C. Athlete Eligibility

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY
<p>All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force and only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Youth Olympic Games.</p> <p>To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes shall:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) have been born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 1997. b) play in at least two tournaments endorsed by FIBA between 1 April 2013 and 8 June 2014. c) belong to a National Federation which is organising in its territory three tournaments endorsed by FIBA during the YOG qualifying period starting from 1 April 2013 to 8 June 2014.

D. Qualification System

QUALIFICATION PATHWAY
<p>For each qualifying event, the qualification places obtained for the Youth Olympic Games will be allocated to:</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> NOCs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The NOC other than host of the three best ranked teams at the 2013 U18 3x3 World Championships to be held on 29 September 2013 shall qualify for the basketball tournaments. <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Should the same NOC have more than one team among the three best ranked teams, the qualification place will be allocated to the NOC, not yet qualified, of the next best ranked team.</p>

2. The NOC other than the host of the three best ranked teams at the 2013 3x3 World Tour Final to be held on 6 October 2013 shall qualify for the basketball tournaments.

Should the same NOC have more than one team in the three best ranked teams or have already qualified via the U18 World Championships, the qualification place will be allocated to the NOC, not yet qualified, of the next best ranked team.

3. The top 13 NOCs in the FIBA 3x3 National Federation ranking on 1 June 2014 shall qualify for the basketball tournaments.

All National Federations meeting the eligibility condition are ranked according to the sum of points earned on 3x3Planet.com by their respective U18 players who are part of the top 1,000 players. This ranking is calculated separately for men and women. In the event of a tie, the NOC with the highest number of ranking points in the respective age and gender will qualify. Should there still be a tie, the NOC with the highest number of national players on the ranking will qualify.

4. A minimum of one NOC in each gender per FIBA Zone - Africa, Americas, Asia, Europe, Oceania - and a maximum of 10 teams from the same FIBA Zone per gender shall take part in both tournaments.

Should there be more than 10 teams per gender from the same FIBA Zone, the ranking on 1 June 2014 will be used to determine the lowest ranked team(s) of the above mentioned Zone. This team(s) will be replaced by the next best ranked team(s) among the four other Zones on the ranking on 1 June 2014.

Should there be a Zone without any qualified team in one of the tournaments, the ranking on 1 June 2014 will be used to determine the best ranked team from the above mentioned Zone. This team will replace the NOC of the lowest ranked qualified team on the ranking on 1 June 2014.

5. A minimum of 30 NOCs will take part in the men's and women's tournaments. Should there be fewer than 30 NOCs, the compiled men's and women's rankings on 1 June 2014 will be used to determine the lowest ranked team(s) of the NOCs with two teams already qualified. This team(s) will be replaced by the next best ranked team(s) of the NOC not yet qualified.

Only athletes qualified for the 3x3 team competition will be able to take part in the skills challenge.

HOST COUNTRY REPRESENTATION

China, as the host country, has the right to enter one team per gender

E. Confirmation process for quota places

CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUALIFICATION PLACES

FIBA shall confirm qualified teams/NOCs to NOCs immediately following each qualifying event.

NOCs will then have up to two weeks from the day of the email/letter to confirm in writing to FIBA and NYOGOC that they will use the obtained places.

CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The NOC of China, as host country, has to state by 20 October 2013 if it will use its host country places.

F. Reallocation of unused quota places

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES
In the event that an NOC elects not to use an obtained place or an NOC qualifies more than one team in each gender, the place will be reallocated to the next best ranked team, of the NOC not yet qualified, in the FIBA 3x3 National Federation ranking on 1 June 2014, provided that the conditions outlined in Part D “Qualification Pathway” are met.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES
Should the host country decline either of its places, the additional place will be offered to the next best ranked NOC not yet qualified in the FIBA 3x3 National Federation ranking on 1 June 2014.
