Enrollment data in this section, and all other sections, were collected at Census Date—four weeks after the first day of instruction each semester. They are the “official” numbers for State and Federal reporting.

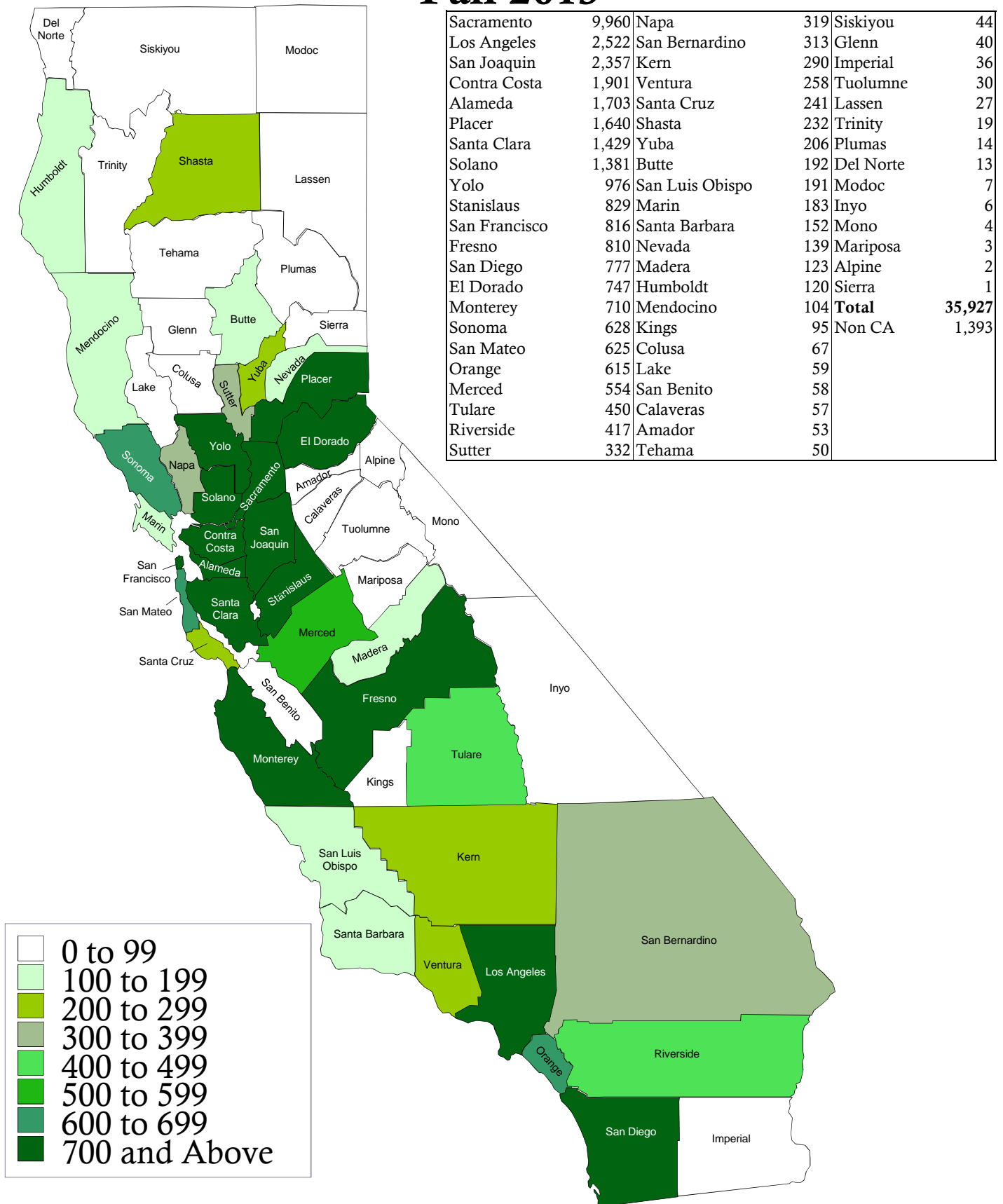


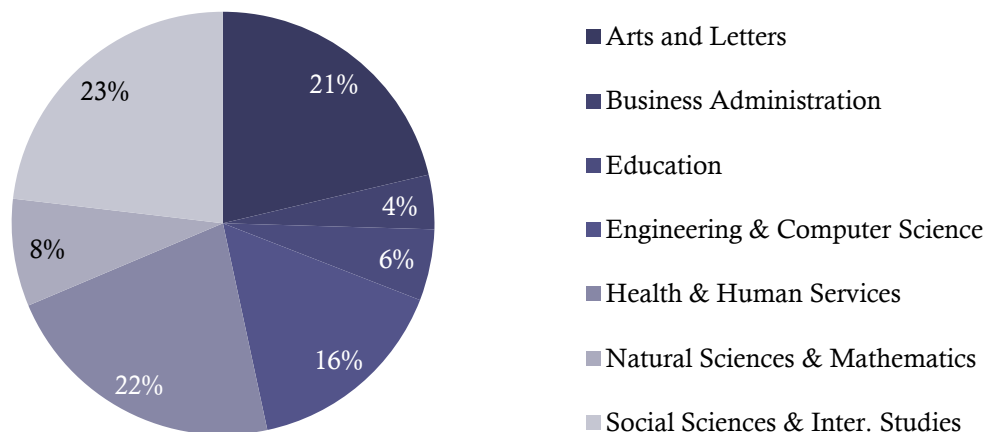

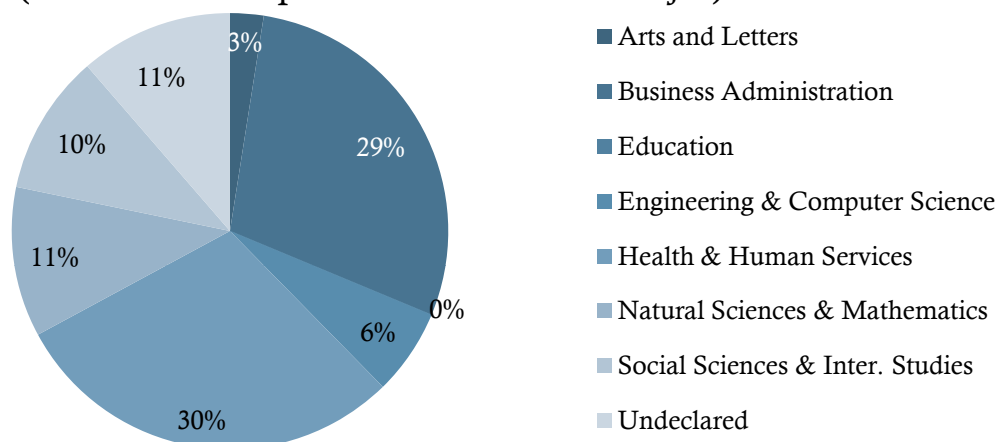
