# LTA COMPETITION REGULATIONS – SUMMARY OF MAJOR CHANGES 2013

The LTA Competition Regulations (which can be found at <a href="www.lta.org.uk/CompetitionRegulations">www.lta.org.uk/CompetitionRegulations</a>) will be amended as from 1 September 2013. This document summarises the major changes that will be made.

## **Overlapping Competitions**

1. There is now an exception in 3.10, which relates to LTA Staged Winter Competitions (ie. National Tour weekend Winter Regional Tour and weekend Winter County Tour tournaments) whereby a Player can enter only one competition at each grade in the same age group taking place on the same weekend.

### Withdrawals and Code Violations

- 2. Paragraph 4.8 has been amended to include suspension periods for a third and fourth suspension in the same 12 month period.
- 3. Paragraph 4.9 now makes clear that, if the suspension date starts during a competition, a Player is not permitted to play in that competition, even if part of the competition takes place outside of the suspension dates.

#### Referee

4. Following the introduction of the Officials Licence Scheme, the person appointed as Referee must be an LTA Licensed Official for Grades 1 to 5 competitions

#### **Prize Money**

5. The organising committee of a competition has the discretion to withhold all or part of the prize money due to a Player where a serious breach of the Regulations has been committed.

## Ranking

- 6. With effect from 1 January 2014, when a Senior player moves up to a new age group, their accumulated ranking points will automatically be carried forward to the new age group. This applies to Seniors events only and not Open age groups.
- 7. Grade 4 and Grade 5 Ranking Points for individual competitions have been increased.
