CHICAGO BLUES FESTIVAL – June 8, 9, 10, 2012: Summer time is almost upon us-one of our favorite times of the year. Chicago Blues Fest always kicks off the summer in a big way-with one of the biggest music events of the year (and still free!) We're honored and pleased to have many Delmark recording artists play this year's Fest, including Zora Young, Demetria Taylor, Quintus McCormick, Jimmy Dawkins, Eddie C. Campbell, Kenny Smith, Big DooWopper, Dave Specter, Eddie Shaw, Bob Stroger, Charles Wilson, Lurrie Bell, & Billy Branch. In a special preview Blues Fest series held at the Old Town School of Folk Music's brand new theatre/building, Demetria Taylor played a rousing Mother's Day celebration, and Sharon Lewis recently tore it up with her band Texas Fire, billed as "Diamonds in our own back yard." Rockin' Johnny & Jimmy Burns just recorded and videotaped an episode for WTTW at Delmark, airing for Blues Fest.

We also just found out the way cool news that guitarist **Dave Specter** is playing for **President Obama** at a benefit at the Chicago Cultural Center on June 1st!

I would love to mention a few of the very many special shows going on during this year's Festival, including our annual Delmark Blues Brunch at the Mart, held every Sunday morning of the fest at the world's largest Blues & Jazz Specialty record store, Bob Koester's Jazz Record Mart. This year's Brunch will feature our faves, **Mississippi Heat** (they are celebrating their 20th anniversary and almost done with their new Delmark CD!) along with many special guests, including **Toronzo Cannon, Tail Dragger, Grana' Louise, Eddie C. Campbell**, and more!

The can't miss event of the Fest is the All-Star Post Fest party at Reggie's Music Joint in the south Loop on Saturday, June 9th with the reunion of **Jimmy Burns** with **Rockin' Johnny** (also celebrating his killer new Delmark CD- *Grim Reaper*,) a rare appearance from **Studebaker John's Maxwell Street Kings** (with **Rick Kreher** & **Steve Cushing**,) and standout west side guitarist, **Eddie Taylor**, **Jr**! Our main man, the one and only **Tail Dragger**, will be celebrating his new Delta Groove CD with our friend **Bob Corritore** at B.L.U.E.S. on Halsted on Thursday, June 7th.

Speaking of Tail Dragger, we're excited to announce that the 2012 *Living Blues* Magazine awards reader's ballot was just announced and our favorite Wolf styled singer was nominated for best live performer *and* most outstanding blues singer of the year (up against **Buddy Guy, Mavis Staples, Sharon Jones & Gregg Allman!**)! Look for a new Delmark recording from him next year with a very special guest!! Fantastic singer/entertainer **Sharon Lewis** is nominated for female blues artist of the year, and the classic **Junior Wells'** *Hoodoo Man Blues* expanded version is nominated for best blues album, reissue recordings. In that same issue of Living Blues, **Deitra Farr** interviews the Bad Girl of the Blues, **Demetria Taylor**, and there is a big lead article on standout singer, **James Kinds!** Please send out healthy thoughts to the "Kind Man," as James unfortunately recently suffered a stroke, hopefully only a minor one. He was just about to head off for an anticipated European tour, too.

Our vinyl reissue series continues with very exciting news. Did you know that the classic 1975 recording from **Otis Rush**, *Cold Day in Hell*, is now out on LP??!! "Guts. That's what this record is all about: Otis Rush's days in hell, and the tentative joys of returning above ground. Everything about Otis Rush says guts: his squeezing, piercing guitar, his raw-boned, blood-tinged vocals, his lyrics, full of a profound sense of the trips men and women lay on each other - and most of all, his courage to open up from the inside and let all this out in his music."

DELMARK JAZZ NEWS: Innovative guitarist **Jeff Parker**'s new CD, *Bright Light in Winter*, is also now available on glorous vinyl, LP, too. It just received a 4 star Downbeat review from esteemed critic, Peter Margasak. Young piano phenom **Jim Holman** just celebrated his elegant debut recording on Delmark at the Jazz Showcase with special guest, **Frank Catalano** on sax! Vibraphone star **Jason Adasiewicz**' Sun Rooms is rocking the Green Mill June 22 and 23 and there will be some wonderful press from Howard Reich in the *Chicago Tribune* and he will also be on 848 and weekender on WBEZ. Saxophonist **Jason Stein**'s killer Quartet has some steady well received local gigs at Elastic Arts, The Hungry Brain on June 17th and the Museum of Contemporary Art on June 26th. **Kahil El' Zabar** and the **Ethnic Heritage Ensemble** with **Ernest Dawkins**, **Corey Wilkes**, **and Fareed Haque** are traveling to Africa soon to Kinshasa, Zaire!!

Rockin' Johnny Band's Grim Reaper

liner notes from the new CD

In mid-1990s Chicago, musical worlds burgeoned, collided and cohered. Young jazz players crafted their own take on different traditions. Rockers turned toward country. A few became rock stars. Through it all, blues singer/guitarist Rockin' Johnny Burgin set his own pace.

Back then, and today, a slew of disciples of this city's 12-bar traditions turned their tributes into overwrought clichés. Rockin' Johnny stood apart from all of that. He absorbed the right lesson from West and South Side mentors. That was: economy should be a blues musician's ally. Pack a world into a few sharp notes and let the spaces sing for themselves.

At the same time, Johnny stayed hungry enough to book his own groups throughout large cities and small towns, and tells that story in the song "Shoe Leather And Tire Rubber." Meanwhile, he sharpened his skills when he served as a sideman for such legends as Tail Dragger, Jimmy Burns, Sam Lay, Pinetop Perkins, Billy Boy Arnold, Little Arthur Duncan and Jimmy Lee Robinson. Some outside gigs added fuel for his originality—like a memorable night at Beat Kitchen working alongside perverse r&b singer Andre Williams.

But when that decade ended, Johnny walked away from music.

Johnny's early and, ultimately, brief time away from the stage echoed Wes Montgomery's decision in the early 1950s to hold factory jobs: the jazz guitarist had a a family to support, and remarked, "What I wanted to do didn't matter as much as what I had to do." A couple years ago, Johnny got back into performing and released Now's The Time in 2010. His new Grim Reaper does more than seal the deal for an artist who kept his thirst for writing and playing even while he's become more comfortable with himself.

"I'm more effective," Johnny said just before departing for a European tour. "While I can't stay up all night, now I really am focused. I had it, been without it, and now that I have it again, I'm not letting it go."

Like the night before a Grim Reaper mixing session, when Johnny played a birthday bash at B.L.U.E.S.

"So many musicians were there, like Eddie C. Campbell—that would have made me so nervous when I was in my late 20s," Johnny said. "But I wasn't nervous at all, though not so relaxed that I don't care. There has to be a little adrenaline going, or you're

doing it wrong."

That energy is also a kernel innovation, such as this disc's title track, which—like "Lousy Dimes"is from the pen of Johnny's longtime friend Ken Kawashima. Lyrically, the story is medieval, but Johnny updates the tale through studioenhanced backwards guitar (otherwise, he's effects-free).

"The song is a conversation between the grim reaper and the singer, so that backwards guitar is like the pull of the underworld," Johnny said. "That worked out beautifully."

Grim Reaper also reconnects Johnny with James Porter, who frequently checked him out during the 1990s, and sometimes blew harp with his band onstage. Nowadays, Porter is a perceptive blues critic and his "One And One Ain't Two" features imagery that reflects his uncanny imagination.

Even when Rockin' Johnny and his band are playing comparatively straight ahead blues tunes, his spacings make his notes vivid and personal, especially on "Brand New Boots," "Rollin' And Tumblin'" and "My Baby She's A Good 'Un."

"I usually stick to the melody in a solo," Johnny said. "And there are holes in the melody, and in the holes, I put a comment on the melody. If you do that, the solo plays itself. Then you can do it again. That's it. One of my heroes was Guitar Junior. His style is boiled down, but he had that sting."

Johnny mentions Johnny B. Moore as another role model, especially for his vibrato. That technique quietly come to the forefront of "Window To The Soul" and a drawn-out "Everybody Needs Somebody."

"There are a few different versions of that, it's like you're grinding the string down into the neck," Johnny said. "Sometimes I take my thumb, which is usually behind the neck, and put it in font of the neck, so I'm using my arm muscles and not the thumbs and I get a sound that way."

A show of strength, to be sure, and that contrasts with Johnny's vulnerable sounding vocals, especially on "She Fooled Me."

"Billy Boy Arnold is my idol on vocals, because he's a great singer, but a low-power singer compared to gospel-type singers like Bobby Bland," Johnny said. "When I heard that, I thought this is the way I ought to sing, this will solve all my problems. My singing is way better now than it was back then. I didn't work on it, it's just life."

As part of Johnny's artistic renewal, he's added horns to "It's Expensive To Be Broke" and "My Sweet Baby." But for the most part, Grim Reaper centers on the core group with Johnny exchanging licks alongside longtime guitar foil Rick Kreher. New drummer Steve Bass fuels the rousing beat of "Don't Mess With Me Baby" and locks into a slower drawl with bassist John Sefner on "Somebody Loan Me A Dime." Johnny says that the key to their chemistry is that he knows not to micromanage.

While Rockin' Johnny has kept his intensity from the 1990s, he's more lighthearted now, despite this album's title. It's hard to imagine his struggling earlier persona closing with a purely upbeat "Party This Christmas." None of this means he's lost his sense of focus, he's just realized that pure happiness can come from prioritizing the moment.

"In Robert Bly's book Iron John, he talks about ritual space, which we don't have in our culture," Johnny said. "But the bandstand is ritual space. When you step on the bandstand, your cell phone should be off. You shouldn't be chewing gum. And it's not about a Bill Doggett record from 1956. It's not about anything in the past anymore."

Quintus McCormick's Still Called The Blues

The moment Quintus McCormick started singing Hey Jodie! I fell in love with his music. It was at his 2009 recording session on the very first song, very first take which got issued as the title track and the opening song on his Delmark debut. While I had heard a live recording that he was using as a demo and as something to sell off the bandstand I was not prepared for what was about to unfold that day. Quintus continued to deliver unbelievably soulful vocal performances of brand new original songs, one after another. When the one-day session was done we had fourteen killer takes and I thought to myself "Wow, this cat could be the next Johnnie Taylor!" And not only did he sing them but he also wrote them and played guitar too.

The critics also loved the album. *Blues Revue* said *Hey Jodie!* is the best studio debut of 2009 and one of the best soulblues albums of the past decade" while *Living Blues* said "McCormick possesses a rich, soulful voice and an incredible versatility on guitar. At one moment he's laying down an edgy bluesrock intro, and the next he's shifting into funk mode with confidence and swagger."

Quintus always has music running through his mind. I've seen him at the Delmark offices and then he'll run to the piano and start running some chords. He's got to get it down on paper before it slips away. Then he'll tell me what's going on in the song and go into playing air drums vocalizing the different parts of the kit and squeezing up his face just to show how funky it's gonna be. And it is. Like "I Gotta Go" with the funky wah-wah clavinet.

Less than a year later Quintus says he's got enough material for another CD. Typically it takes an artist longer to come up with good, fresh songs but true to his word the second CD *Put It On Me* was no less successful in delivering great original blues, R&B and soul music. Meanwhile the first CD is still selling in spite of illegal downloading and the bad economy. And now less than three years from the recording of the first CD Quintus is back again with *Still Called The Blues,* full of wonderful, inspired original material and a few covers with which Quintus has completely made his own.

That's My Baby, one of the new Q-joints, sounds more like a Minnie Ripperton jam than something you'd expect from the label that brought the world all those great Junior Wells and Magic Sam recordings but remember they also brought soul and funk to their blues. Who can make a man when he's cussin' and fussin' melt like butter when she's says "What's wrong?" That's My Baby! Amen, brother!

Oh! Darling was of course recorded by The Beatles but it's not rock n roll. It's doowop. Only The Beatles version didn't have the usual four part backup harmonies. Q drops it r&b like Wilson Pickett dropped Hey Jude. And at the last minute, and unplanned, labelmate The Big Doowopper adds all four of the backup vocal parts.

Party on a Saturday, go to church on a sunday, finally recall you gotta go back to work on a Monday. Anyway you look at it -doesn't matter what genre of music anybody can pigeonhole any of this MUSIC into, it's Still Called The Blues!

Mike Wheeler played rhythm guitar on Linsey's session and on May 21 & 22, he recorded his own session for a forthcoming Delmark CD.

Mississippi Heat is continuing work on their new CD *Delta Bound,* which celebrates their 10th CD overall, and the 20th anniversary of the band.

Ernest Dawkins finished recording a new Delmark album just before he left for his annual month-long residency in France. Now that he's back he'll be back in the studio for the final touches and mixing.

Rob Mazurek recorded his Pulsar Quartet in late March with Bundy Brown engineering. The next blues session will be **Willie Buck** in mid-June. He will be supported by the **Rockin' Johnny** Band and special guests.

Traditional jazz group the **Fat Babies** will be recording for Delmark that same week.

R&B/Reggae singer **Charli Hunt** is working on her second CD for Boomshot Records.

Trumpeter Yves Francois recorded with his seven piece band.

Blues harpist **Harry Garner** starting tracking for his independent CD.

Jazz vocalist **Gina Gibson**, who recorded a Christmas CD last year, was here to start work on her new CD.

Gene Lubin, original member of 60's band, **The Knaves**, was here re-visiting music he recorded at Chess studios and creating new music for a CD he will be coming out with soon.

Piano technician Charlie Terr just completed work on our wonderful 1917 Steinway B. It's nice to see the line of the Steinway, the Rhodes and the Hammond B3 with Leslie when you get that first glimpse of the room as you enter. Delmark/Riverside/Jazz Record Mart owner **Bob Koester** will be celebrating his 80th birthday in October and Delmark celebrates it's 60th anniversary next year – time flies when you're havin' fun!!

The Gang is concerned equally with the great musical legacies of Louis Armstrong, Pee Wee Russell, Derek Bailey, and the Art Ensemble of Chicago. It's the kind of exploration that can only come from musicians that are native speakers of three languages: jazz, free jazz and free improvisation. Josh Berman, cornet; Jeb Bishop, trombone: Guillermo Gregorio, clarinet; Jason Stein, bass clarinet; Keefe Jackson, tenor saxophone; Jason Adasiewicz, vibraphone; Joshua Abrams, bass and Frank Rosaly, drums.

Fred Lonberg-Holm's Fast Citizens Gather Delmark DE 2017

Formed in 2002, The Fast Citizens are the Chicago-based sextet of Aram Shelton, Keefe Jackson, Josh Berman, Fred Lonberg-Holm, Anton Hatwich and Frank Rosaly. With a rotating leadership, they have made three records, each featuring a different member. Continuing the exploratory tradition of their first two albums - Jackson's *Ready Everyday* (Delmark 571) and Shelton's *Two Cities* (Delmark 590) - *Gather* augments their jazz, experimental and free improvised vocabulary with an ever expanding set of references ranging from the popular to the esoteric. "Fast Citizens continues to forge its own direction, reaching beyond formulaic conventions to embrace new forms." -*All About Jazz*



"I think I've paid my dues, you know?"

Linsey Alexander hails from deep blues country. He was born in 1942 in Holly Springs, Mississippi, near the epicenter of the Hill Country blues community that introduced the likes of R.L. Burnside and Junior Kimbrough to the world. When he was about twelve years old, he moved to Memphis with his family; there he had the experience that would eventually lead him into a lifetime of making music.

"It started," he remembers, "from me listening to a guy who would come by my house, and he would bring his guitar, and he used to play us a little lick . . . This guy's name was Otis. I'd sit there and listen at him; we were about the same age. He left one day, and he left the guitar, so what I had seem him play and what he had showed a little bit, I picked up the guitar, and I started playing it myself. I think the first song actually was 'Hang Down Your Head, Tom Dooley,' and I did [the country music hit] 'White Silver Sands."

Linsey also remembers hearing blues, country, and rock & roll on the radio during those years; Memphis keyboard legend Rosco Gordon was a favorite of his, as were rockers like Chuck Berry and Elvis. But despite this, and despite his admiration for young Otis's guitar playing, he didn't yet envision himself as a musician. "That came later," he affirms. "I tried to be a singer more than I did a guitar player. When I'd be out playing football with the boys, and I had the long walk home by myself, I used to sing a lot."

In about 1960, Linsey left Memphis for Chicago. Like the bluesman he would soon become, he did it for love: "Followed my girl. She was down on vacation in Memphis, and me and her got to be close friends. She was living in Chicago, and I had a brother in Chicago, and my mother [had] passed in '58. I was living with [another] brother, and I was working in a hotel, doing maintenance work and stuff like that. When the girl left, my older brother and I decided to come to Chicago. So we packed up, got on the Greyhound, and here we come."

In Chicago, Linsey found himself captivated by the still-thriving South Side scene; a club-goer could immerse himself in music ranging from contemporary soul and R&B to hardcore Chicago blues. He heard popular soul artists like McKinley Mitchell and Bobby Day, and he also had the opportunity to experience the housewrecking bluesmanship of Howlin' Wolf. Inspired, he purchased a guitar, got together with a couple of like-minded friends, and formed a band. Christened the Hot Tomatoes, they were good enough to enter a talent show at a well-known nightclub on 63rd St. called The Place. But Linsey had higher aspirations. "I was kind of advancing more than my band could keep up with me," he asserts, "so I got another bass player, then I got another drummer, and we started gig-



ging out, and then we got another guitar player, and we called ourselves the Equitable Band. My first real paying gig was the Launching Pad.; 75th [St.] and Stony Island. We got in there with my band, and we played for about 8 years."

Linsey also had the opportunity to share stages with such figures as Bobby Rush, Little Milton, B.B. King, and Buddy Guy. But he focused mostly on fronting his own group. "My band was doing pretty good on the South Side," he affirms, "playing at various little clubs, lawn parties and stuff. We started getting good gigs; I played with [drummer and bandleader] Red Saunders for a while. They used to rent the band out to go do gigs for them.



"I went to a club down by 35th and Archer, used to be called Red's. I was playing there one night, and an agent come in there, his name was Frank Curtis, and he said, 'What in the world are you doing in here, as good as you are?' I said, 'Well, this is as far as I can go right now, [unless] something else happens.' We had a sax-ophone player, we was going good, about the hottest band on the South Side. So when I got with this agent, he started taking me around – took me up to B.L.U.E.S. [a popular North Side club]; they let me sit in, and that man heard me, and the guy from Kingston Mines [across the street] came over and heard me and said, 'We gonna give you some work.' So they gave me some work. Next time you know, I was in Blue Chicago [downtown] – the guy had me working, y'know?"

Savvy and opportunistic ("I seen I was going to be around tourists"), Linsey then recorded a series of CDs, which he produced and distributed independently. They didn't get much radio play, but they brought in some money and expanded his reputation. "The more money I made," he affirms, "the more I invested in myself. They been doing good and still selling."

No doubt because of those years of experience, as well as his hard-won businesslike attitude and determination, Linsey recorded this, his first-ever CD on an established label, with a rare blend of improvisational flair and no-nonsense attention to detail. "I did it live," he avers with justifiable pride, "and I didn't have to go back and overdub no singing. Not one song. And I just had to overdub two quitar solos, and that was it."

The songs, meanwhile, combine streetsy toughness with an eclectic approach that reflects Linsey's diverse musical influences. Although most of what's here is rooted solidly in the postwar blues tradition, there are strong flavorings of deep soul (the title tune is based on the melodic structure of the Eddie Floyd/Al Green classic "I've Never Found A Girl") and funk-driven R&B (a sharp-eared listener will hear echoes of Parliament's "Give Up the Funk" on the concluding cut, Linsey's imaginative updating of the Robert Johnson myth).

It's all part of Linsey's determination to "keep the blues alive," as he says, but to do so without becoming a copycat or repeating well-worn ideas until they've lost their sheen. The blues, to him, is a living and breathing music; it's part of who he is, not just something he plays. "I like the traditional sound," he says, "then I like my sound, and I try to get it all there together, where they can really combine together and make one thing. I hear a lot of guitar players all playing in the same – all trying to sound like somebody else. I don 't want to be known for that. When you hear me, I want you to know who I am. I'm still living; I still got a story to tell." – **David Whiteis**

While much has been documented about the historical contributions of New Orleans to jazz, there is also a vibrant contemporary scene incorporating that history into inspired and living music. The connection between Chicago and New Orleans is equally storied and that tradition continues through trombonist and organizer Jeff Albert who's septet the Lucky 7's is a com-

bination of premier Chicago improvisers (Josh Berman, Keefe Jackson, Jason Adasiewicz, Jeb Bishop) and Katrina-displaced Quinn Kirchner and Matthew Golombisky. On their second outing, Pluto Junkyard (Clean Feed 141),

Albert's compositions and brawny trombone sound contrast nicely with co-leader Jeb Bishop - with whom he shares a musical kinship and sympathy. Apart from his work with the Lucky 7's, Albert's time is divided be-

and international talent alike, including Ken Vandermark, Wilbert De Joode, Hamid Drake and Wolter Wierbos. Cellist Helen Gillet, another frequent collaborator of Albert's and Chicagoans, has carved out a highly personal approach to improvising. Similar to her Chicago contemporaries Tomeika Reid and Fred Longberg-holm, Gillet has found ways to incorporate the full tonal palette of the instrument itself and modify it with loop stations, amplification and various ped-

als. A prime example of this is the opening track, "Walking Milo" from her impressive trio release Running of the Bells (Helen Gillet 01). The piece begins with solo cello being layered on top of itself with thoughtful momentum and

beautifully arcing lines eventually joined by saxophone. The rest of the CD, which has received national acclaim (including a 4 star review in Downbeat), finds Gillet's trio running the gamut from groove oriented pieces ("Cheller," "Gypsum") to more freely improvised moments ("Running of the Bells"). Further highlighting the city's draw to international talent, Italian drummer Marcello Benetti has recently taken up residence in

New Orleans and brings both Gillet and Albert together in his quartet on Shuffled (Caligola 2150). With compositions like the driving "Green Card" and the second-line referencing "Primero (Dia En Nueva Orleans)" Shuffled



Benetti displays his exceptionally clear and hard swinging style. Benetti is equally at home displaying his good humor and joy of playing in the tracks "819 Port Street (Elsie's Shoes)" and "BFF (Lili's List)." In many ways, this release is an excellent document of the current state of the scene and the city itself: vibrant, proud of its heritage and boldly looking to the future.

THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF RICHARD HARDING, THE QUIET KNIGHT

The *Chicago Sun-Times'* Dave Hoekstra wrote a nearly full-page obituary for one of Chicago's greatest club owners recently.

Richard Harding loved good music, served good liquor, was eminently fair to the artists and showed excellent taste in the music he booked.. What more can you ask of a club owner?

The first club I recall is **Poor Richards**, which was originally at 1363 North Sedgwick virtually across the street from the notorious Cabrini-Green project. The first gig I heard about was when he hired Big Joe Williams before moving the club to a location at 1363 Wells Street. I believe he included in his bookings Sleepy John Estes and possibly Arthur Crudup. He had moved only a block or two but it placed him in the most important center for music in the city....Wells Street in the 60s.

Also located on Wells were: Mother Blues, originally operated by a folk trio that recorded for Mercury, eventually became a jazz/blues hot spot managed by Bob Wetlauffer who'd been a bartender at the Gate of Horn; and Big John's where the Butterfield-(We recorded Bloomfield-Siegal-Schwall, etc. guys played. J.B.Hutto's last Delmark there, Stompin" At Mother Blues, DE-778). Little Brother Montgomery opened the Plugged Nickel with a trad band but when they brought in Woody Herman for a one-nighter they started booking blues,. Miles Davis did one of his classic albums there. Judy Roberts started her career at Bulls. The original Earl of Old Town presented banjoist Eddie Davis and a full size trad band, later became a legendary folk club with Steve Goodman, John Prine, etc. a veteran of the Sweethearts of Rhythm worked at another club. Blues legend Curtis Jones played his last date in the U,S. there before being seduced to France.

The police riot during the Democratic convention on 1968 was as bad on Wells Street as anything you saw in Grant Park. Then there seemed to be a crime problem on Wells so the music scene moved up Lincoln Avenue to the Kingston Mines, Wise Fools, B,L.U.E.S., etc..

Anyway, in 1969, Richard moved into the **Quiet Night**, which I seem to recall had been a folk club. This second-floor Belmont location was spacious enough for him to bring in Muddy Waters, Miles Davis, Howling Wolf, Herbie Hancock, and to feature the Siegal-Schwall band regularly. Folk and rock figures such as Dan Hicksman, Neil Sedaka, Steve Goodman, Loudain Wainwright, Utah Phillips, Arlo Guthrie made up much of the schedule. I understand record company tour support helped.

But whenever there was a cancellation, Richard would bring in Roosevelt Sykes, which always resulted in Sunnyland Slim and Little Brother Montgomery being in the audience and often sitting-in. (I used to wonder if perhaps they weren't being paid as well.)

It lasted ten years. There was some police harassment (perhaps looking for a bribe). He sold the club and moved to Aspen, then San Francisco, before returning to Chicago and opening **DaVinci's Music Gallery** on the third floor at 2011 West North, one of the first music clubs in the Wicker Park art colony. He opened with Stan Getz. But the club soon became home for the great jazz pianist Willie Pickens. It is thought that Richard lost so much money on Getz that he couldn't continue so he soon retired again from the business.

During the younger mayor Daley's regime it was very difficult to license a club for live music. One club in our neighborhood had to chug along as a coffee house for more than a year before getting their cabaret license. Let's hope our new and better mayor Rahm Emmanuel will do somehting about this. I anticipate he will because he's a vast improvement (as are our new police chief and county commissioner over their predecessors).

I returned from a few weeks on the road to learn that Richard had returned to Chicago a few years ago and had just recently passed. Dave Hoekstra said that Harding "said his hellos because he wasn't so good at goodbyes."
