOS: EVOLUTION FROM 3RD WORLD TO 1**ST **WORLD ECO-SUSTAINABLE MEGA CITY"** focuses on transforming the landscape of Lagos into a world class sustainable and vibrant city of cohesive communities.

The rapid urbanization of Lagos as a result of rural to urban migration has resulted in a city bursting at its seams. Horizontal spread cannot proffer a lasting solution, with the attendant high cost of energy required to achieve it, in terms of expanded infrastructure (roads, power, waste, drainage, transportation, etc.) and the resultant loss of natural green belts, agricultural land and the ecological balance of the environment.

There is need to evolve a more sustainable pattern, model of development and existence in Lagos State. The cities of tomorrow need to be denser with more concentrated centers of living, working and playing, that are more resource efficient and habitable for the urban population.
