QANTAS AIRBUS A330 UPGRADE

From the end of 2014, Qantas is upgrading its Airbus A330 international and domestic fleets. These aircraft are used mostly on flights between Australia and Asia, and between the east and west coasts of Australia.

All Business Class cabins will be upgraded as will international Economy class cabins. Domestic Economy cabins will be refreshed. New in-flight entertainment systems will be rolled out right across the A330 fleet.

Overall space and comfort in all new seats will be improved from existing levels.





NEW BUSINESS SUITES

All A330s will feature Business Suites by Qantas' Creative Director, Marc Newson.

The new suites have been designed to offer comfort, flexibility and privacy, with a space that can be used for sleeping, working or relaxing.

Seats recline into a fully lie-flat bed and are positioned to give direct aisle access for all passengers (1-2-1 configuration).

Uniquely, the seats can be in recline position for take off and landing, maximising the opportunity for rest.

The combination of a sizeable console next to the seat and the design of the meal tray means customers can dine while they work.



MORE COMFORT IN ECONOMY

International Economy Class passengers will have a noticeable increase in overall comfort and legroom, with a streamlined under-seat design.

Internationally-configured A330s will have footnets and multidirectional headrests (similar to our A380 product) plus an armrest that fits neatly between the seats when folded away.

Domestic Economy Class seats will be refreshed, with new cushions and more contemporary fabrics.



LATEST IN-FLIGHT ENTERTAINMENT

In addition to Panasonic inflight entertainment systems, all A330s will be fitted with Qantas' Q-Streaming technology, which gives customers access to an extensive entertainment library streamed to tablet-style devices.

New back of seat entertainment will be fitted to the international fleet (all cabins) and domestic Business Suites, increasing the amount of content from around 300 hours to over 1500 (similar to what is offered on our A380s). On the international fleet this is in addition to Ostreaming to your own device.

- Both systems will feature integrated USB ports.
