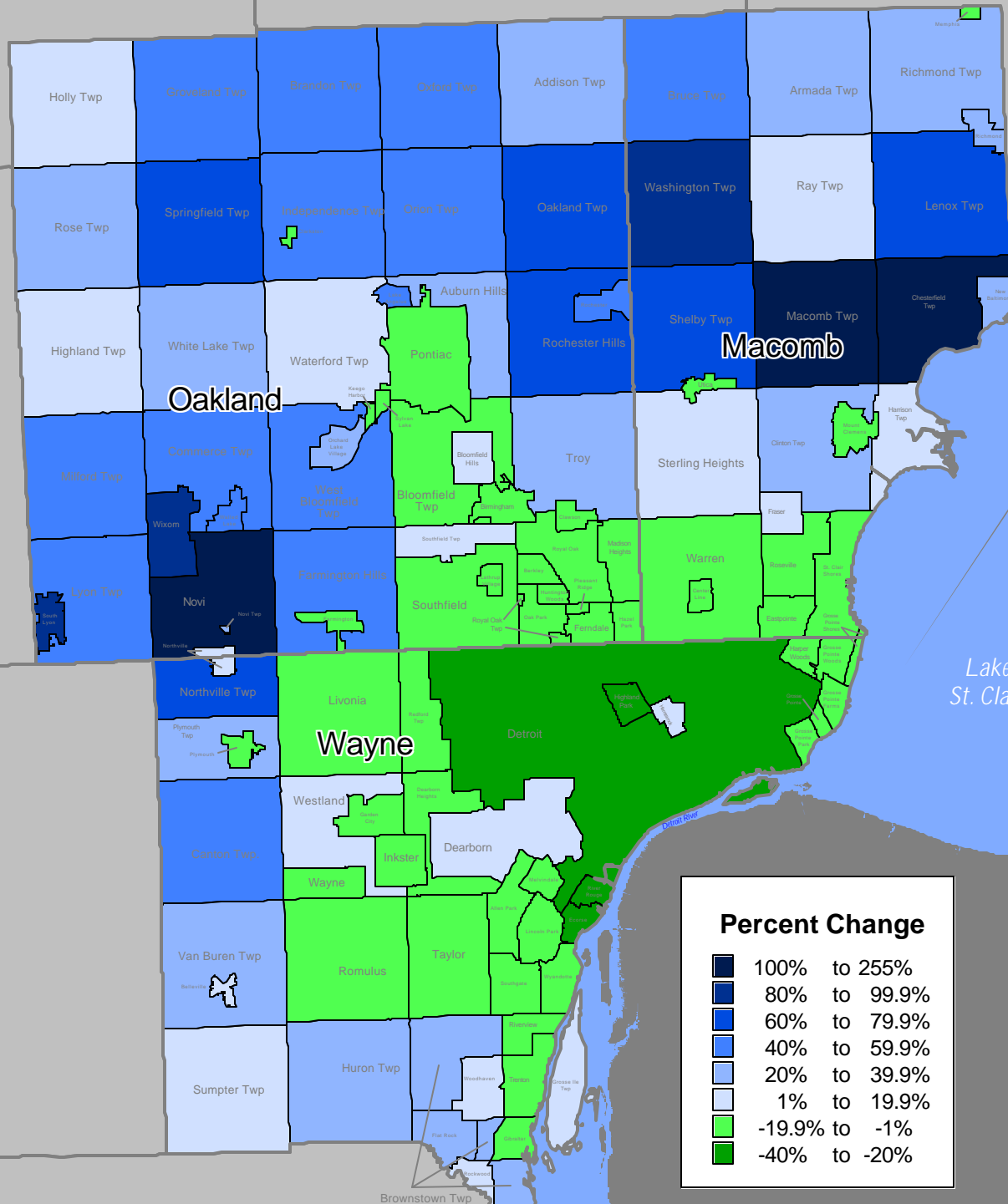

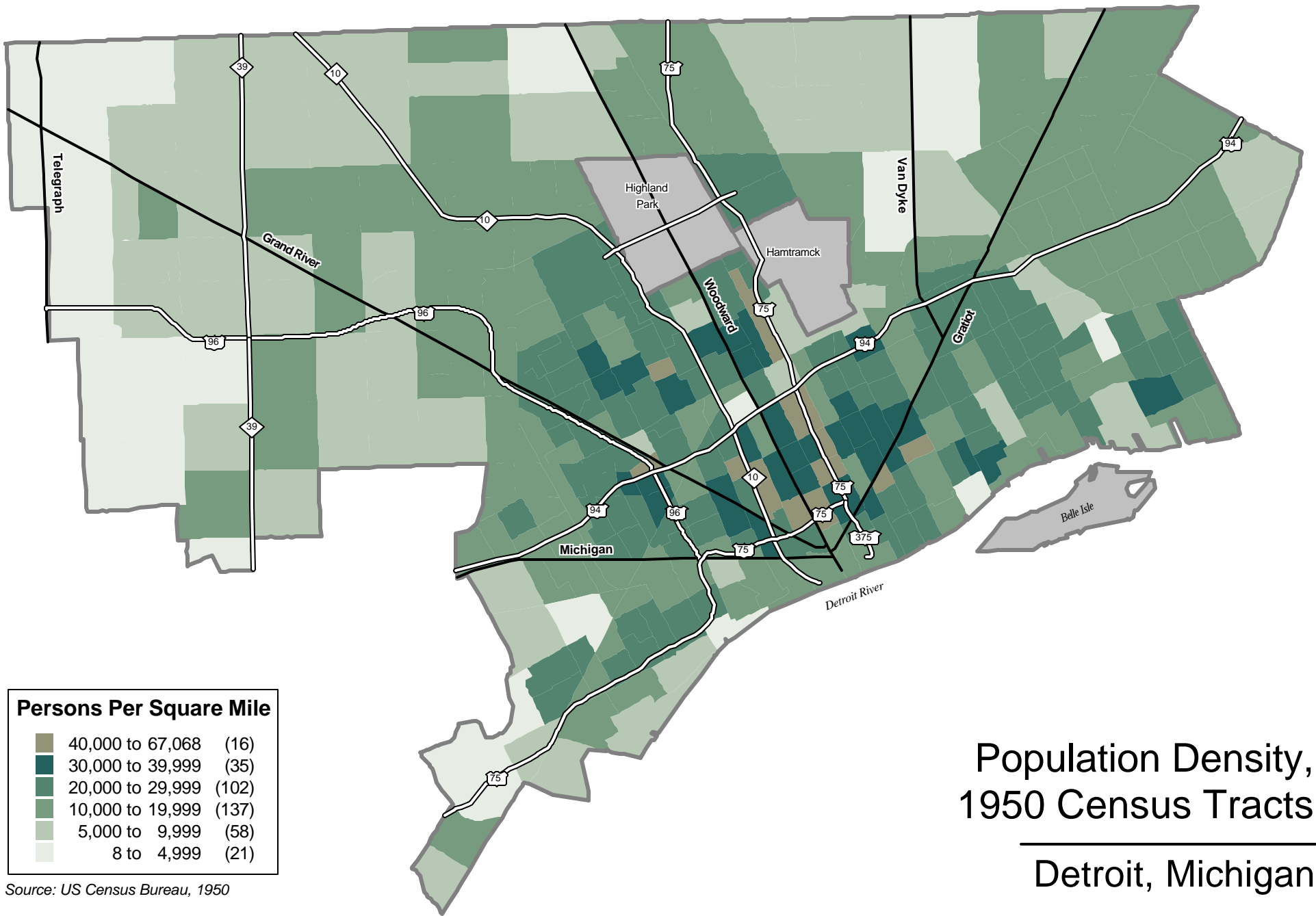
RACIAL/ETHNIC TRENDS IN SOUTHEAST MICHIGAN

Summary

- **Metropolitan Area Experiences Increased Diversity**
 - **Suburban growth in all Race/Ethnic Groups**
 - **Decade of the 1990's Brought Largest Suburban Increase for African-Americans**
 - **Asians and Hispanics Show Greatest Increases throughout the Metropolitan Area**
 - **Major Cities Throughout the Metropolitan Area Increase Their Share of Minorities**
 - **Detroit's African-American Population Drops for the First Time, but Share Still Grows**
 - **Whites Continue to Leave the City of Detroit**
 - **Detroit's Hispanic and Asian Groups Grow Significantly**
 - **Multi-Race Population is Significant in Areas with Large Middle-Eastern Communities**

Metropolitan Detroit MCD's 1980 - 2000 Population Change





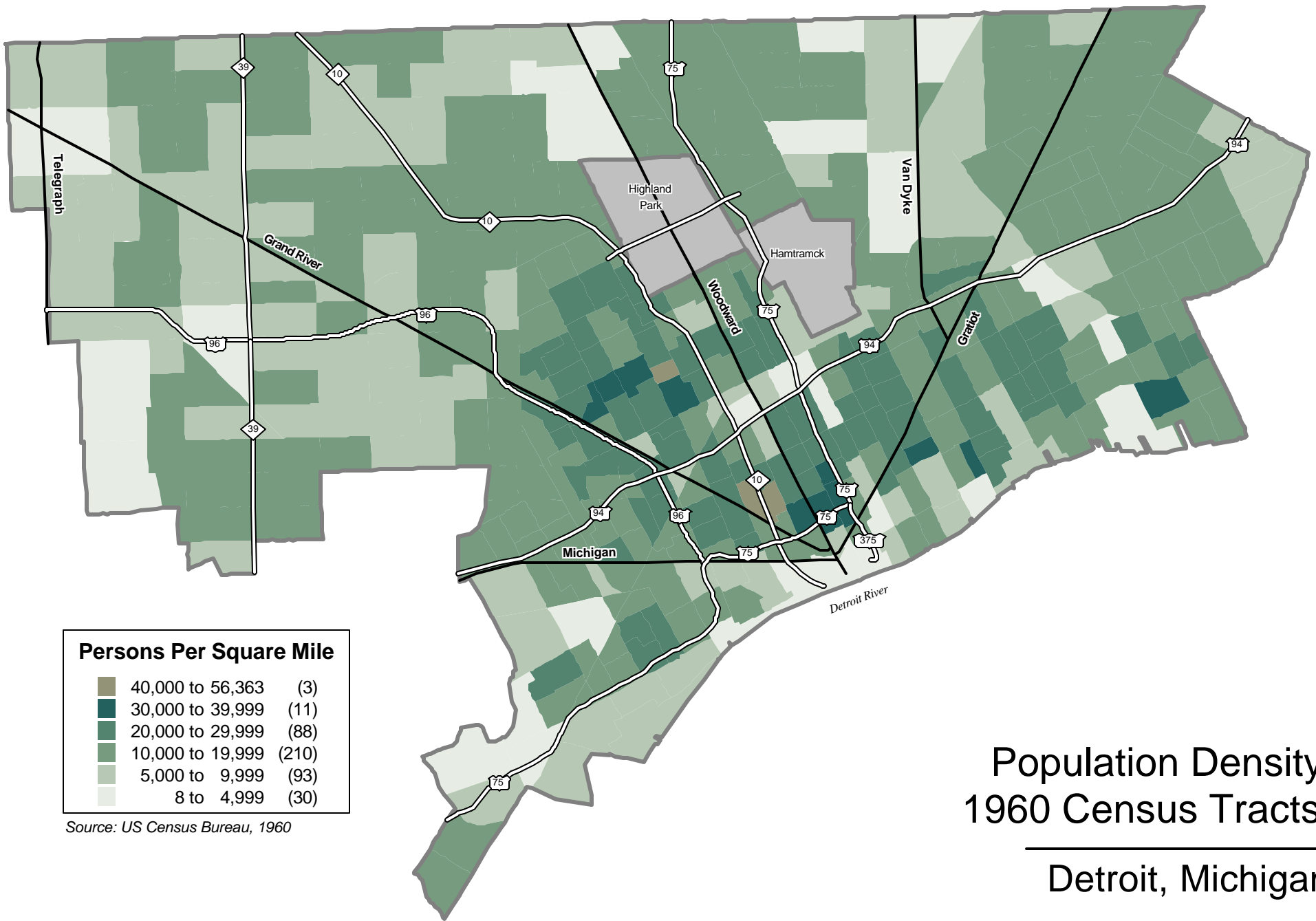

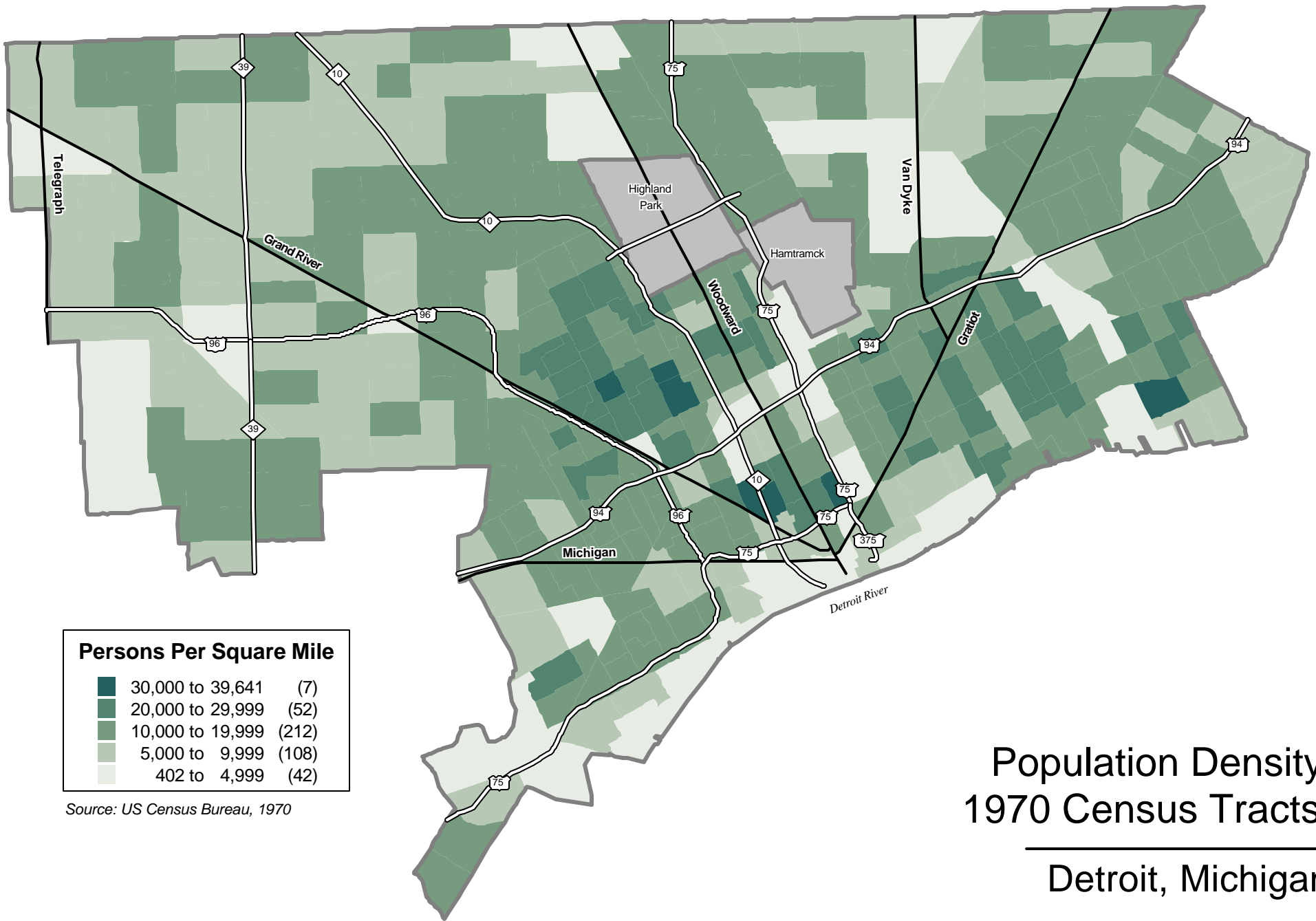

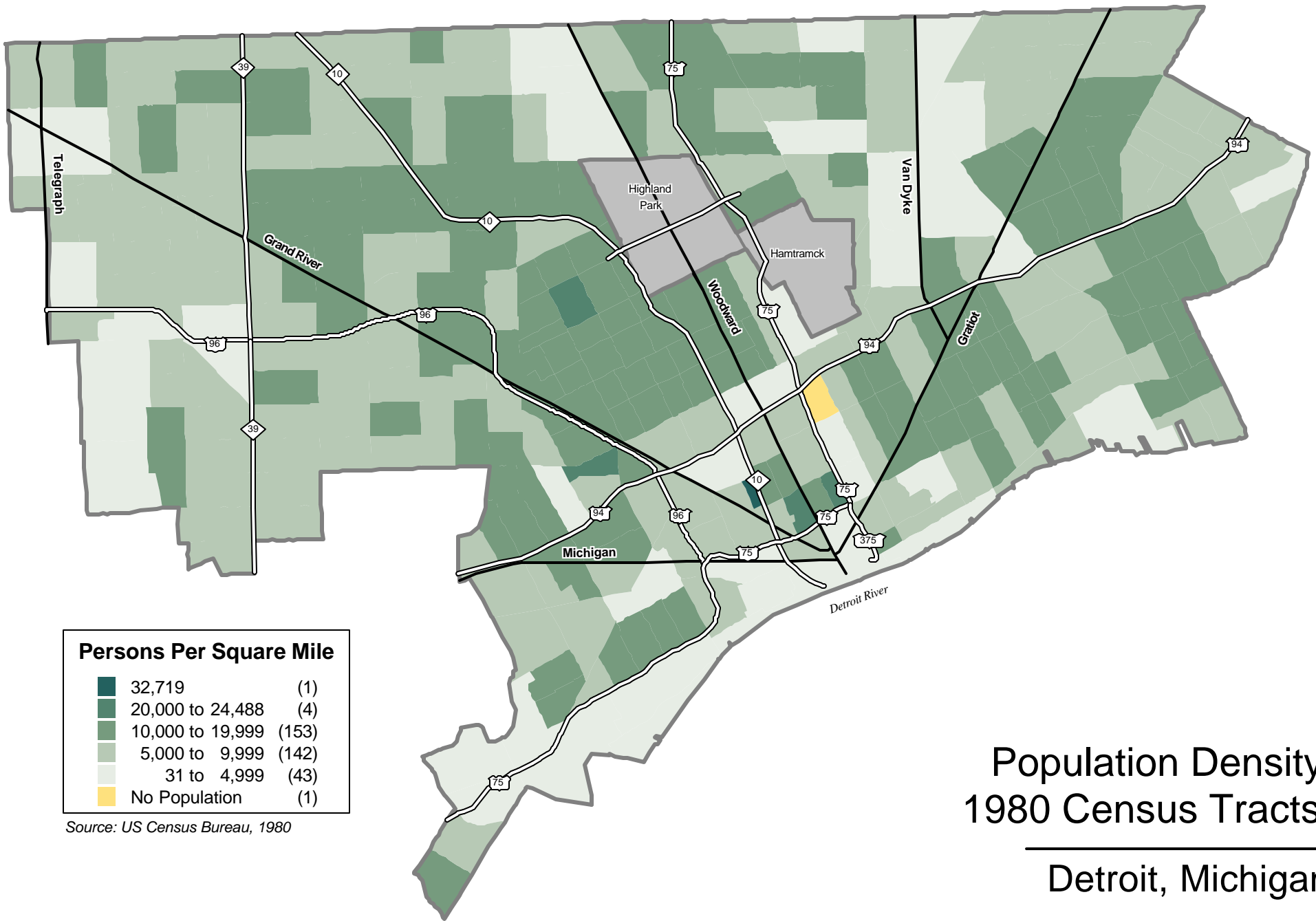

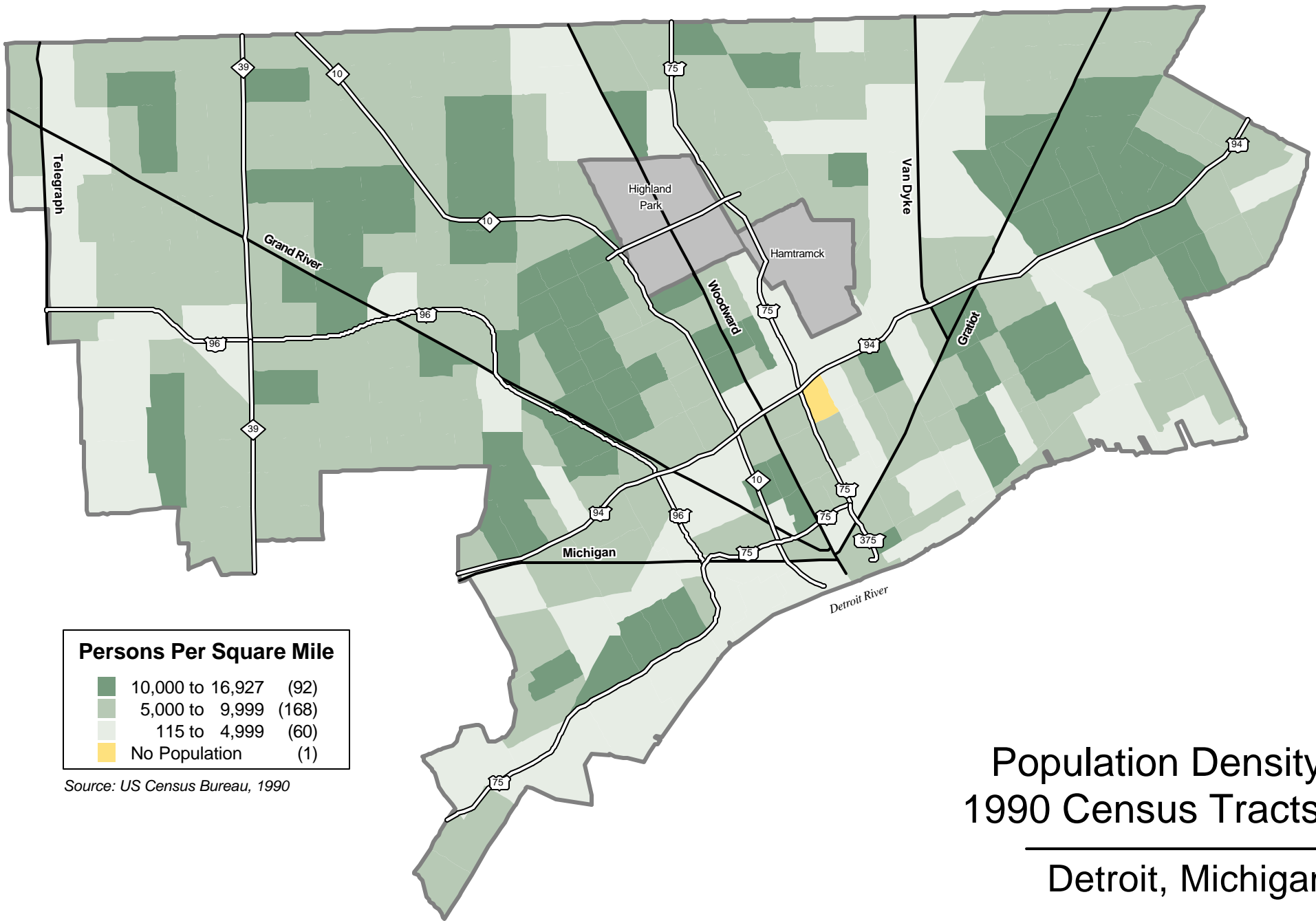

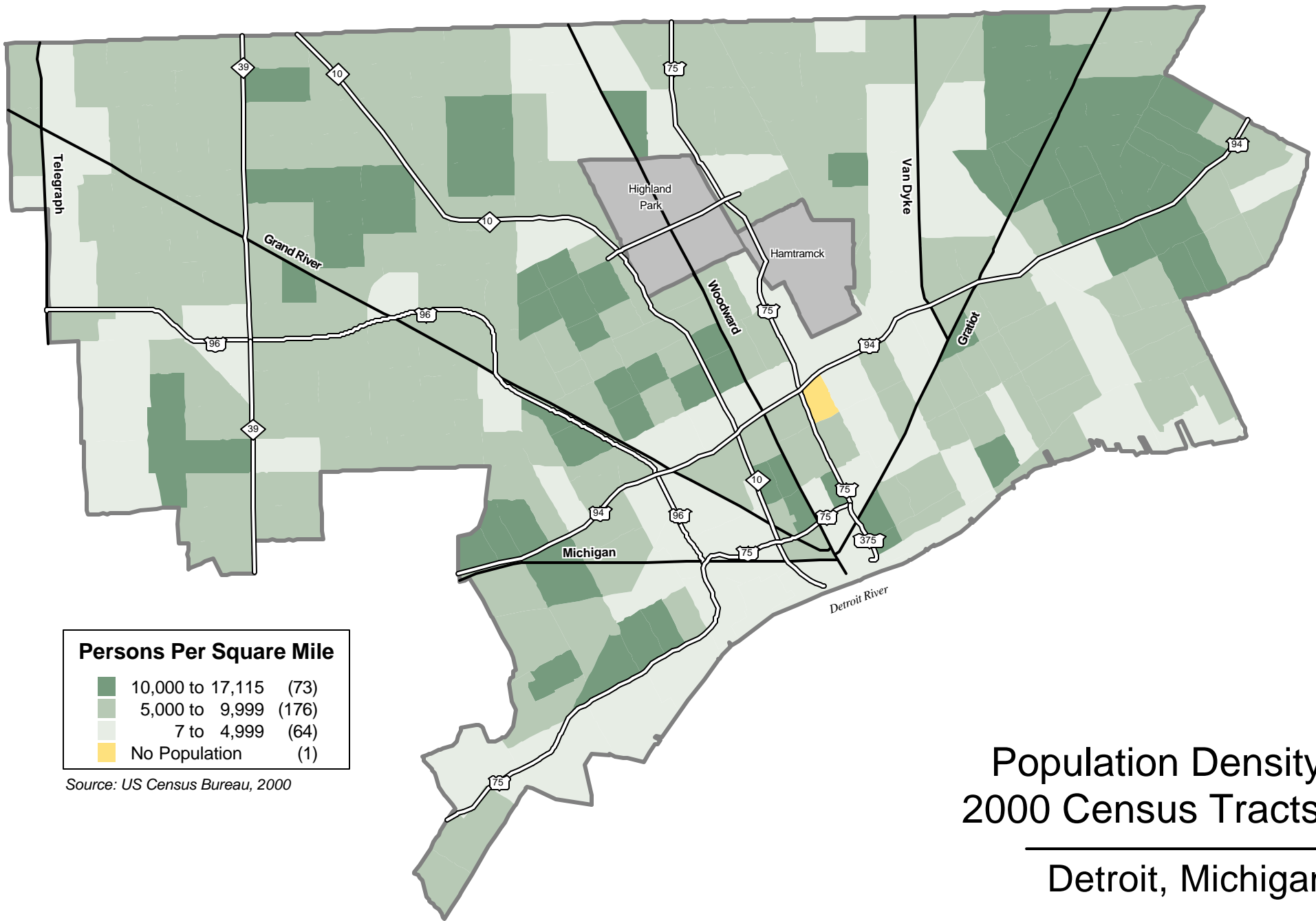

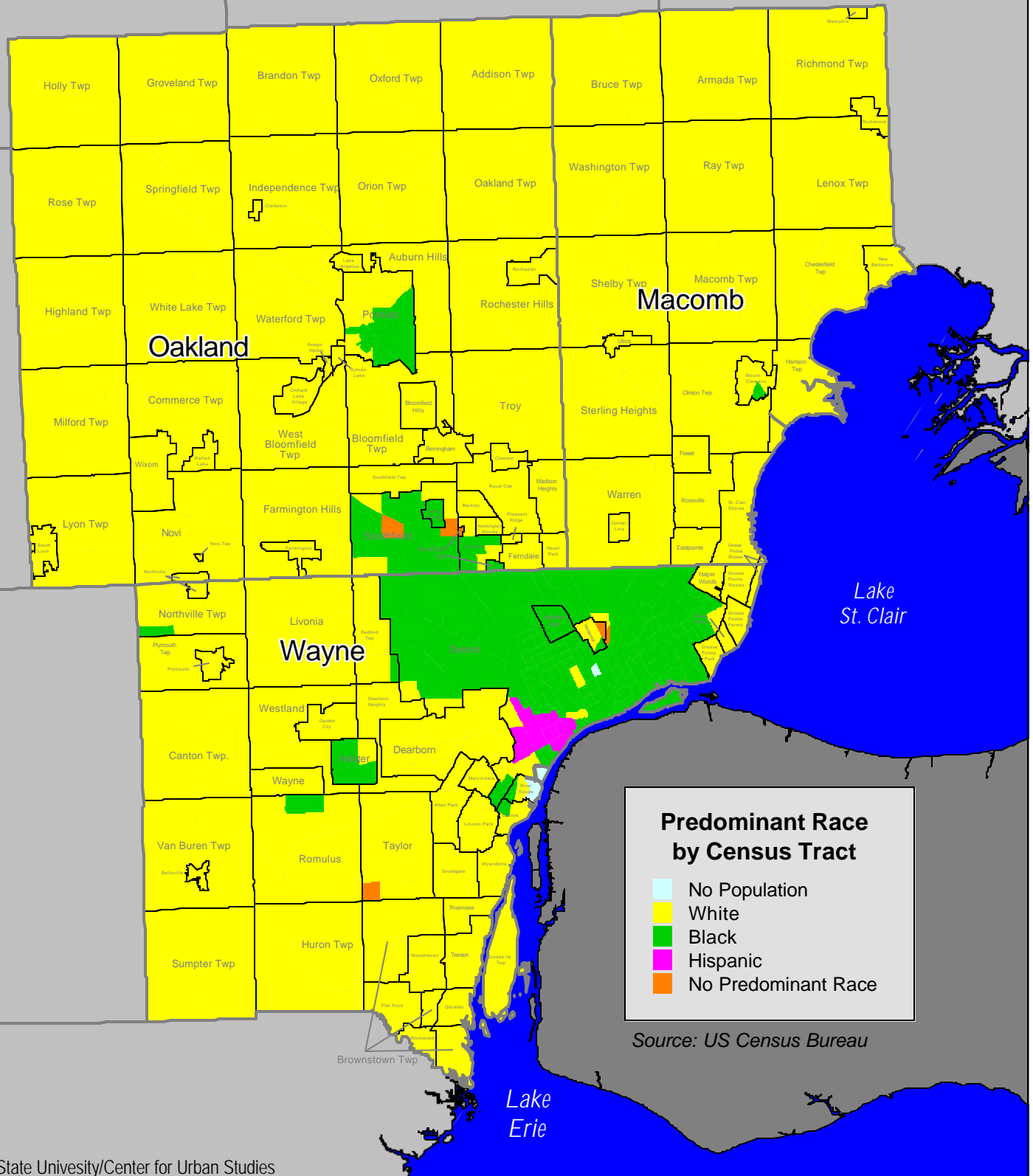

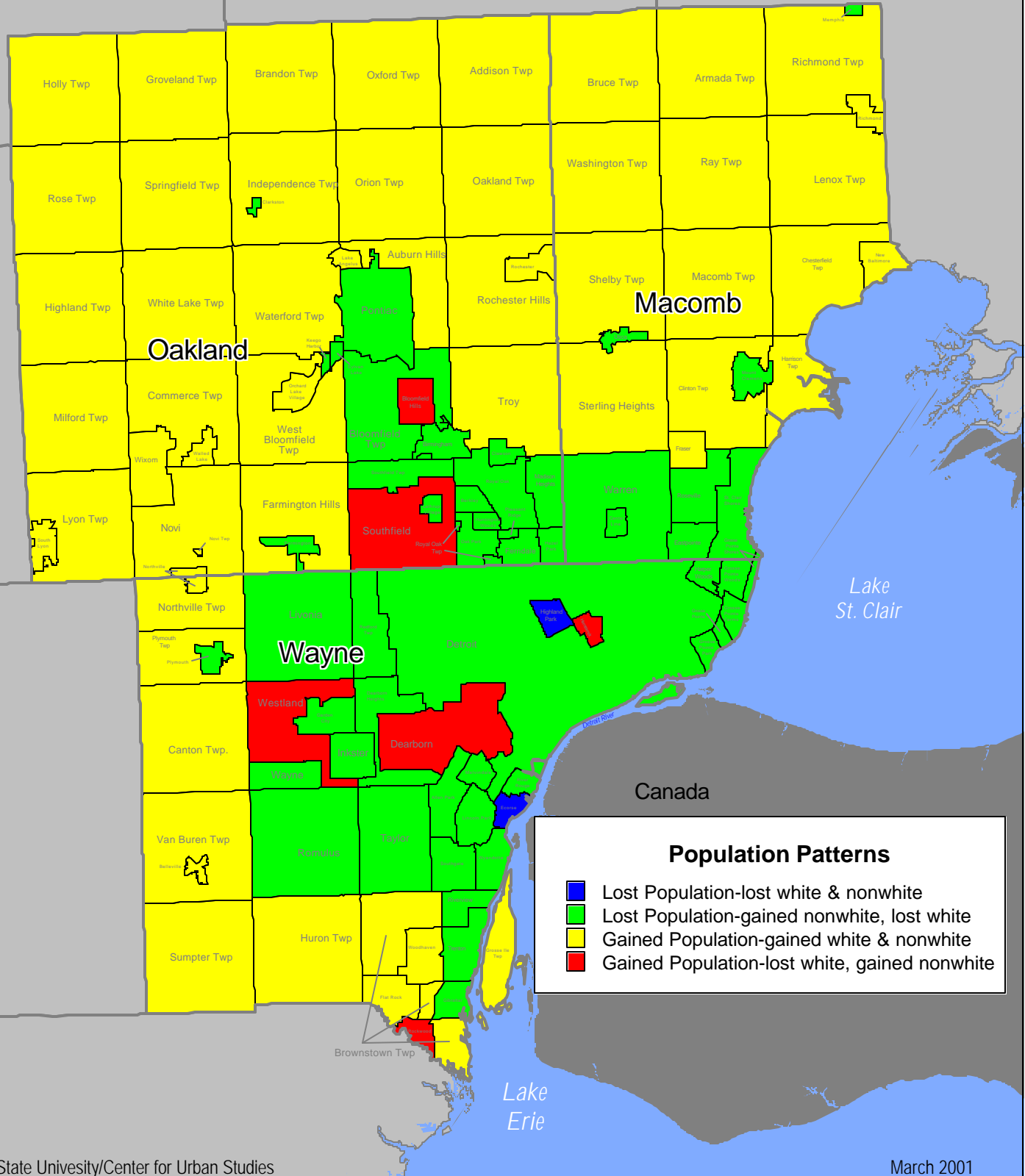

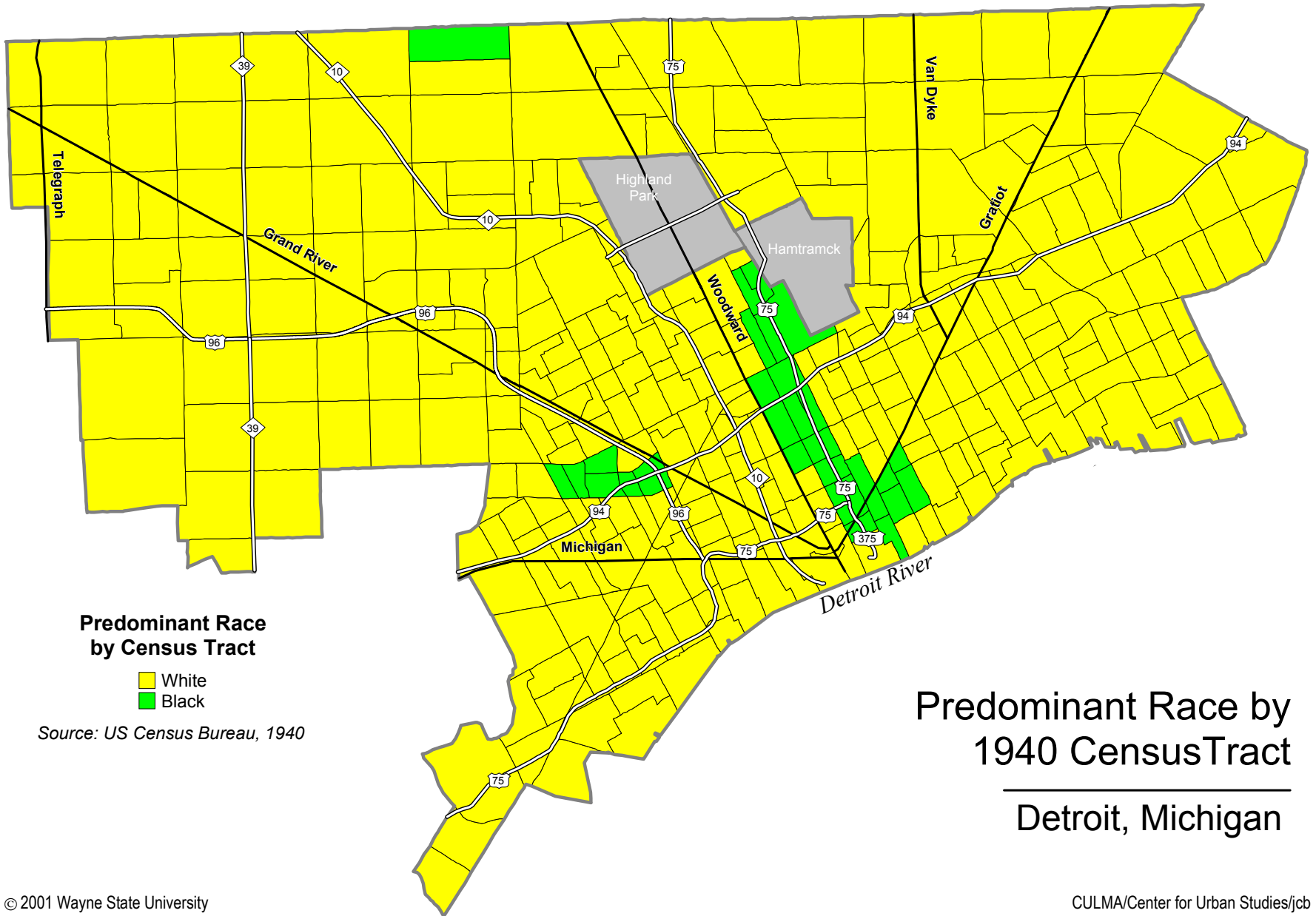

1990 - 2000 Population Change





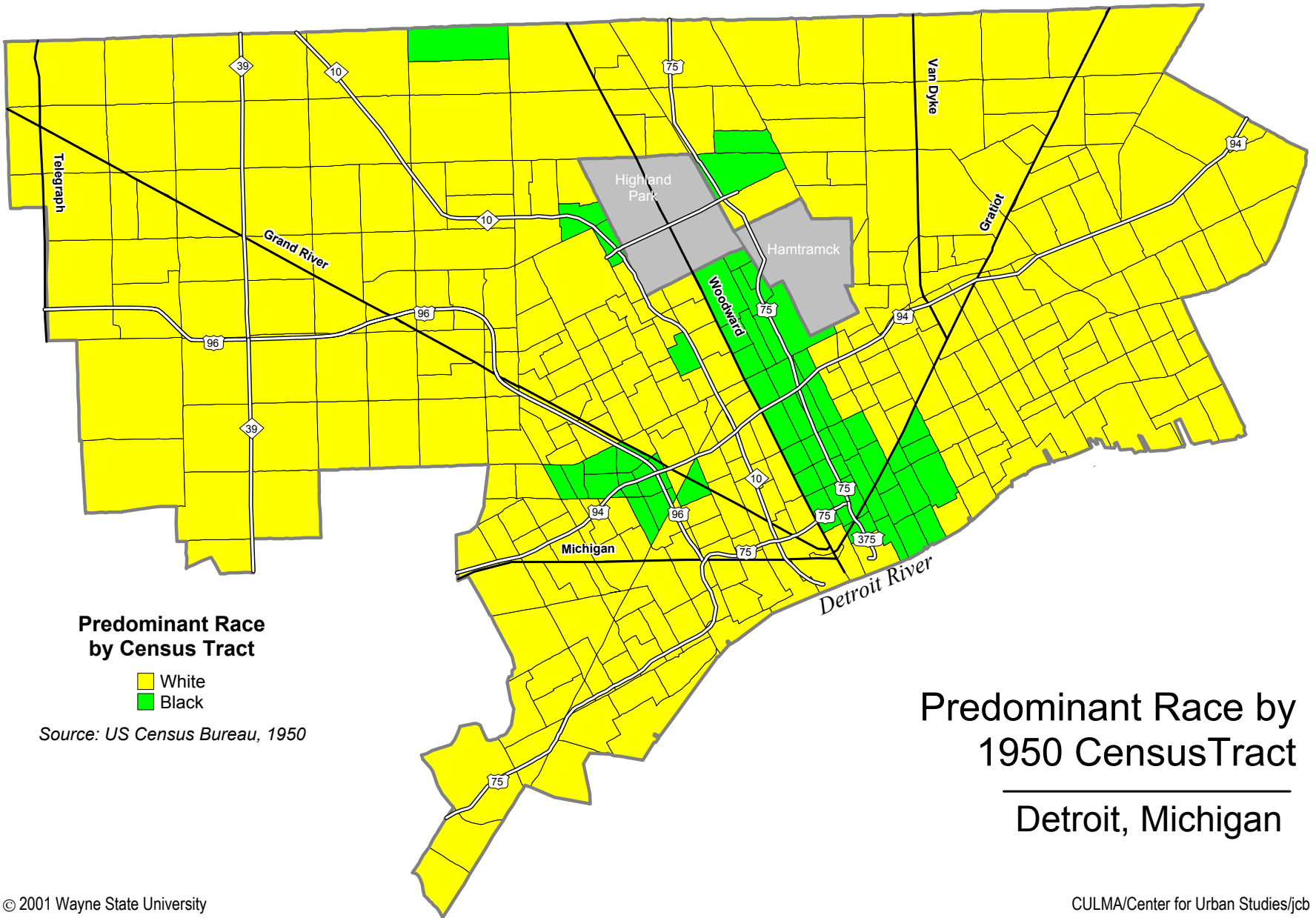

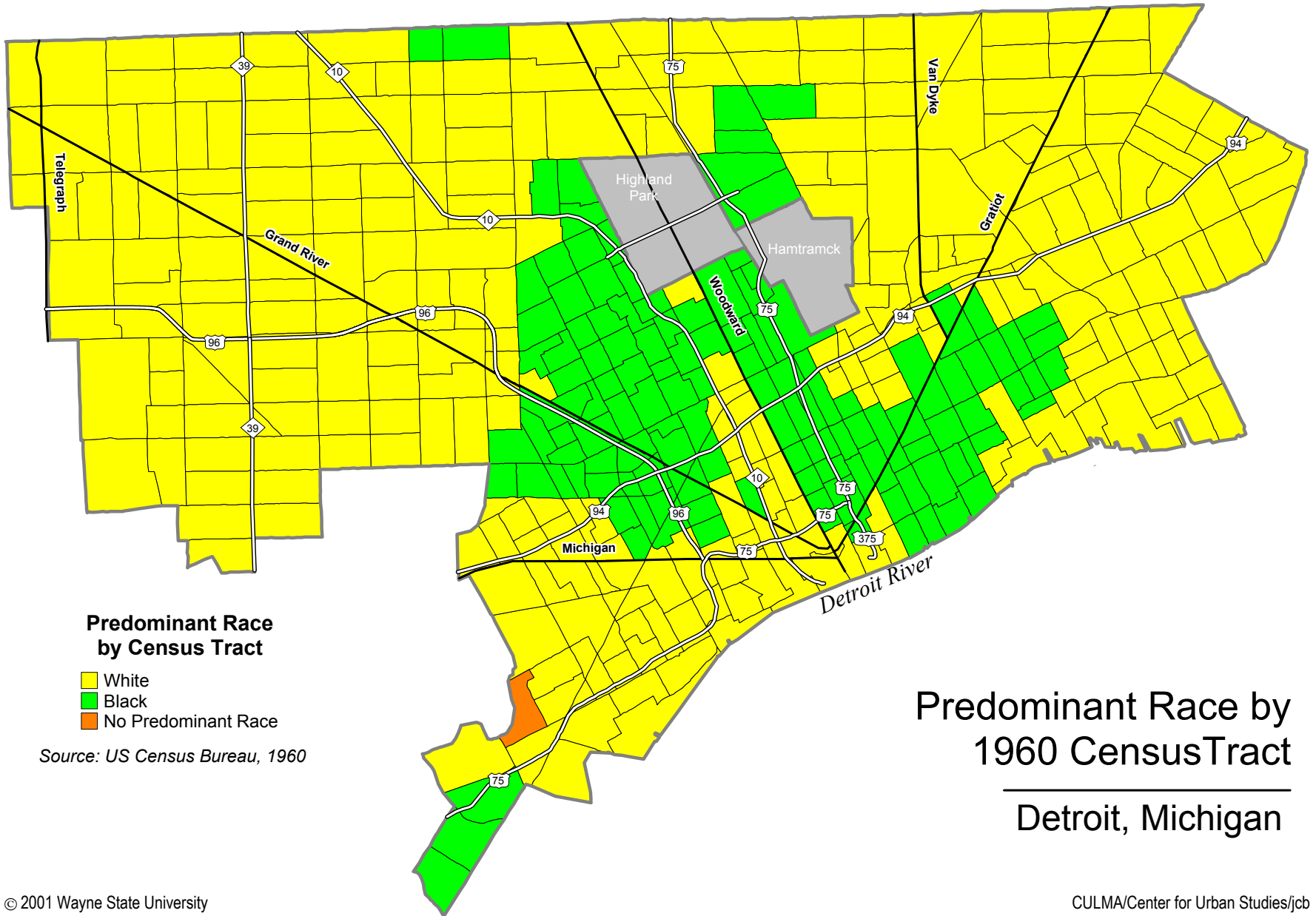
**Predominant Race by
1940 Census Tract**

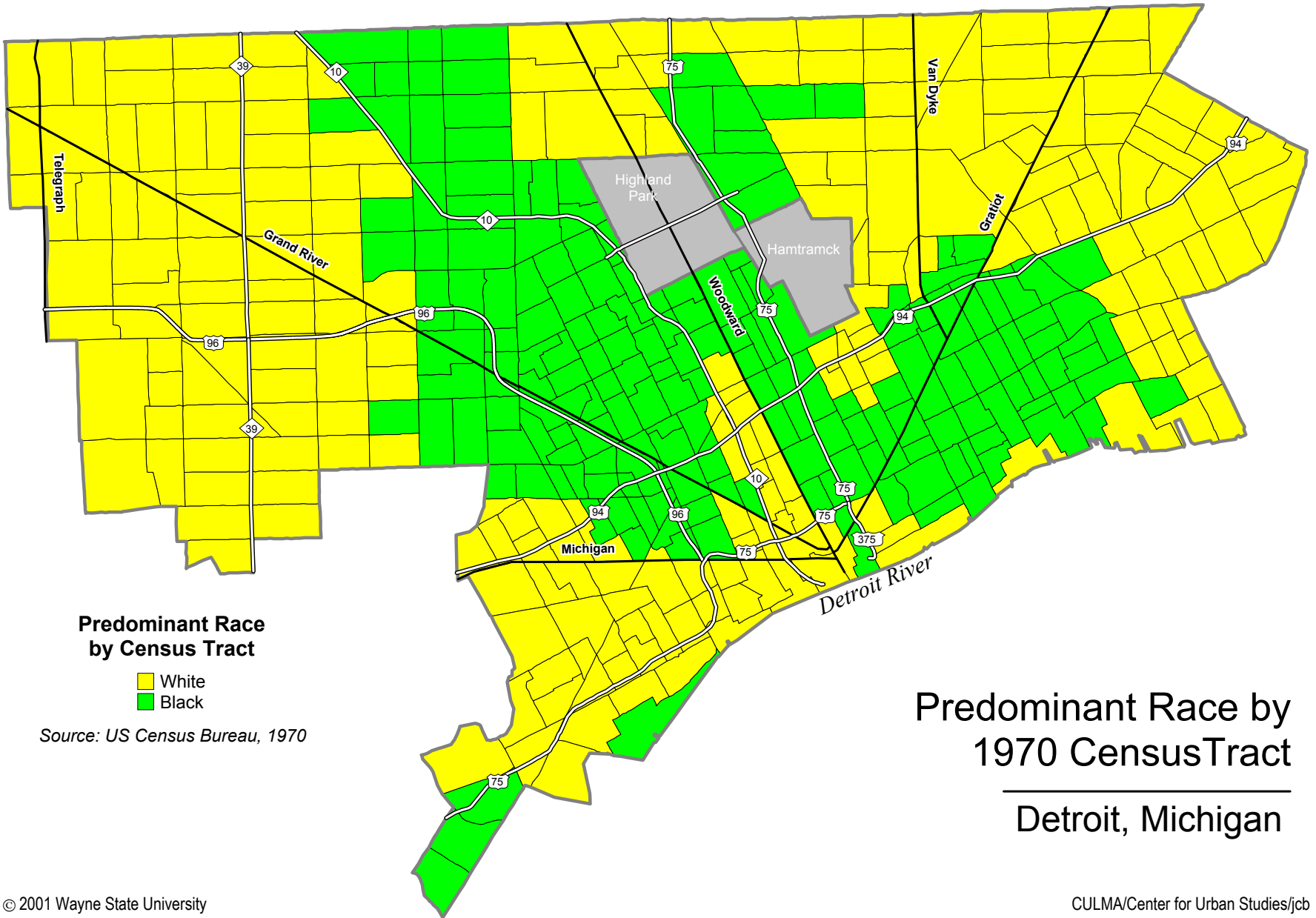

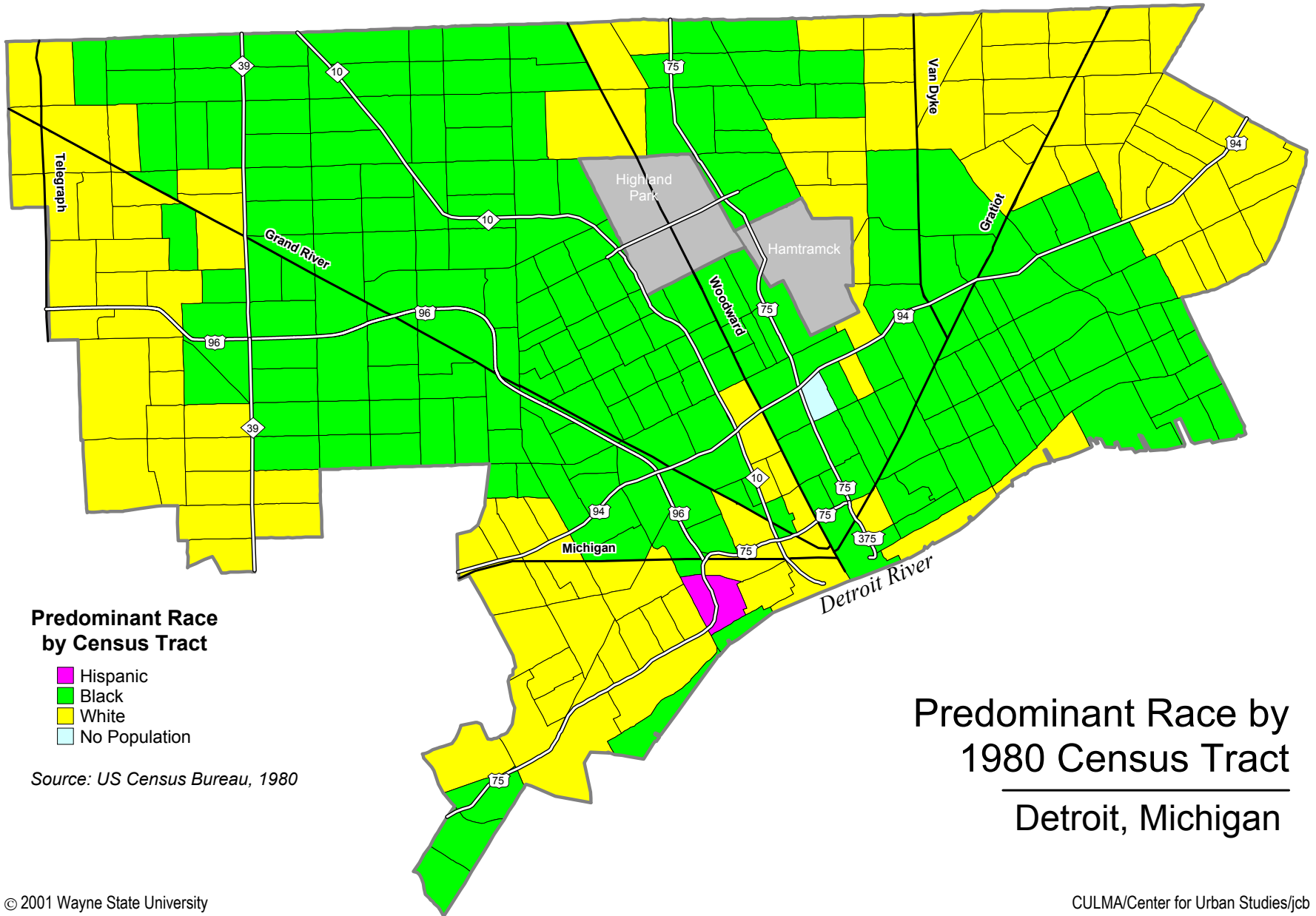

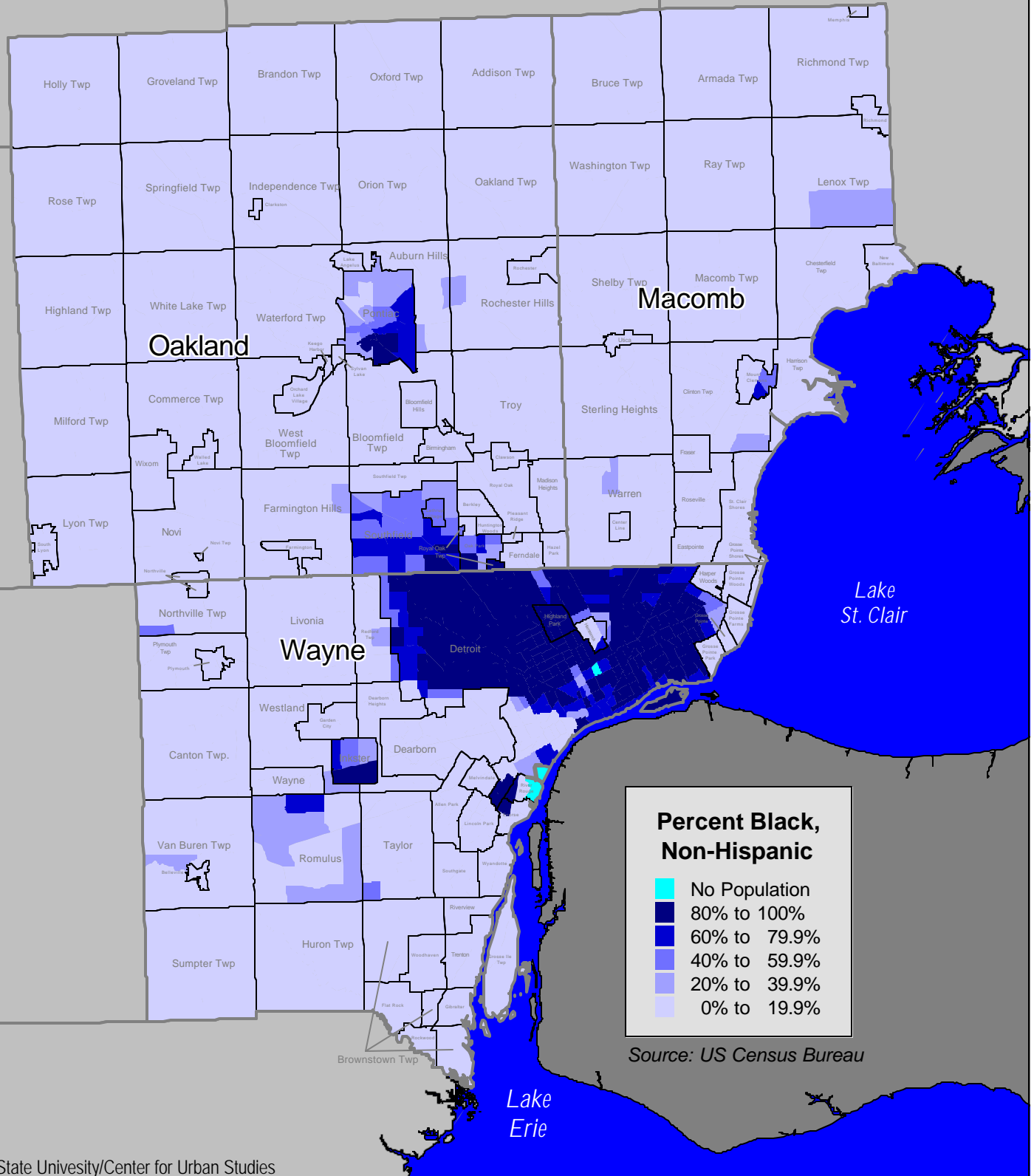






Predominant Race by 2000 Census Tract Detroit, Michigan

Black Population by 2000 Census Tract Metropolitan Detroit Area



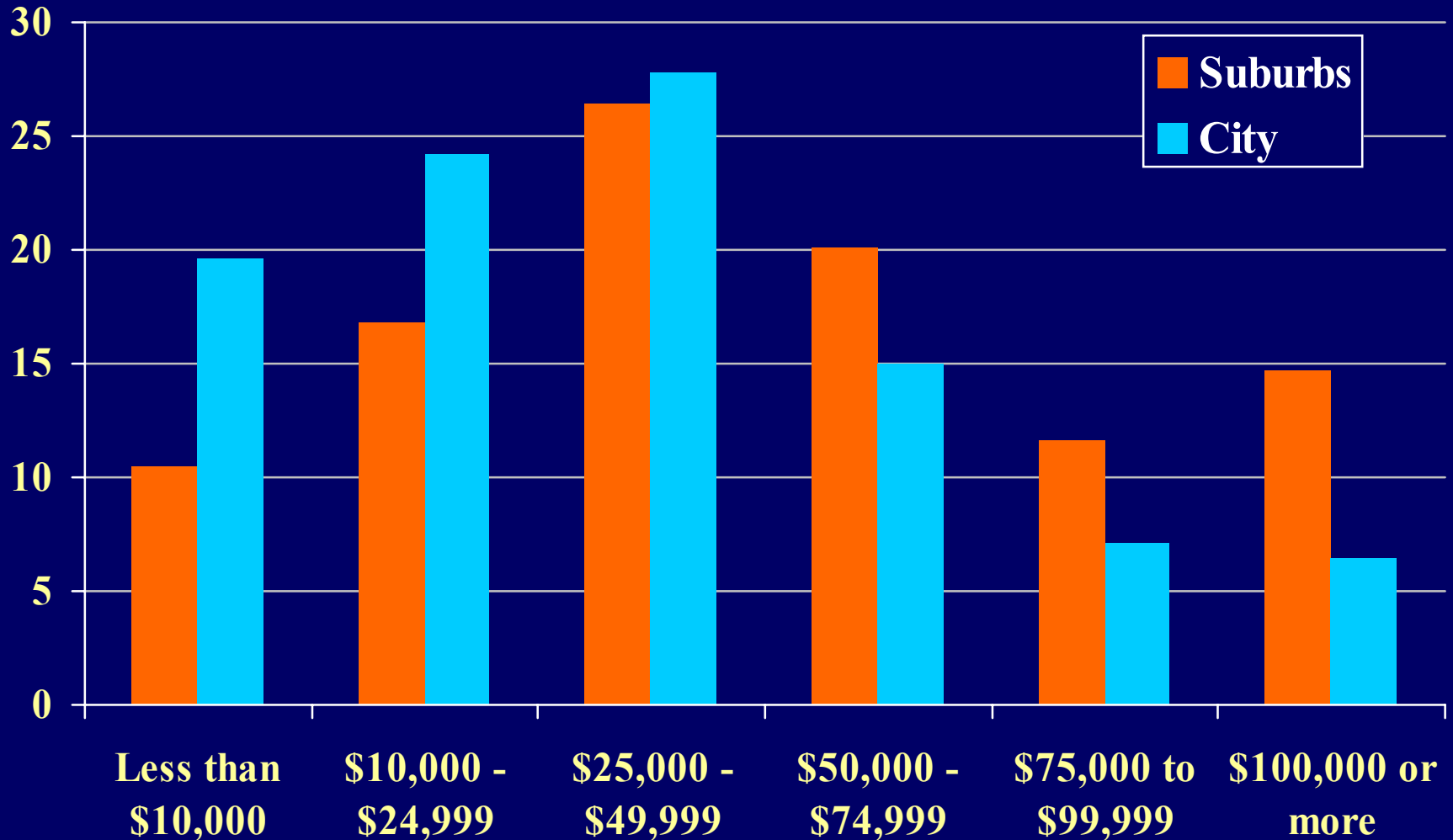

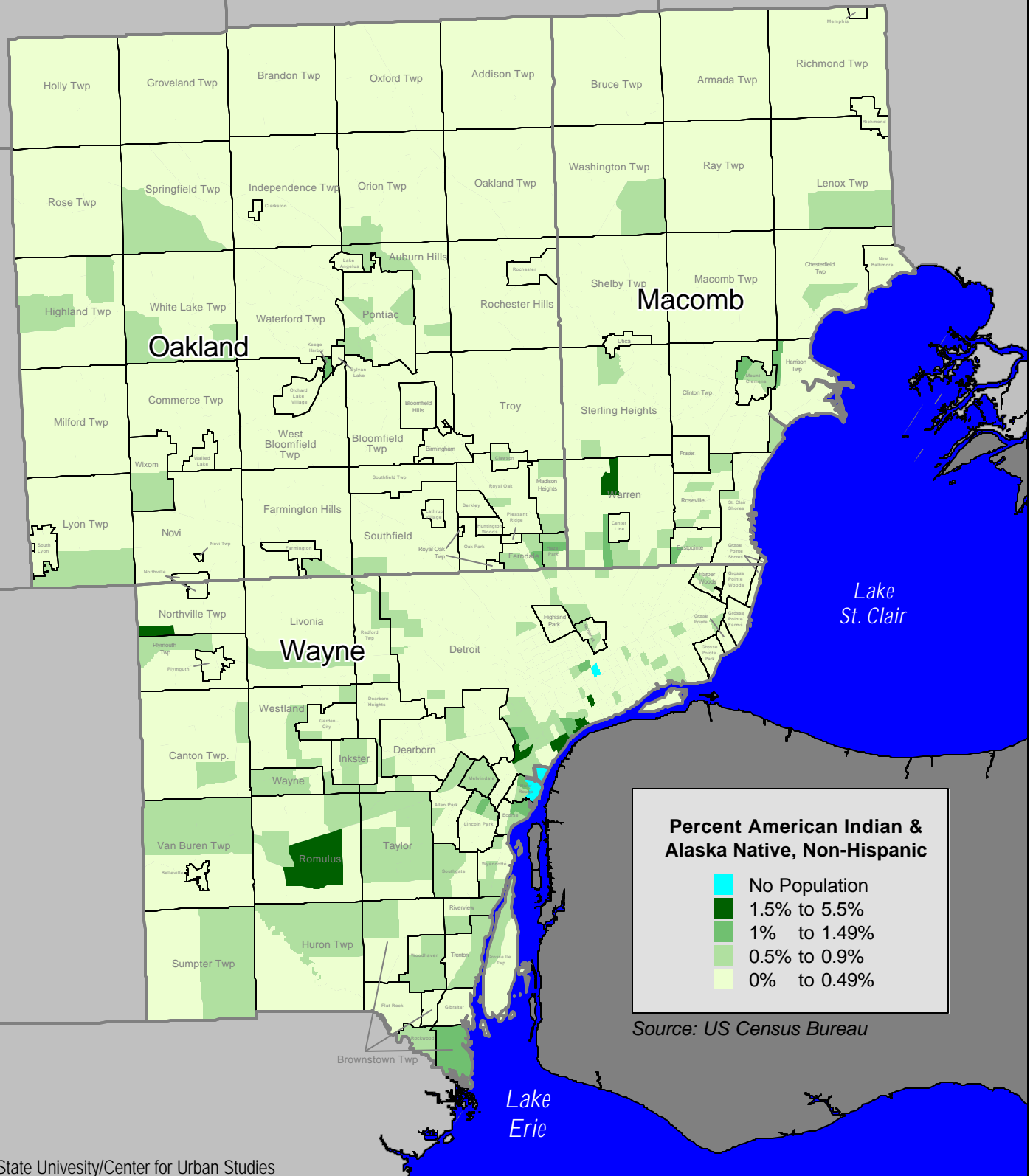

The 1990s Saw Record Movement of Middle and Upper Class Blacks to the Suburbs



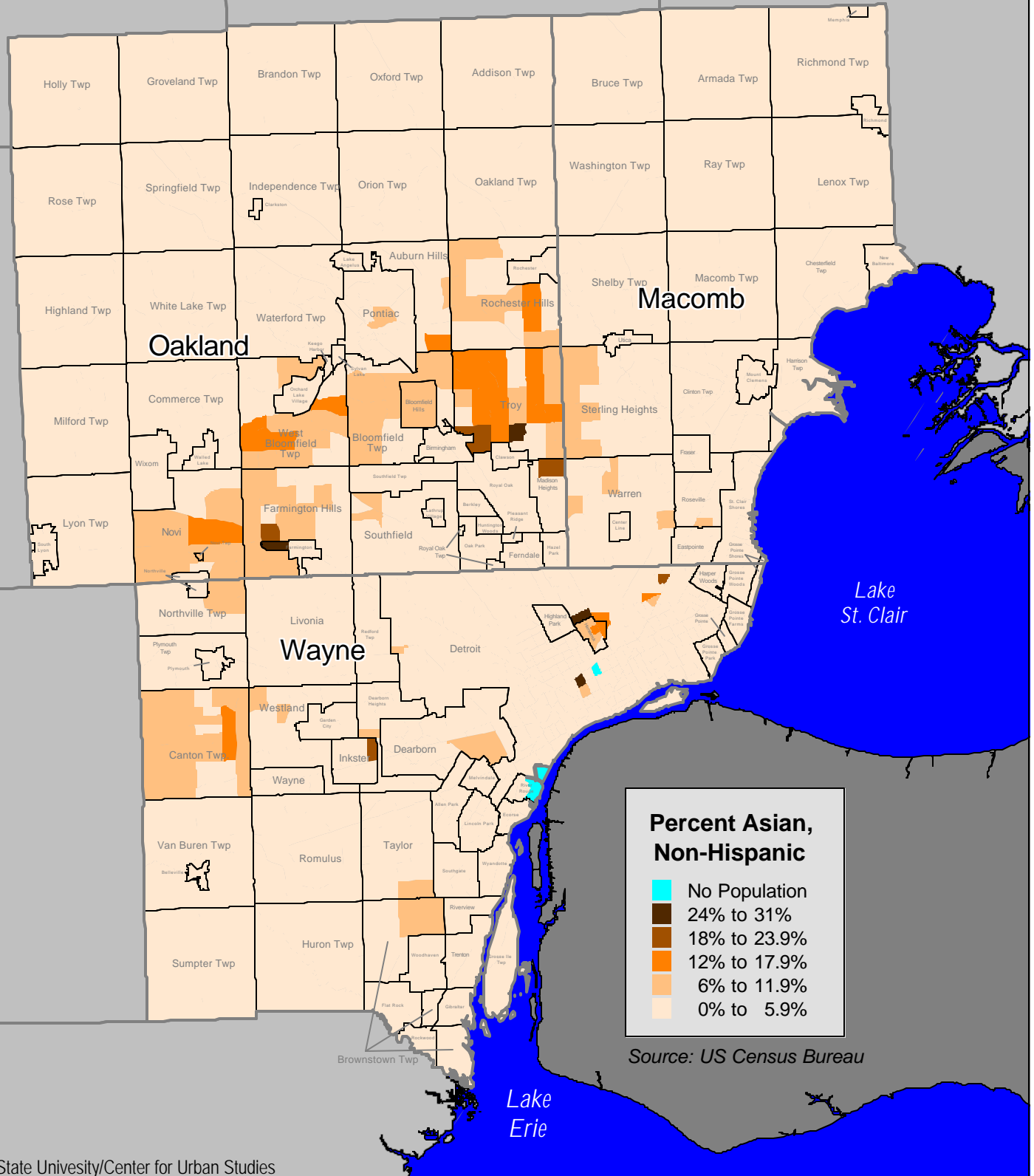
American Indian & Alaska Native Population by 2000 Census Tract Metropolitan Detroit Area

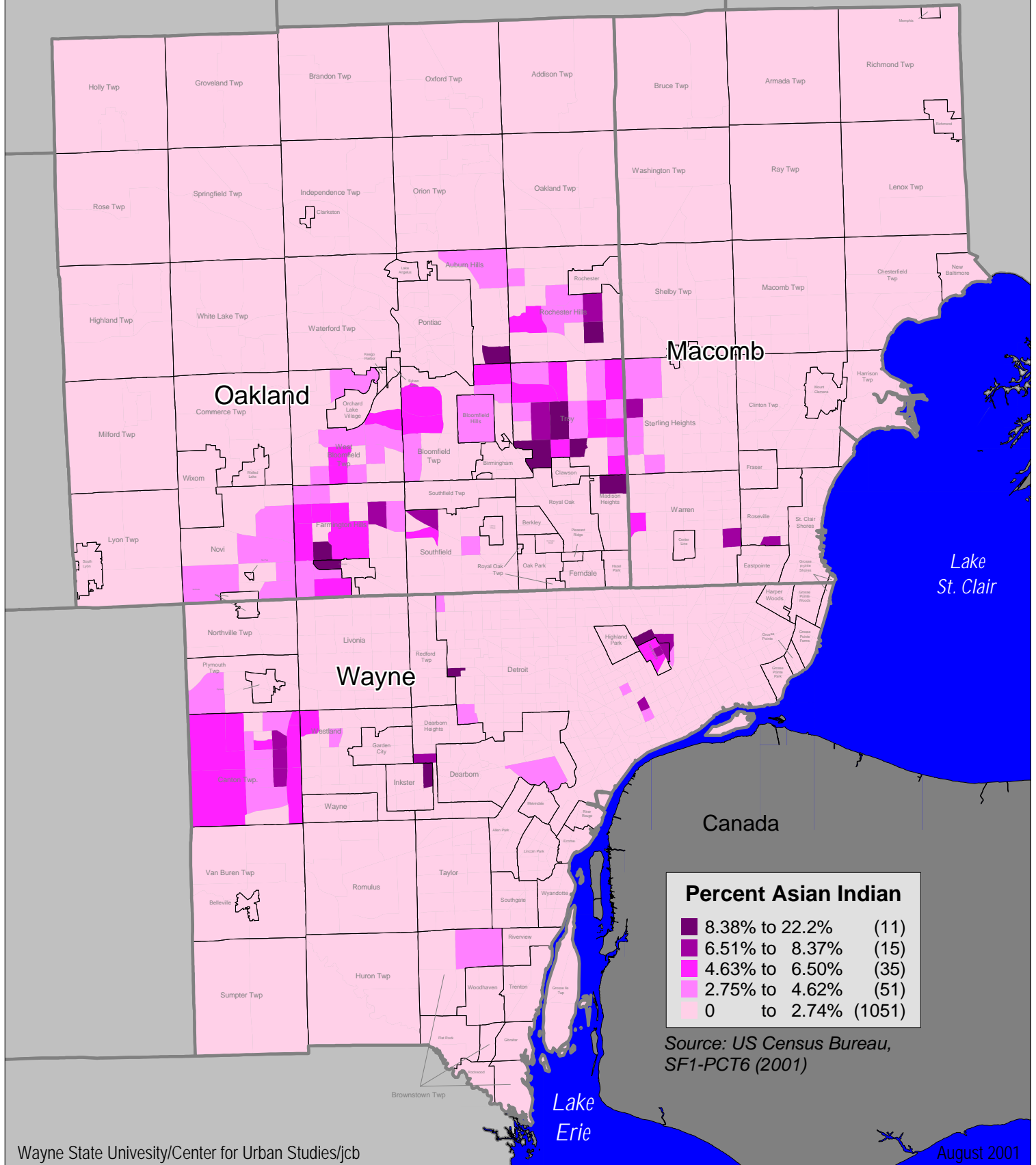
Asian Population by 2000 Census Tract Metropolitan Detroit Area



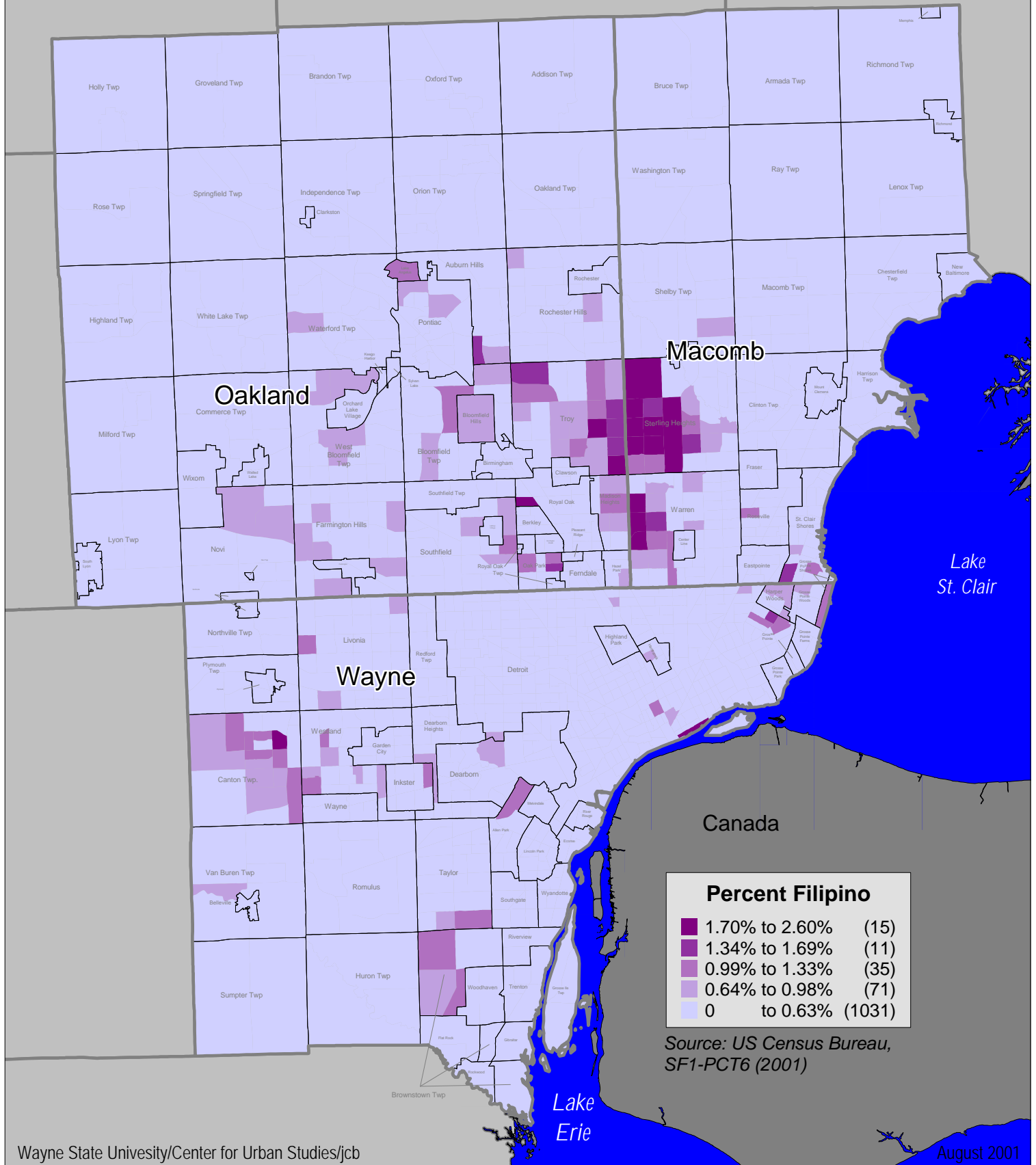

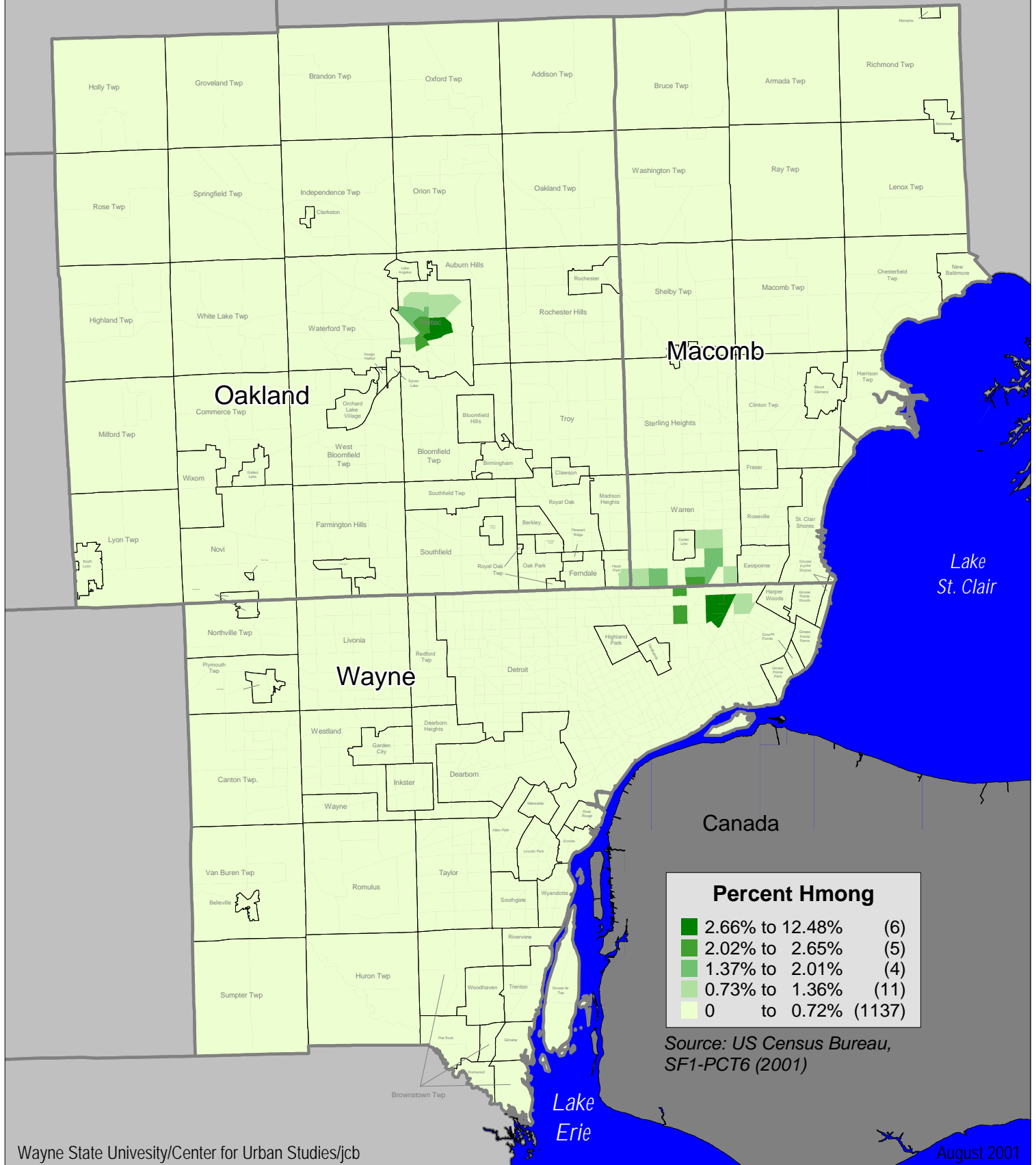
Asian Indian Population by 2000 Census Tract Tri-County Area



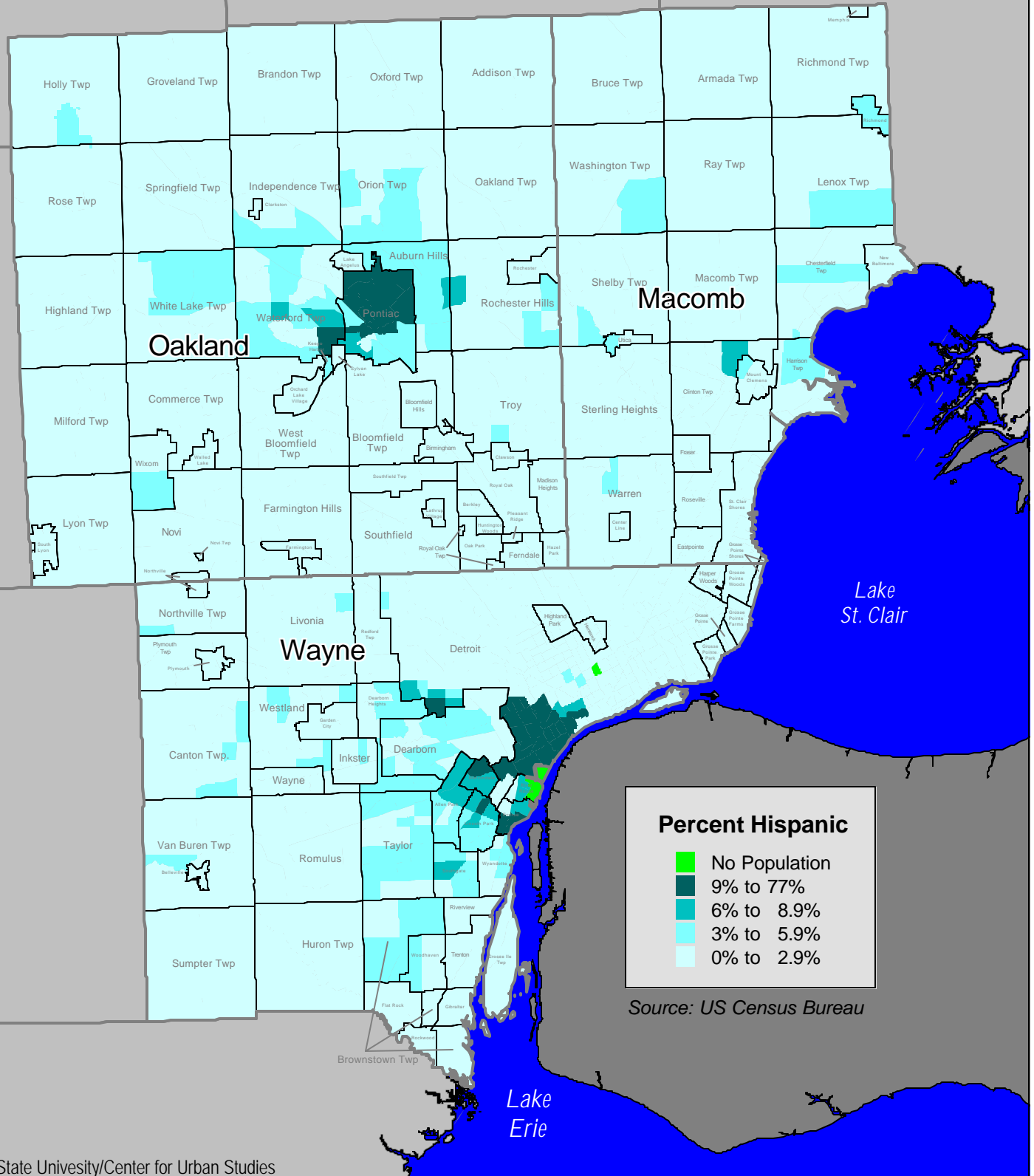
Filipino Population by 2000 Census Tract Tri-County Area



Hmong Population by 2000 Census Tract Tri-County Area

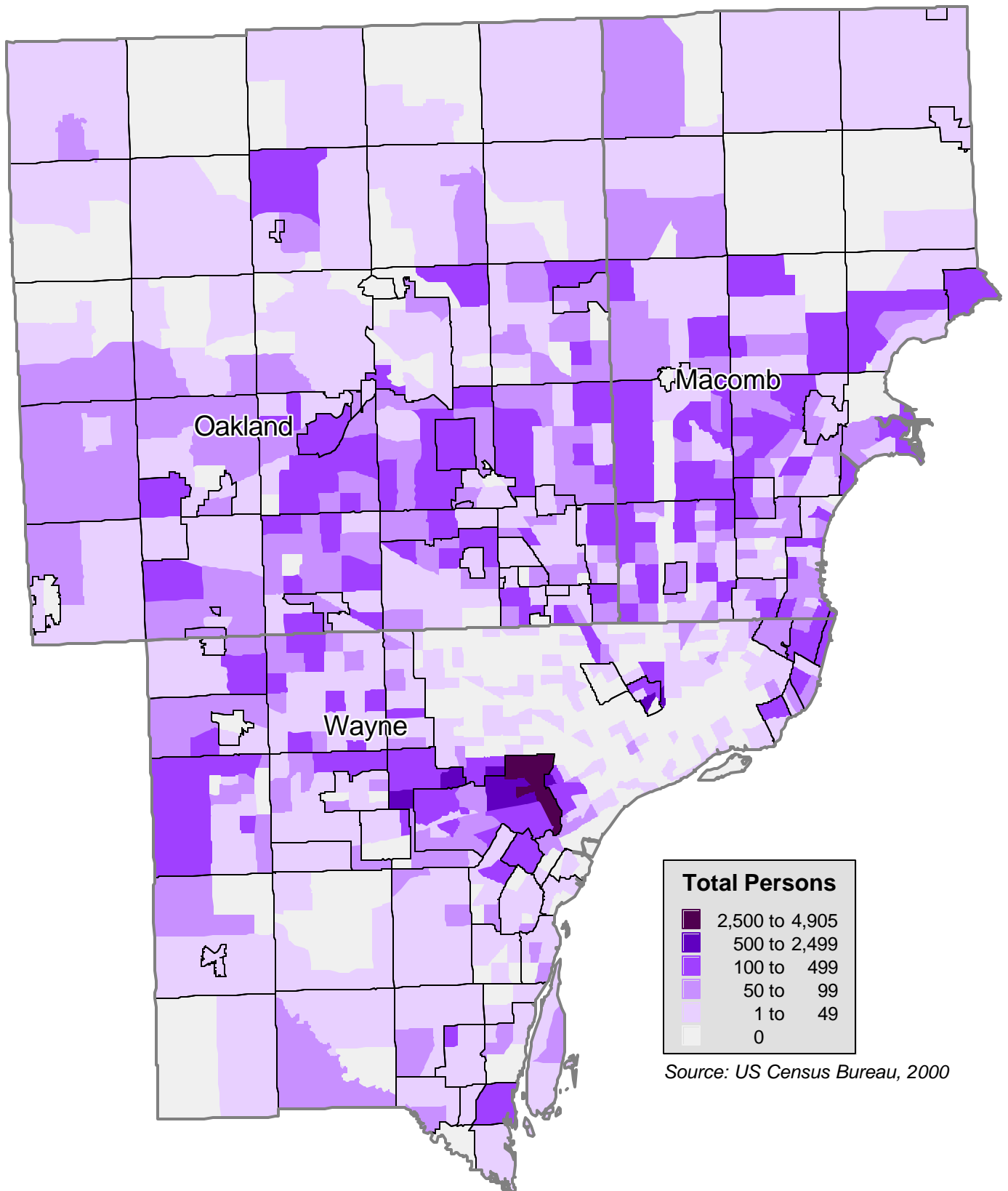


Hispanic Population by 2000 Census Tract Metropolitan Detroit Area

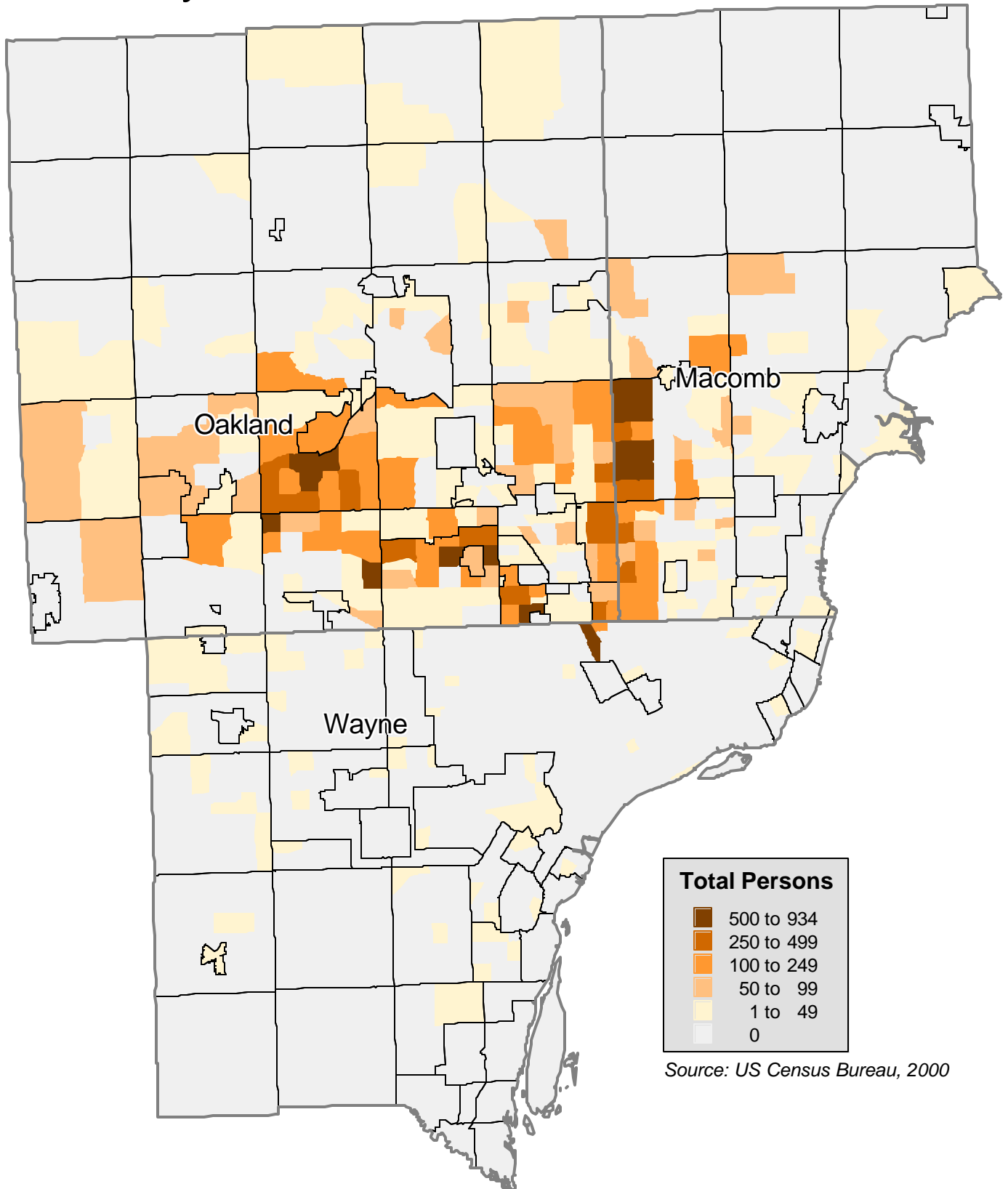

Persons of Assyrian, Chaldean or Syriac Ancestry

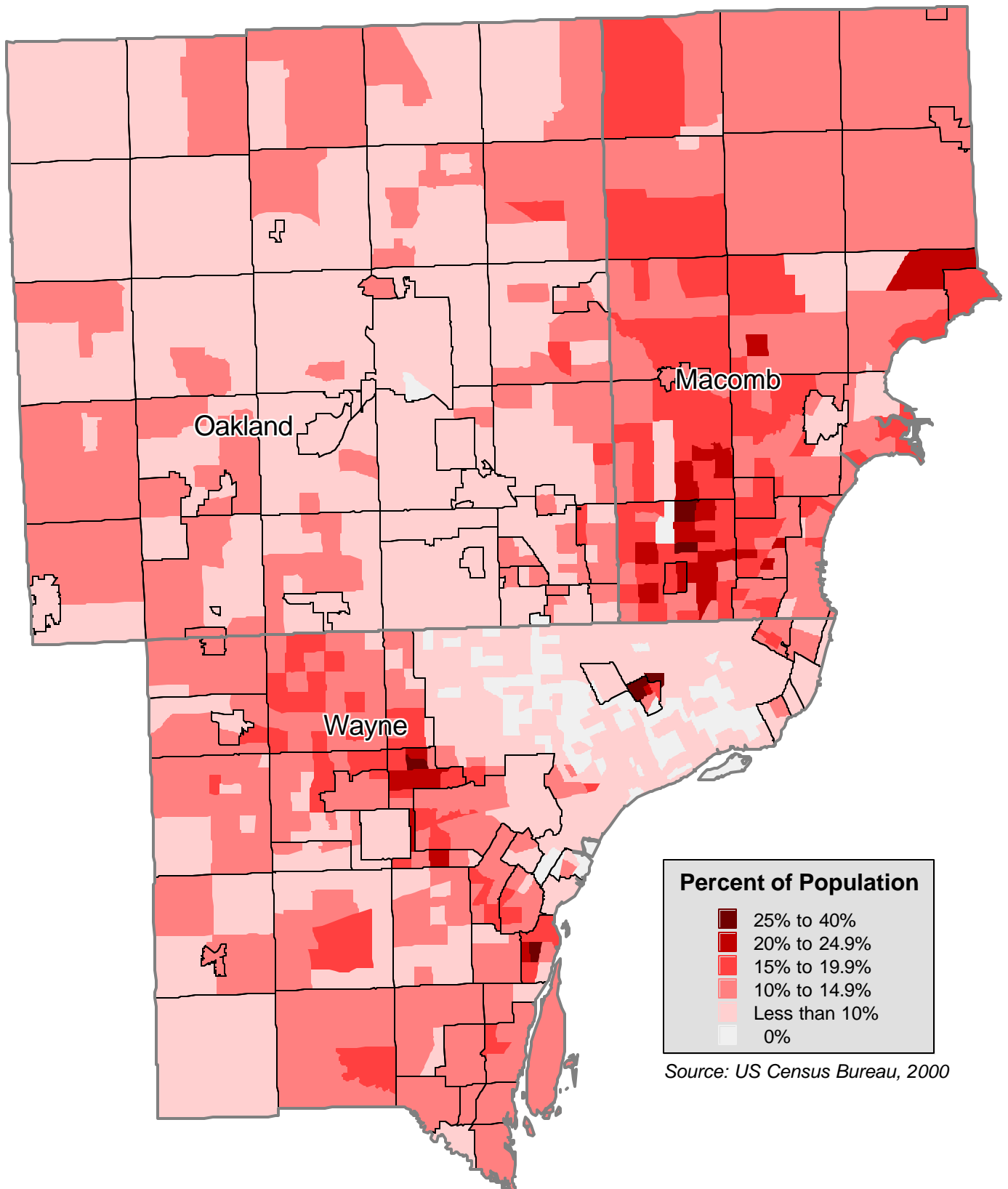

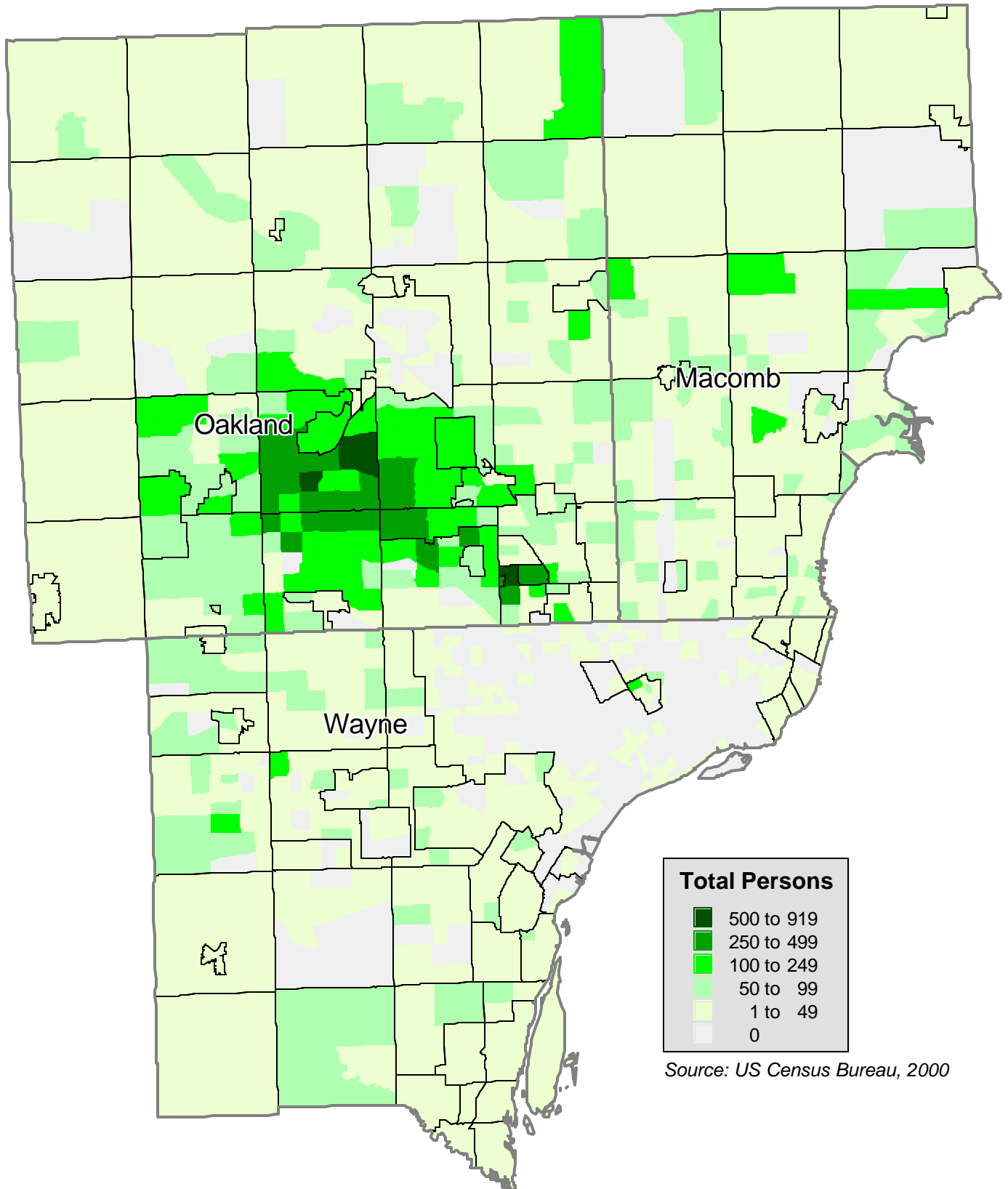

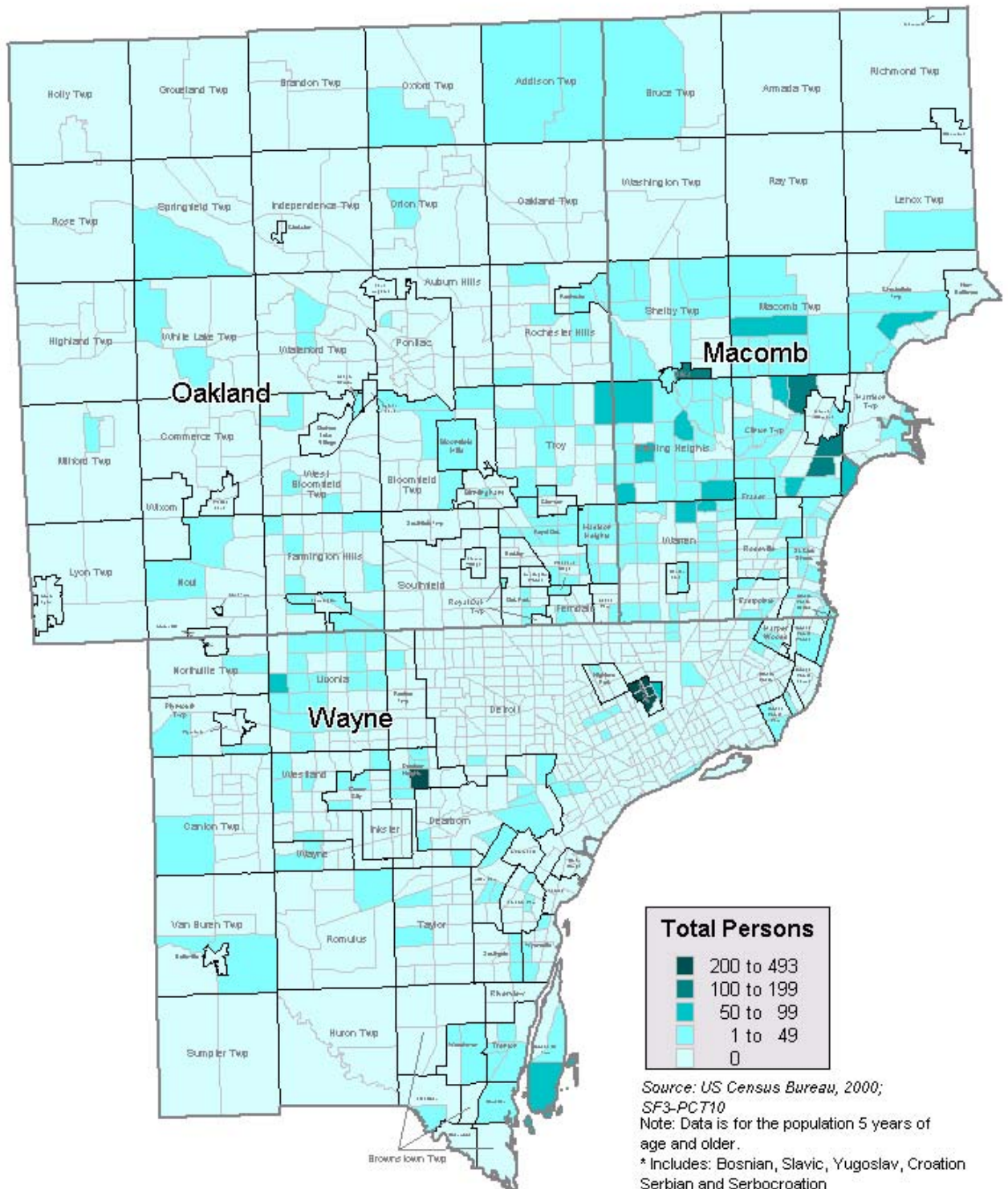

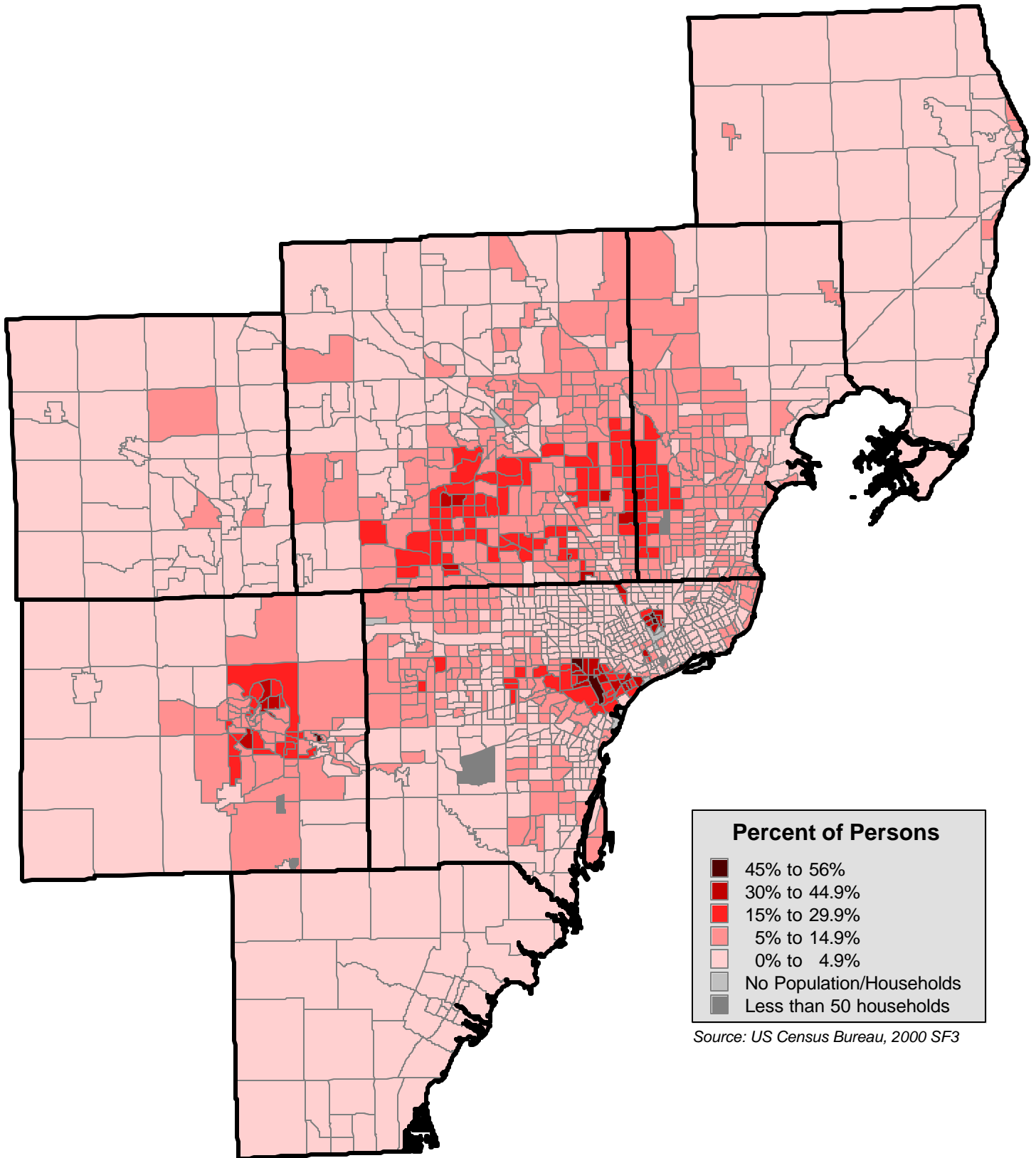

Foreign Born Population

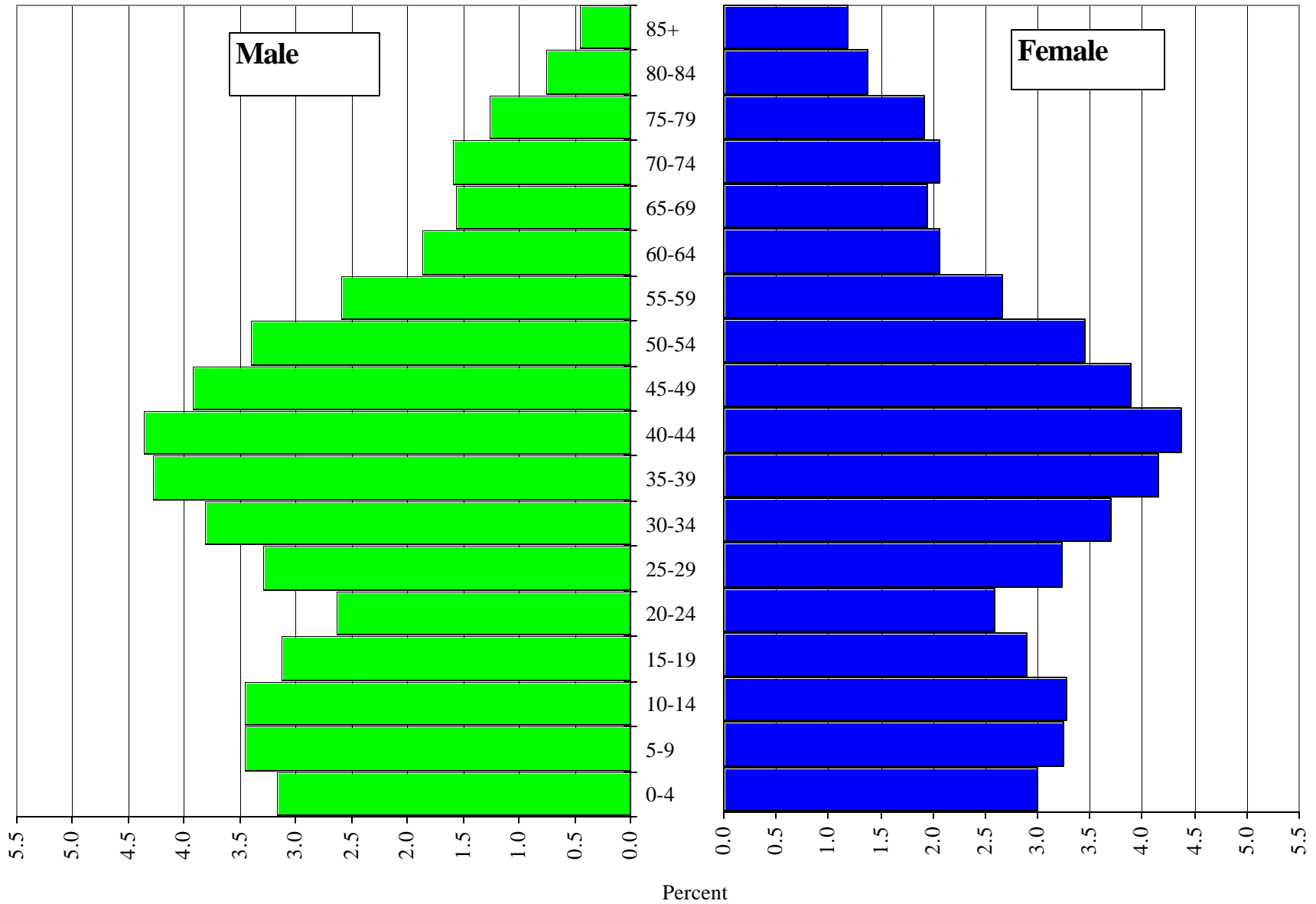

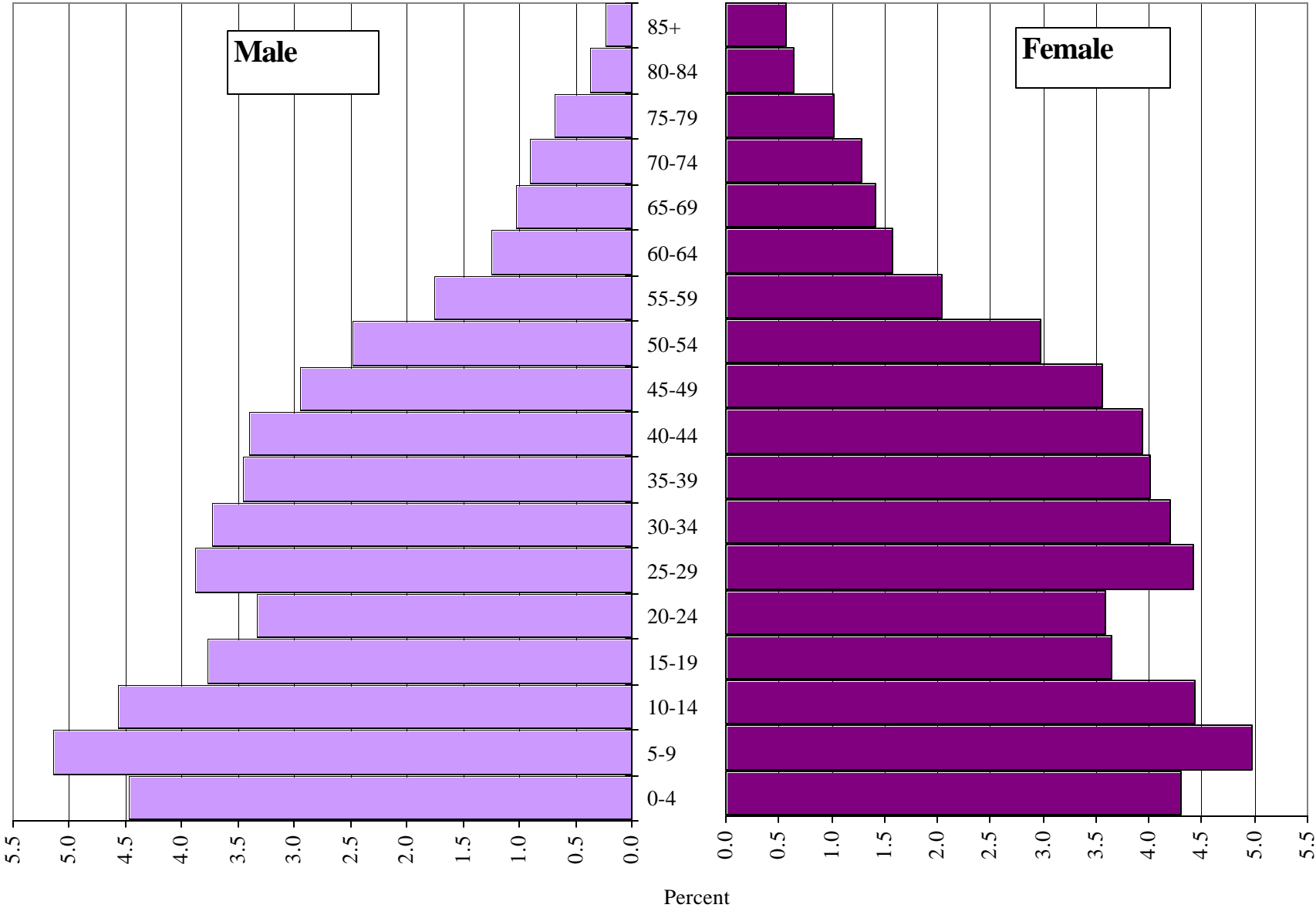
Percent of Total Population



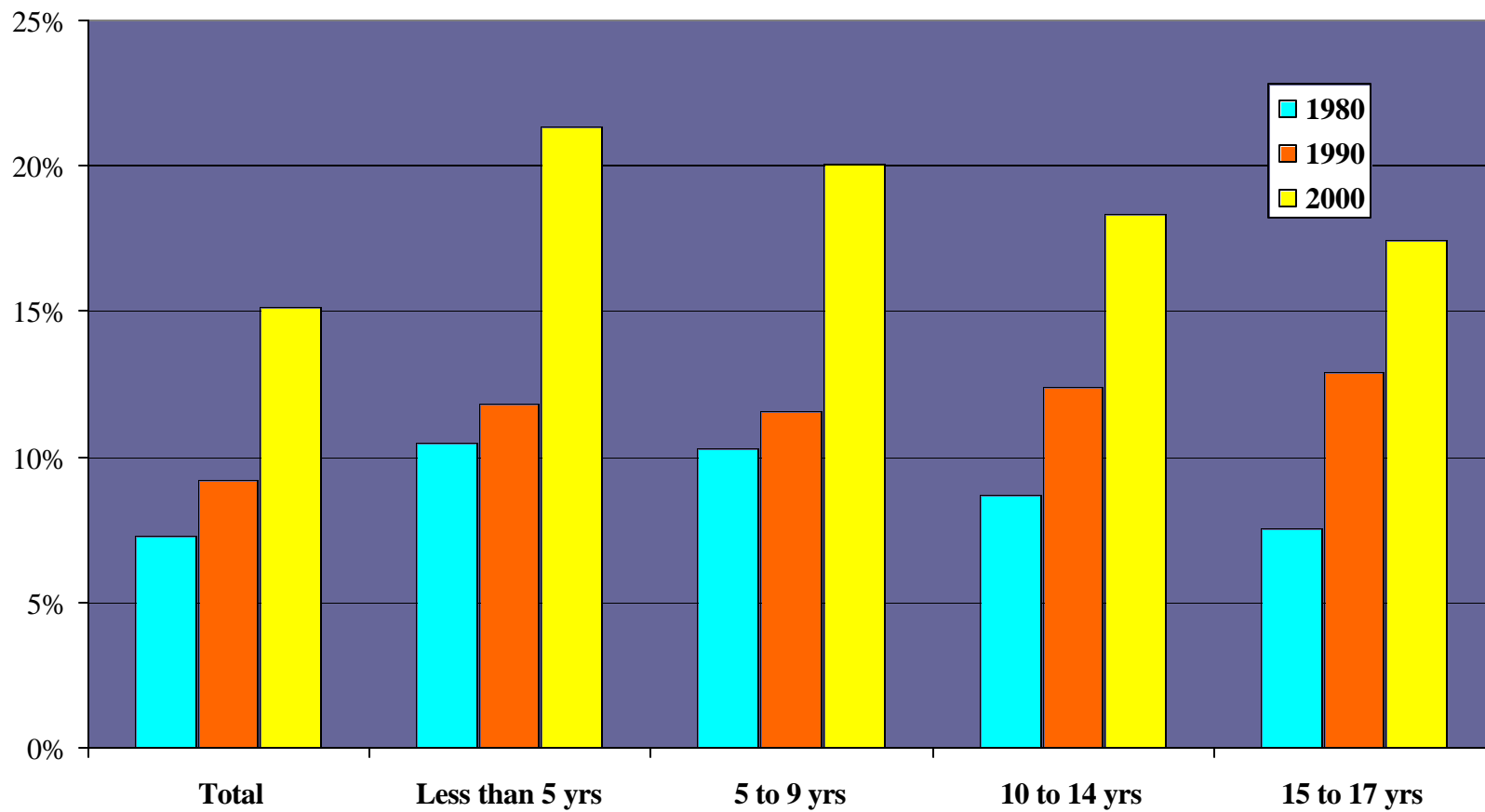
MINORITY POPULATION, 2000

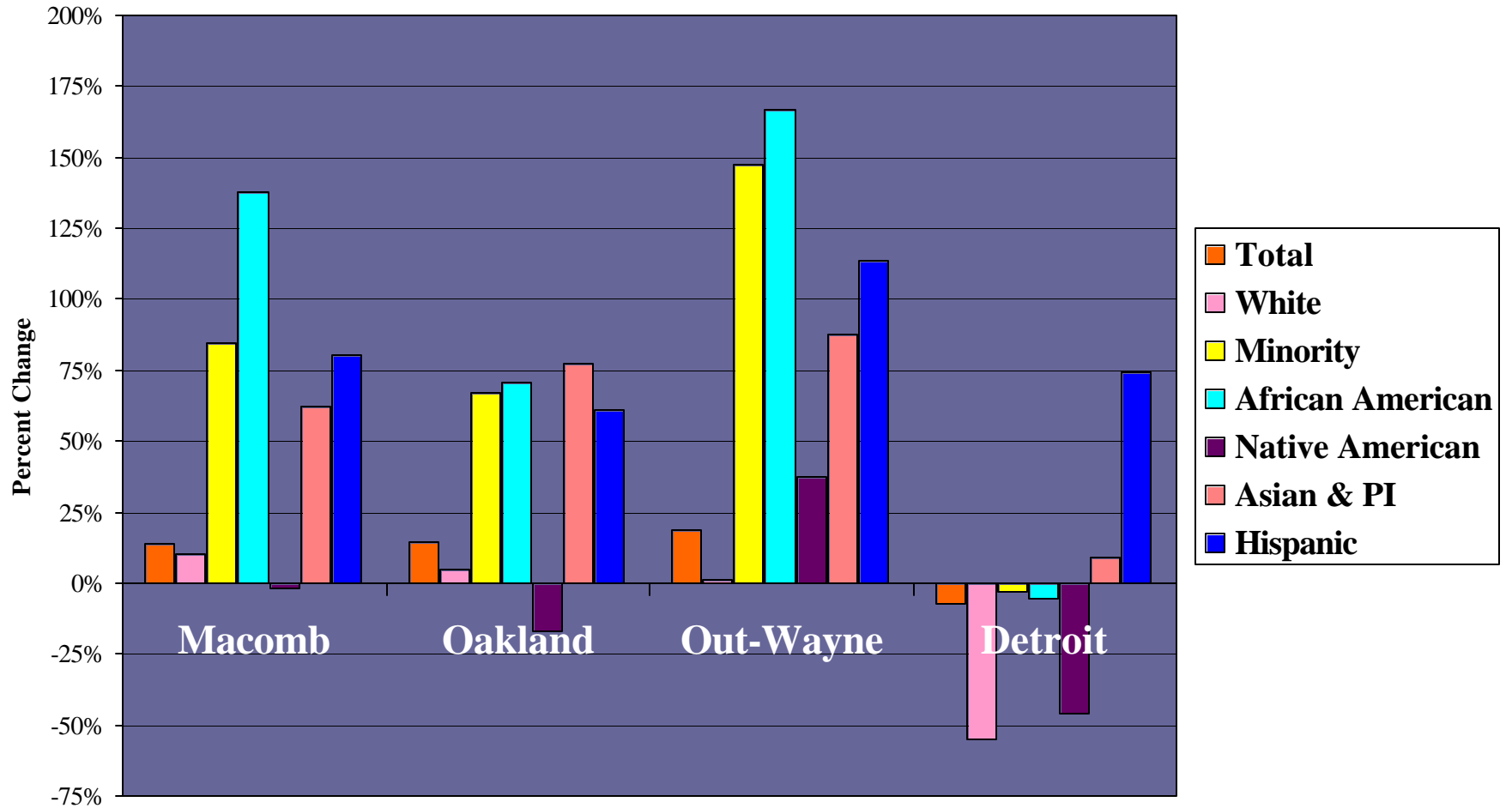
