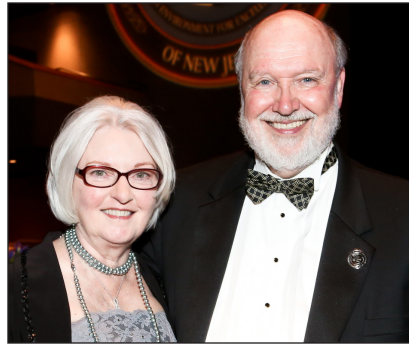


# THOMAS J. KUHAR FOUNDER'S AWARD

## Presented to Dr. & Mrs. Herman J. Saatkamp, Jr.

Dr. Herman J. Saatkamp, Jr. is the fourth President of The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey, a consistently top ranked undergraduate and graduate college of the arts, sciences, and professional studies located in Galloway, New Jersey.

Dr. Saatkamp recognizes Stockton's role as both an esteemed educational facility and a force of economic growth in the region. Under his leadership, Stockton College has undergone a number of expansions and extensions including: a two story art gallery, an expanded Campus Center and soon to be opened Unified Science Center along with the Sara and Sam Schoffer Holocaust Resource Center and the Carnegie Library in Atlantic City. Academic programs have also expanded including changing academic divisions to schools, the creation of the School of Business, School of Health Sciences, William J. Hughes Center for



Public Policy, Small Business Development Center, and the Lloyd D. Levenson Institute of Gaming, Hospitality and Tourism. Stockton College is also now affiliated with the Noyes Museum of Art, Dante Hall Theatre in Atlantic City, The Sam Azeez Museum of Woodbine Heritage, Stockton Seaview Hotel and Golf Club in Galloway, and the soon to open Arts Garage in Atlantic City. Stockton is also collaborating with The FAA William J. Hughes Technical Center in the development of the Aviation Research and Technology Park, during which Dr. Saatkamp served as Board Chair. This collaboration together with Stockton's affiliation with Atlantic City Medical Center and Bacharach Institute for Rehabilitation enables the College to establish programs and services that are beneficial to students, the community, workforce and to the economic vitality and well-being of New Jersey.

Both Dr. and Mrs. Saatkamp are deeply committed to the local community. Dr. Saatkamp has served as the Public Service Division Chair of the New Jersey Employees' Charitable Campaign, and was honored as the Research and Development Council of New Jersey's 2011 "Educator of the Year" for shaping educational programs and outreach to bring together industry and communities and build on the strength of the region's economy. Dorothy Saatkamp is a longtime member of the United Way Women's Leadership Initiative and serves on the planning committee of their annual financial workshop, "Power of the Purse." Now retired, Dot's profession was in special education with a focus on learning disabilities. They have two children, Barbara (a physician) and Joseph (an engineer) and two granddaughters.

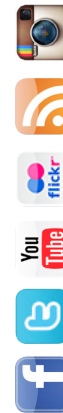
